#### OAKLAND NOTES

- **The Oakland Athletics** have lost four straight and eight of the last 11...fell to 4-12 against the Mariners this season and to 42-50 against Seattle over the last five years...are 31-41 at home and have clinched a losing record at the Coliseum for just the third time in the last 17 years (40-41 in 2007 and 2009)...have homered in a season-high 12 consecutive games (15 home runs total)...are 1-5 on this nine-game homestand against Los Angeles-AL (1-2), Seattle (0-3) and Houston (three games).
- **A's pinch hitters** had their streak of six consecutive pinch hits snapped when Marcus Semien struck out in the seventh...the Athletics extended the streak to six on Coco Crisp and Josh Reddick's seventh-inning singles...are 11-for-15 (.733) over the last nine games.
- **Sean Nolin** made his Athletics debut, his third career major league appearance (last: Sept. 22, 2014) and his second career major league start (last: May 24, 2013).
- **Carson Blair** (0-for-0, bb) made his major league debut as a defensive replacement in the top of the eighth.
- **Billy Burns** (2-for-5) is batting .360 (18-for-50) over his last 12 games...is 17-for-53 (.321) against the Mariners this season.
- **Billy Butler** (2-for-3, r, hr, rbi, so) is 14-for-26 (.538) over his last 10 games...is a .318 (83-for-261) career hitter against Seattle...snapped a 38-game homerless streak with his seventh-inning solo home run...it was his longest homerless drought over the last two years...recorded his 28th multiple hit game of the year.
- **Mark Canha** (2-for-4, r, bb) is batting .320 (31-for-97) with eight doubles, four home runs and 20 RBI over his last 24 games...had his 21st multiple hit game of the year.
- **Stephen Vogt** (0-for-3, so) snapped his six-game hitting streak...was 11-for-19 (.579) during the streak.

#### SEATTLE NOTES

- **The Seattle Mariners** have won a season-high five straight and 10 of the last 14 games...are 37-35 on the road this season...are 33-21 against the A's dating back to the start of 2013...have swept the A's twice this season (previous: May 8-10 at Seattle)...swept just their fifth three-game series against the A's in Oakland in franchise history (last: April 10-12, 2009)...finished 7-3 on this 10-game road trip to Chicago-AL (2-2), Houston (2-1) and Oakland (3-0)
- **Hisashi Iwakuma** improved to 5-5 with a 4.42 ERA (29 er in 59.0 ip) in nine career starts against the A's...made his first start in Oakland since 2013 and is 3-1 with a 3.33 ERA (9 er in 24.1 ip) in four career starts at the O.co Coliseum...the Mariners have won nine of Iwakuma's last 11 starts.
- **Tom Wilhelmsen** has tossed 11.1 scoreless innings and is 8-for-8 in save chances over his last 10 contests.
- **Robinson Cano** (0-for-4, so) snapped his seven-game hitting streak...went 11-for-31 (.533) during the streak.
- **Logan Morrison** (1-for-4, so) extended his hitting streak to five games...is 7-for-15 (.467) during the streak.
- **Brad Miller** (2-for-4, r) extended his hitting streak to seven games (11-for-26, .423)...is batting .316 (31-for-98) with 12 runs scored and 13 RBI over his last 32 games...recorded his 28th multiple hit game of the season.
- **Shawn O'Malley** (1-for-2, r, bb, so) is 6-for-8 (.750) and has reached base in 10 of his 12 plate appearances to begin his Mariners career.
- **Kyle Seager** (1-for-2, rbi, bb) extended his hitting streak to nine games (18-for-36, .500)...is batting .452 (19-for-42) with nine runs scored, four doubles, five home runs and 13 RBI over his last 11 games.
- **Mark Trumbo** (1-for-4, 2b) extended his hitting streak to eight games...is 9-for-32 (.281) with six runs scored, three home runs and six RBI during the streak.
- **Rich Donnelly** did not coach third base due to an upset stomach.
