Felix Hernandez recorded his 16th win last night, tying him for the AL lead with Houston's Dallas Keuchel...2nd-most wins he has recorded in his career, trailing 19 in 2009 when he tied for the AL lead (w/Sabathia/Verlander)...that was the only time a Mariners pitcher has led the league in wins.

Robinson Canó recorded his 444th double of his MLB career, tying him with George Burns and Andres Galarraga for 110th on the all-time list, 9th-most by a Dominican-born player.

### SERIES VS. ATHLETICS

The Mariners and A's meet for the 16th of 19 games this season...will wrap the season series with a 3-game set Oct. 2-4 at Safeco Field...the Mariners clinched the season series for the 3rd consecutive season (currently 11-4)...the first time to win 3 consecutive season series vs. Oakland since 2001-2003...dating back to 2013, the Mariners are 31-21 over last 52 games vs. the A's.

**TODAY'S TILT**...the Mariners wrap up a 10-game, 11-day road trip today with the final of three games vs. the Oakland Athletics (2-0)...the trip began in Chicago-AL (2-2) and continued in Houston (2-1)...open a 10-game homestand Monday vs. Texas (4 games), Colorado (3 games) and Los Angeles (3 games)...today's game will be televised in the Mariners TV market on ROOT SPORTS and broadcast on 710 ESPN Seattle and the Mariners Radio Network.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...won a season-high tying 4 straight and 6 of 9 on current road trip...have won 9 of last 13 games...are 13-10 over last 23, 19-14 in last 33 and 23-20 in last 43...won 6 of last 10 series to improve to 16-20-8 in series played...are 7-10 in 17 rubber games (3-game series).

- AL Leader - Nelson Cruz** is amongst AL leaders: 1st in SLG (.587), 2nd in HR (39), 3rd in OPS (.967), T4th in XBH (62), T4th in hits (158), 6th in OBP (.380), T6th in multi-H G (45), 9th in RBI (82), 9th in AVG (.310).
- Heating Up - Robinson Canó** is batting .333 (77x231) with a .917 OPS since July 1 (6th in AL in avg, 12th in OPS)...has raised his batting avg from .238 to .280 in last 56 G.
- Extra! Extra! - Robinson Canó** needs 3 more extra-base hits for his 11th consecutive season with 50+ XBH...will become 5th player in MLB history with 50+ XBH in first 11 MLB seasons (last: Pujols).
- Edgar Effect** - Seattle is hitting .264 with 237 extra-base hits and averaging 4.65 runs per game since **Edgar Martinez** took over as hitting coach on June 20...hit .233 w/3.38 RPG in first 68 G of season.
- Close Games** - 2nd in the AL with 76 of 136 G decided by 2 or fewer runs (26-22 in 1-run games).
- Extra Innings** - Mariners lead the Majors with 21 extra-inning games (10-11: 4-6 home, 6-5 road).
- 13 Straight** - The Mariners have hit a HR in 13 consecutive games (22 HR), T2nd-longest streak in the Majors (COL-15 & NYY-13) this season.
- RISP** - The Mariners are batting .277 (89x321) with 21 2B, 10 HR and 107 RBI with RISP over the last 31 games (8/2-c)...**Robinson Canó** (.415/17x41, 3 2B, HR, 14 RBI), **Franklin Gutierrez** (.391/9x23, 4 2B, 3 HR, 16 RBI), **Brad Miller** (7x21, 2B, 7 RBI, BB) are all batting over .330 during this stretch.

**SWEEP?**...a win today would give Seattle its second 3-game sweep of the Athletics this season (also: May 8-10 at Safeco Field); would be only the 4th time in franchise history to sweep 3-game set in Oakland and first since April 10-12, 2009 (also: April 10-12, 2001 & Sept. 17-19, 2007).

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN**...with last night's win vs. the A's the Mariners improved to 36-35 on the road this season...Seattle is one of American League 6 teams with a record over .500 on the road in 2015, while ranking T3rd with 36 road wins...dating back to May 22, Seattle is 29-23 in their last 52 road games, leading the Majors in wins and 3rd in winning percentage in that span...during stretch, the club is averaging 4.46 runs per game with 232 runs scored, 101 doubles, 5 triples and 70 home runs.

**A TALE OF TWO HALVES**...the Mariners are batting .272 (458x1685) with 234 runs, 99 doubles, 5 triples, 73 home runs and 226 RBI in 47 games since the All-Star break...Seattle leads the AL in home runs (73), extra-base hits (177) and total bases (786), while ranking 2nd in slugging percentage (.466), OPS (.801), T2nd in doubles (99), 3rd in OBP (.334) and hits (458) and 4th in average (.272) and runs (234) in the second half of the season...the Mariners batting average rose from .236 in the first half to .272 in the second half, an increase of .036, which is the largest increase in the Majors, ahead of the Mets (.033), the White Sox (.032) and Rangers (.029)...Seattle has also increased their runs per games from 3.51 to 4.98 (+1.47 R/GM), which is the largest increase in the American League and 3rd-largest in the Majors, trailing increases by the Mets (+2.00) and Phillies (+1.49) and ahead of the White Sox (+1.41)...here is a comparison of the Mariners Pre- and Post-All-Star game stats:

**NICE START**...Ketel Marte has recorded 33 hits in his first 31 MLB games, with a .351 on-base percentage (33x118/.280)...his 33 hits are tied for 9th-most by a Mariners player in the first 31 games of a career, and most since Nick Franklin also had 33 hits in 31 games in 2013.

