### SERIES VS. ATHLETICS

The Mariners and Athletics meet for the 15th of 19 games this season...the Mariners won 2-fo-3 game vs. the A's at Safeco Field, Aug. 24-26...Seattle went 10-9 vs. the A's last season, including a 4-5 mark at Safeco Field...dating back to 2013, the Mariners are 31-21 over last 52 games vs. the A's.

**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners continue a 10-game, 11-day road trip tonight with the second of three games vs. the Oakland Athletics (1-0)...the trip began in Chicago-AL (2-2) and continued in Houston (2-1)...open a 10-game homestand Monday vs. Texas (4 games), Colorado (3 games) and Los Angeles (3 games)...tonight's game will be televised in the Mariners TV market on **ROOT SPORTS** and broadcast on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...won 3 straight and 5 of 8 on current road trip...have won 8 of last 12 games...are 12-10 over last 22, 18-14 in last 32 and 22-20 in last 42...won 5 of last 9 series to improve to 15-20-8 in series played...are 7-10 in 17 rubber games (3-game series).

- **AL Leader - Nelson Cruz** is amongst AL leaders: 1st in SLG (.587), 2nd in HR (39), 3rd in OPS (.967), T3rd in XBH (62), T4th in hits (158), T6th in multi-H G (45), 6th in OBP (.380), T8th in RBI (82), 9th in AVG (.310).
- **Heating Up - Robinson Canó** is batting .336 (76x226) with a .924 OPS since July 1 (T5th in AL in avg, 12th in OPS)...has raised his batting avg from .238 to .281 in last 55 G.
- **Extra! Extra! - Robinson Canó** needs 4 more extra-base hits for his 11th consecutive season with 50+ XBH...will become 5th player in MLB history with 50+ XBH in first 11 MLB seasons (last: Pujols).
- **Edgar Effect** - Seattle is hitting .262 with 230 extra-base hits and averaging 4.6 runs per game since **Edgar Martinez** took over as hitting coach on June 20...hit .233 w/3.38 RPG in first 68 G of season.
- **Close Games** - T1st in the AL with 76 of 135 G decided by 2 or fewer runs (26-22 in 1-run games).
- **Last At-Bat** - 23 defeats in final at-bat, most in MLB...T1st in AL with 10 walk-off losses (TB - 10).
- **Extra Innings** - Mariners lead the Majors with 21 extra-inning games (10-11: 4-6 home, 6-5 road).
- **12 Straight** - The Mariners have hit a HR in 12 consecutive games (21 HR), T3rd-longest streak in the Majors (COL-15 & NYY-13) this season.

**CONTINUING SUCCESS VS. THE A'S**...with last night's win vs. the A's the Mariners clinched the season series for the third consecutive season (currently 10-4 this season)...went 11-8 in 2013 and 10-9 last season vs. the A's...would be the first time to win three consecutive season series vs. Oakland since 2001-2003.

**A TALE OF TWO HALVES**...the Mariners are batting .269 (444x1649) with 226 runs scored, 94 doubles, 5 triples, 71 home runs and 218 RBI in 46 games since the All-Star break...Seattle leads the American League in home runs (71), extra-base hits (170) and total bases (761), while ranking 2nd in slugging percentage (.461) and OPS (.792) in the second half of the season...the Mariners batting average rose from .236 in the first half to .269 in the second half, an increase of .033, which is tied for the largest increase in the Majors, along with the Mets (.033) and ahead of the White Sox (.031) and Rangers (.030)...Seattle has also increased their runs per games from 3.51 to 4.91 (+1.40 R/GM), which is the largest increase in the American League and 3rd-largest in the Majors, trailing increases by the Mets (+1.96) and Phillies (+1.55) and ahead of the White Sox (+1.39)...here is a comparison of the Mariners Pre- and Post-All-Star game stats:

**KING OF THE A'S**...Felix Hernandez is 6-1 vs. the Athletics in 10 starts dating back to the start of last season (2.51 ERA, 9 QS)...over his last 14 starts at O.co Coliseum (since start of 2009) is 6-1, 2.85 ERA (31 ER, 98.0 IP)...was the losing pitcher in his last start here July 4 (7.0,10,2,2,2,6), snapping a 6-game winning streak in Oakland...went 13 consecutive starts without a losing decision at O.co Coliseum, tied for the longest streak by an opposing pitcher at the Coliseum (Mike Flanagan, BAL, 1977-84).

