OAKLAND NOTES

- **The Oakland Athletics** snapped a five-game losing streak with their first win in September...snapped a season-high tying five-game home losing streak...have homered in a season-high 13 consecutive games (17 home runs total)...are 7-7 against Houston this season...are 38-20 all-time against the Astros...are 21-23 on Labor Day since moving to Oakland in 1968 (13-16 at home)...are 2-5 on this nine-game homestand against Los Angeles-AL (1-2), Seattle (0-3) and Houston (1-0).
- **Felix Doubront** is 2-0 with a 3.60 ERA (8 er in 20.0 ip) in four starts with Oakland this season...is 2-0 with a 4.97 (7 er in 12.2 ip) in two career starts against Houston.
- **Sean Doolittle** recorded his first save of the season (first since Sept. 19, 2014 vs. Philadelphia).
- **Billy Burns** (2-for-5, r, 2 rbi) is batting .364 (20-for-55) over his last 12 games...recorded his team-leading 41st multiple-hit game of the season.
- **Billy Butler** (1-for-4, 2 r, bb, k) has hit safely in each of his last eight games...is 12-for-25 (.480) with three RBI over that span.
- **Mark Canha** (2-for-4, r, hr, 2 rbi, bb, 2 k) is batting .330 (33-for-100) with eight doubles, five home runs and 22 RBI over his last 25 games.
- **Coco Crisp** (1-for-2, r, 2b, 2 rbi) has hit safely in each of his past four appearances as a pinch hitter...is 4-for-7 (.571) as a pinch-hitter this season.
- **Brett Lawrie** (2-for-4, r, 3b, rbi, bb, k) is batting .371 (23-for-62) with 11 RBI and 14 runs scored over his last 16 games...recorded his 37th multiple-hit game of the year.
- **Josh Phegley** (1-for-4, r, hr, 2 rbi) has eight home runs and 26 RBI over his last 43 games.
- **Danny Valencia** (1-for-2, 2 r, rbi, 3 bb) snapped an 0-for-10 hitless streak with a single in the bottom of the first inning...is a career .425 (18-for-42) hitter against Houston.

HOUSTON NOTES

- **The Houston Astros** have lost four of the last six games...are now 29-26 against American League West competition this season...are 27-39 on the road this season...are 7-7 against the A's this year...are 0-1 on this 10-game road trip to Oakland (0-1), Los Angeles-AL (three games) and Texas (four games).
- **Mike Fiers** is 2-1 with a 1.69 ERA (6 er in 32.0 ip) in five starts since joining the Astros...is 0-1 with a 3.86 ERA (5 er in 11.2 ip) in two career starts against Oakland.
- **Jose Altuve** (0-for-4) had his 20-game hitting streak at the O.co Coliseum snapped...was batting .375 (33-for-88) with three doubles and eight RBI over that span.
- **Carlos Correa** (1-for-5, r, hr, 4 rbi) hit his 17th home run of the season.
- **Carlos Gomez** (2-for-5, 2b, k) has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games...is batting .319 (15-for-47) with five doubles, one home run and six RBI over that span.
- **Marwin Gonzalez** (2-for-4, r, 2b) is hitting .322 (57-for-177) with eight doubles, seven home runs and 18 RBI in his last 63 games (dating back to June 14)...recorded his 21st multiple-hit game of the season.
- **Jake Marisnick** (2-for-3, r, hr, 3 rbi, k) is hitting .333 (15-for-45) in his last 21 games.
- **George Springer** (1-for-4, 2 r, 2b, bb) snapped an 0-for-seven hitless streak with a double to lead off the game.
- **Jonathan Villar** (1-for-2, r, hr, rbi) hit a pinch-hit home run to lead off the seventh inning.