**STREAKING**...the Mariners currently have 4 players with hitting streak of at least 6 games: **Kyle Seager** (8 G, .500/17x34, 9 R, 4 2B, 4 HR, 11 RBI, 6 BB, SB), **Robinson Canó** (7 G, .355/11x31, 3 R, 2 2B, 2 RBI, 3 BB), **Mark Trumbo** (7 G, .286/8x28, 6 R, 3 HR, 6 RBI, 3 BB) and **Brad Miller** (6 G, .409/9x22, 2 R, 2 2B, 5 RBI, 2 BB, SB, SF).

**DOUBLE-DIGIT SAVES**...with one more save, Tom Wilhelmsen will become the third different Mariners pitcher to record 10+ saves this season...will join Fernando Rodney (16) and Carson Smith (13)...will be the first time in club history to have 3 players with double-digits in saves.

**LOMO IN SEPTEMBER**...dating back to Sept. 25, 2014, Logan Morrison has hit safely in 8 straight games in the month of September, batting .481 with 10 runs scored, 2 doubles, 5 home runs and 15 RBI...over the past two seasons Morrison has hits safely in 22 of 28 games in Sept., batting .368 (32x87) with 20 runs scored, 9 doubles, 8 home runs, 21 RBI and 6 walks...during this stretch his .368 average in Sept. ranks 5th in the American League.

**AS YOU KNOW**...Shawn O'Malley is 5-for-6 (.833) and has reached base in 8 of his 9 plate appearances to begin his Mariners career, including hitting his first Major League home run last night...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...according to Elias and ESPN Stats and Info, O'Malley joins Steve Henderson in 1983 (3x3, R, BB, SB on 4/5/83 and 0x1, 4 BB, SB on 4/6/83) as the only other Mariners player to reach base 4 times in both his first 2 games with the team...O'Malley is also the first Mariners player to bat 9th and register 2 hits, 2 walks, 2 runs and 1 RBI in a game, which he accomplished last night (2x2, 2 R, 2B, HR, 1 RBI, 2 BB).

ABOUT IWAKUMA...

- Pronounced: he-sash-ee ee-wah-ku-mah
Making 15th start of the season, and the 106th career MLB game/92nd start today vs. the Athletics (2nd this season).
107-69, 3.25 ERA (557 ER, 1,541.0 IP) in 226 G/225 GS w/Kintetsu (2001-04) & Rakuten (2005-2011) in the Japan League.
Pitched in the 2004 Athens Olympics as a member of the Japan national team (bronze medal)...also part of gold medal-winning Japan squad in the 2009 WBC.
2008 Pacific League MVP & winner of Eiji Sawamura Award (Cy Young equivalent) going 21-4, 1.87 ERA (42 ER, 201.2 IP).
Signed by Seattle as a free agent Jan. 5, 2012.
1 of 5 Mariners pitchers born in Japan, but is only the 2nd to make a start...only other Japan-born pitcher to make a start for the Mariners was Mac Suzuki (9 GS, last: 5/17/99 vs. MIN).
Named to the 2013 American League All-Star Team.
Tossed at least 6.0 innings in 65 of his 91 career MLB starts, including 40 of his last 56 starts and 7 of 14 starts this season.
Is 8-5, 3.14 ERA (33 ER, 94.2 IP) in 16 career Sept/Oct starts... was 2-3, 7.61 ERA in 5 Sept/Oct starts in 2014.

LAST TIME OUT...W#6 in Mariners 7-6 victory at the Chicago White Sox on August 29...matched career-high with 4 walks allowed (last: Aug. 28, 2012 at MIN)...retired first 8 batters of the game before having to work out of bases-loaded jam in 3rd with flyout...allowed 3-straight singles in the 4th including RBI-single by LaRoche before getting strikeout and pair of groundouts to end threat...other run allowed came in the 6th, giving up RBI-single to Flowers on final pitch thrown... left game with 5-2 lead.