**HEY LEFTY**...Kyle Seager has 22 home runs this season, including 10 home runs off left-handed pitching...Seager leads the Majors for home runs by a left-handed batter off a left-handed pitcher, ranking ahead of Chris Davis (BAL, 9 of 40 HR vs. LHP)...the 10 HR by a LH batter off a LH pitcher are the most by a Mariners player since Seager hit 10 in 2013...Ken Griffey Jr. is the only Mariners LH batter to hit more than 10 HR off a LHP in a season (6x, last: 21 HR in 1998).

**DOUBLE-DIGIT SAVES**...with one more save, Tom Wilhelmson will become the third different Mariners pitcher to record 10+ saves this season...will join Fernando Rodney (16) and Carson Smith (13)...will be the first time in club history to have 3 players with double-digits in saves.

**ALPHABET SOUP**...RHP Tony Zych made his Major League debut last night becoming the last player of the more than 18,000 players who have played Major League baseball listed in the baseball encyclopedia...he supplanted Edward (Dutch) Zwilling, who had held that distinction since he broke in with the White Sox on Aug. 14, 1910 (Zwilling played for Chicago's three Major League teams of that era: the Sox, the Cubs, and the Chicago entry in the Federal League, alternately known as the ChiFeds or the Whales)...the Mariners have also had the first player in the directory, when RHP David Aardsma played for the club from 2009-2010...and in another bit of baseball name trivia, the Mariners also had the first player with a hyphenated last name in LHP Ryan Rowland-Smith.

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...Kyle Seager collected his 30th double and 22nd home run of the season last vs. the Athletics, marking the 3rd time in his career to accomplish this feat...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...Seager is the 7th players in Mariners franchise history to record at least 3 seasons with 30 doubles and 20 home runs?...Seager joins Edgar Martinez (7x), Ken Griffey Jr. (6x), Brett Boone (4x), Raul Ibanez (4x), Alex Rodriguez (4x) and Alvin Davis (3x) to have at least 3 such seasons...of the 19 Mariners players to accomplish this feat, including Kyle, have done it 47 different times.

**ABOUT FELIX**...29-year-old right-hander is making his 27th start of the season tonight vs. the A's.

- Is the second pitcher in franchise history to record 300 games started as a Mariner (also: Jamie Moyer, 323 GS w/Seattle 1996-2006).
- Signed a 7-year deal through the 2019 season on Feb. 13, 2013.
- In 2010 won the **AL Cy Young**, garnering 21 of 28 first-place votes...joined Randy Johnson (1995) as only Mariners to win the Cy Young...named *Sporting News* AL Pitcher of the Year...was 2nd in Cy Young voting in 2014.
- ML debut Aug. 4, 2005 at Detroit...Safeco debut vs. MIN Aug. 9, 2005...youngest pitcher since Jose Rijo worked as reliever in '84 (19 years, 54 days (7/6/84 at MIN)).
- At 19 years, 118 days old at debut, was the 3rd-youngest player to debut in Mariners history & 2nd-youngest pitcher.
- Born in Valencia, VZ...signed as 16-year-old non-drafted free agent July 4, 2002.
- A.L. All-Star: 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 (starter) & 2015.
- Threw the first Perfect Game in Mariners history, and 23rd in MLB history, Aug. 15, 2012 in a 1-0 victory over Tampa Bay at Safeco Field (9.0,0,0,0,0,12)...7th PG in MLB history to be decided in a 1-0 game, and 1st in the AL since 1984.
- Tossed 6.0+ IP in 268 of 329 GS (81.46%)...6.0+ innings in 75 of 91 starts since 2013 (82.4%), including 66 quality starts (224 career quality starts, Seattle record).
- Along with Jamie Moyer (2,093.0), are only pitchers with 2,000+ innings with Seattle.
- Is 19-18, 3.40 ERA in 53 career GS in Sept./Oct. (2-1, 1.66 ERA in 6 GS in 2014).