NO-NO...threw the 5th no-hitter in Mariners history (4th by a single pitcher) in his last start on Aug. 12 vs. the Baltimore Orioles...was Iwakuma's first MLB complete game...the 2nd Japanese-born pitcher with an MLB no-hitter (Hideo Nomo, 2x)... 4th no-no in MLB this season...first no-hitter in the American League since Felix Hernandez (Aug. 15, 2012 vs. TB)...mixed his off-speed pitches well, according to ESPN Stats & Info, threw his lowest percentage of pitches in the strike zone in his career (41 percent, 11 percentage points below his season average entering the day), still throwing 77 of 116 pitches for strikes.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK...named the American League Player of the Week for Aug. 10-16 after tossing the no-hitter in his start vs. Baltimore...was his first career Player of the Week honor, and the first by a Mariners pitcher since Felix Hernandez (June 9, 2014)...third Player of the Week honor for the Mariners this season (Brad Miller - May 18, Nelson Cruz - April 20).

STRINGING TEAM WINS...Seattle has won 8 of Iwakuma's last 10 starts (since July 11) after dropping each of his first 4 starts of the season.

500 Ks...recorded his 500th career strikeout by fanning Mitch Moreland in the 2nd inning of his win at Texas on Aug. 18...hit the milestone while walking just 118 batters...according to STATS LLC, is tied for the 6th-fewest walks by a pitcher before recording his 500th strikeout since 1914 (LAD's Kenley Jansen leads with 104 BB/500K)...recorded 1,175 strikeouts over 11 seasons in Japan before starting his MLB career.

100 STRONG...has made 105 career appearance in the Major Leagues (91 starts) since joining the Mariners in 2012...amongst American League pitchers with at least 75 starts since his debut season, Iwakuma has the 6th-lowest ERA (3.24) and 5th-best strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.15).

VS. THE AL WEST...is 3-2, 4.74 ERA (20 ER, 38.0 IP) vs. AL West in 2015...has won 3 of last 4 starts, going 3-0, 2.05 ERA in starts against LAA (7/11), TEX (8/7) and at TEX (8/18) with lone loss vs. OAK (8/24)...overall in his career, is 23-14 with a 3.57 ERA (109 ER, 274.2 IP) in 45 G/42 GS vs. the AL West.

BACK TO BEING KUMA...is 6-2, 3.68 (30 ER, 73.1 IP) w/9 HR allowed in 11 starts since return from 15-day DL on July 6...was 0-1, 6.61 (12 ER, 16.1 IP) w/5 HR allowed in 3 GS prior to being placed on DL April 24 (retro to April 21).

STOP THIEF...allowed a stolen base in the 1st inning of his start July 28 vs. Arizona (A.J. Pollock)...was the first stolen base off Iwakuma since Sept. 15, 2013 vs. the Royals (Jarrod Dyson)...made 35 starts without allowing a stolen base, a span that included 239 baserunners with opponents going 0-for-9 attempting to steal a base...allowed only 16 stolen bases in 105 MLB games...only 3 attempted steals against in 2015.

TOUGH TO LEAD OFF INNING...has limited opposing hitters to a .135 (12x89) batting average when leading off an inning this season...in 6 August starts, batters leading off an inning are 3x39 (.077 average) with 3 walks.

THE INJURY...suffered a right lat strain and was placed on the disabled list on April 24 (retro to April 21)...second DL stint of Major League career after suffering a torn tendon in right index finger during spring training in 2014.

REHAB RECAP...made 3 rehab starts in June, including 1 at Short-A Everett and 2 at Triple-A Tacoma...allowed 2 runs on 11 hits with 13 strikeouts over 13.1 IP in 3 rehab starts...in final rehab outing on June 30 vs. Las Vegas, allowed 1 run on 5 hits over 5.2 IP, striking out 6 and earning his first minor league win.

27-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 16th start of the season tomorrow vs. Texas...ND in last start Sept. 1 at HOU (5.1,5,4,4,4,4,HR)...L#7 Aug. 27 at CWS (6.2,9,4,3,0,3)...relief outing (1.0 Sho IP) Aug. 24 vs. OAK...recalled from AAA Tacoma Aug. 23...received a run support average of 2.55 and Mariners scored 24 runs in his 14 starts in 2015...selected from AAA Tacoma on April 26 to replace the injured Hisashi Iwakuma...AAA: was 4-2, 7.34 ERA (50 ER, 61.1 IP) in 12 starts with AAA Tacoma...2014: Went 10-12, 3.85 ERA (70 ER, 163.2 IP) in 29 starts last season... shut down for the season after leaving start Sept. 16 at LAA with a strained flexor bundle in his left elbow...Career: Owns a 14-19 record with a 4.04 ERA (114 ER, 253.2 IP) in 44 starts in a Mariners uniform... has spent entire career in the Seattle organization after signing as a minor league free agent on May 3, 2011...defected from Cuba to Mexico in late 2010 after playing with Guantanamo in Serie Nacional...vs. TEX: Making his 5th career start against the Rangers...is 2-1 with a 2.42 ERA (6 ER, 22.1 IP) with 18 strikeouts in 4 starts...has not faced the Rangers this season.