**LAST TIME OUT**...W#15 in Mariners 8-2 win vs. Oakland on Aug. 26...won 15 games for 3rd time in his career, becoming 5th pitcher in club history with 3+ seasons with 15+ wins...85th start of at least 8.0 IP allowing 2 or fewer runs, most in baseball since his debut season in 2005...surrendered home run to Billy Burns on first pitch of the game...did not allow another hit until a leadoff single by Butler in the 5th...allowed home run to Brett Lawrie on first pitch of 7th inning...left game with 8-2 lead after 8.0 innings.

**HIGH HIGHS AND LOW LOWS**...since the start of June, has gone 7-7, 4.95 ERA in 16 starts, but had very different outings along the way...in his 7 wins, has a 1.78 ERA (10 ER, 50.2 IP), allowing 2 or fewer runs in 6 starts and holding opponents to a .198 average against...conversely, in his 7 losses, Felix has a 11.23 ERA, allowing 42 earned runs over 33.2 innings with opponents hitting .414.

**OWNING O.CO**...despite recording a quality start in his last appearance at O.co Coliseum on July 4 (7.0,10.2,2,2,6), Felix took the loss, snapping his streak of 13 consecutive starts at O.co without a loss...had been tied for the longest such streak by an opposing pitcher, joining Mike Flanagan of the Orioles who had a 13 start streak from 1977-84...overall, is 10-3, 2.72 ERA (42 ER, 139.0 IP) in 20 career starts (15 quality starts) in Oakland...his 10 wins at O.co are tied for the 3rd most by an opposing pitcher, trailing Tommy John (12) and Mike Flanagan (11).

**STARTING THINGS UP**...Felix made his 324th career start for the Mariners on July 29 vs. Arizona, passing **Jamie Moyer** (323) for most games started in club history...Hall of Famer **Randy Johnson** is 3rd (266)...amongst pitchers who have made all their career starts for one team, Felix is 19th, trailing Hal Schumacher of the New York Giants (329)...the last pitcher to make this many starts for only one team in their career was Minnesota's Brad Radke (377 from 1995-2006)...**Walter Johnson** holds the Major League record, making 666 starts for the Washington Senators.

**SIX-TIME ALL-STAR**...named to the 2015 American League All-Star team as a manager's selection and worked a 1-2-3 inning 3rd inning (1 K)...6th overall selection (2009, 2011-15), most by any Mariner pitcher and 4th most overall behind **Ken Griffey Jr.** (10; 1990, '91, '92-MVP, '93, '94, '95, '96, '97, '98, '99), **Ichiro Suzuki** (10; 2001, '02, '03, '04, '05, '06, '07-MVP, '08, '09, '10) and **Edgar Martinez** (7; 1992, '95, '96, '97, 2000, '01, '03).

**JUST GET HIM 3**...when receiving 3+ runs of support, Felix is 12-0 with a 1.97 ERA (20 ER, 91.1 IP) in 13 starts this season...by contrast, is 3-8, 5.71 ERA (48 ER, 75.2 IP) in 13 starts where he received 2 or fewer runs of support.

**FELIX QUALITY START**...set MLB record with 16 consecutive starts allowing 2 or fewer runs in 7.0 or more innings May 18-Aug. 11, 2014...old mark was 13 by Tom Seaver in 1971...led the Majors with 22 such starts (7.0 or more IP, 2 or fewer runs) last season, with the next closest AL pitcher being Corey Kluber with 19...124 FQS since 2009, most in the Majors ahead of Clayton Kershaw (102)...has recorded 14 FQS this season (13-1), tied for 3rd-most in the Majors (T2nd in AL) with **Chris Sale** and **John Lackey** behind **Zack Greinke** (16) and **Dallas Keuchel** (15).

Felix has recorded 2,109 career strikeouts, currently 4th-most by a pitcher before turning 30 years old: Walter Johnson (2,302), Sam McDowell (2,271), Bert Blyleven (2,250), **Felix Hernandez (2,109)**, Nolan Ryan (2,085).

**2,000 STRIKEOUTS**
