WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers open their final roadtrip of the regular season this evening, a 6-game trip with 3 contests each in Oakland and Houston...Texas has lost 2 of 3 and were 7-3 on its homestand against Oakland (2-1), Houston (4-0), and Seattle (1-2)...club has won 6 of 8 and is 12-7 (.632) in September, tied for TOR (12-7) for 2nd best winning percentage in A.L. for the month to SEA at .667 (12-6)...Texas has dropped consecutive games just twice in the last 37 contests beginning 8/13... as won 7 of 10, 9 of 14, 16 of 24, 19 of 29, 25 of 37, and 33 of the last 50 games, the longer span beginning 7/29...club has gone 37-20 (.649) beginning 7/21, 2nd in A.L. (TOR-.696, 39-17) and T3rd in MLB... team's 38-23 (.623) record since the All-Star break is 2nd in A.L. and T3rd in ML (see chart at left)...club is 68-51 starting 5/10 and 72-53 since 5/4...at 80-69 (.537), team has the 4th-best record in the A.L...club has been a season high 12 games above .500 twice, last on 9/19 at 80-68, its best record since the end of 2013 (91-72)...team was a season high 8 G under .500 on 5/3 (8-16).

MARKED IMPROVEMENT: At 80-69, Texas has 13 more wins than in all of 2014 (67-95)...the 13-win improvement is 2nd-best in MLB to only a +15 for the Cubs (88-62 in 2015, 73-89 in 2014) in 2015...the 13-win improvement is already T5th-best in Rangers history (full seasons only), and only other year with an improvement that large since 1999 came in 2004 (+18)...with one more victory, Texas will have 6th season with .500 or better record in the last 7 years.

FIRST PLACE RANGERS: Texas has had sole possession of 1st place in the A.L. West for the last 7 days beginning 9/15...that is the team's longest span of being along at the top since 23 straight days, 8/10-9/1/13...after 3 straight days with a 2.5 game advantage from 9/17-19, club has lost 1.5 games the last 2 days and current 1.0 game lead is lowest since 9/5 (0.5 GA)...the 2.5 GA was team's biggest September lead since 9/29/12 (2.5 GA).

- Texas had not been alone in 1st place all season until win on 9/15 vs. HOU in game #144...became just 6th team in division era (since 1969) to take sole possession of a division lead for the 1st time in game #144-or-later of a season (credit Elias): 2012 A's (game no. 162), 2007 Phillies (160), 2006 Twins (162), 1978 Yankees (144), and 1973 Mets (154).
- Texas was 8.0 GB on 8/2 and 9.0 games out of 1st on 7/22...Rangers are trying to become 5th team in past 40 years and 1st since 2006 Twins to win its division after trailing by at least 8.0 games in August (credit Elias).
- The season-high 9.5-game deficit in 2015 (5/3, 5/19-20) is the largest in club history before reaching 1st place at some point later in a campaign, as previous high was 9.0 GB before reaching 1st place in 1977.

ON THE ROAD: The Rangers have lost consecutive away games for the 1st time since 3 straight defeats, 8/9-12...team has won 8 of 13 on the road beginning 8/21...at 41-34 (547), the Rangers are 3rd in the majors in road winning percentage (.573-STL; .560-CHI) and T3rd in wins...this marks the 4th time in the last 5 years that the Rangers have had a winning record on the road...41 wins are T4th most in club history after 75 road games: 44-31 in 1977; 42-33 in 2012 and 2013; 41-34 in 1999...Texas was 29-46 after 75 road games in 2014 and finished at 34-47 away from home...the Rangers' +7 in road wins from 2014 is 2nd most in ML to the Cubs at +10.

SERIES INFO: The 1-2 mark vs. SEA over the weekend was just the club's 2nd loss in 10 home series since the All-Star break, the other a 1-2 mark vs. TOR, 8/25-27...overall, the Rangers are 11-6-2 in 19 2nd half series.

VERSUS OAKLAND: Texas is 6-10 vs. the A's in 2015, losing 6 of 8 beginning 6/10...the Rangers are 33-40 against OAK since start of 2012...club has lost 2 straight at O.co Coliseum and is 3-4 in 1st 2 series here in 2015...all-time, Texas leads, 340-332 overall with the A's having a 173-161 advantage here in Oakland.

AGAINST THE A.L. WEST: Texas is in a stretch of 23 straight games in its own division that began on 9/4...the Rangers are 30-36 (.455) in their own division in 2015...Texas is 12-4 against Houston but has combined for an 18-32 (.360) mark vs. Los Angeles, Oakland, and Seattle...club is 12-8 vs. the A.L. West beginning 8/17 and is 18-11 since 7/24...the Rangers are 15-17 in A.L. West parks in 2015.

PLAYING ON: Monday was the final scheduled regular season off day for the Rangers in 2015 as the club is scheduled to play on the final 13 days of the campaign...Texas is one of 10 ML teams with 149 games played to date with only CLE (148) having played fewer games...the Rangers have played the fewest games of any A.L. West club: 151--HOU; 150--LAA, OAK, SEA...Texas has been scheduled to play on 30 of the last 31 days in 2015 beginning 9/4.

THE CHOO EXPRESS: Shin-Soo Choo is 12-for-18 with 4 walks over his last 5 games and batted .543 (19-37) with 8 walks and 11 runs on the 10-game homestand to improve his season average from .253 to .272.

- Choo is batting .441 (30-68) in 19 games in September, the 2nd highest average in the majors among qualifiers (50+ PA) behind the Cubs' Starlin Castro (.444)...he has the ML's highest on-base percentage in Sept. at .568.
- Choo has reached base safely in his last 19 and 40 of his last 41 G...since the All-Star break, he is batting .350 (69-197) 56 games to rise from .221 while leading the A.L. in on-base percentage (.469) in that span.

WEEKLY HONOR: On Monday, Prince Fielder was selected as the A.L. co-Player of the Week with White Sox' Jose Abreu for 9/14-20...Fielder led the A.L. in runs (9), tied for 1st in RBI (9) and tied for 3rd in HR (3) and BB (6) in his 7 games for the week...it was his 6th career player of the week selection, the 1st since the week ending 4/14/13 with DET...Fielder was the 2nd Ranger honored this season, joining Rowned Odor for the week ending 7/26.

MITCH MORELAND hit his team high 22nd homer of the year on Sunday, one shy of his season best (2013)...his 79 RBI are 19 more than his previous best (2013) and he has matched his career bests with 120 hits and 24 2B...Moreland has 4 HR and 11 RBI in his last 11 games beginning 9/8, tied for the 2nd most HR in the A.L. in that span.

VERSUS LEFTHANDERS: Texas will face lefthanded starters in at least the 1st 2 games of this series...the Rangers are 4-1 in the last 5 games when facing a southpaw starter...in that span, lefty starters are 0-3 with 2 ND and an 8.74 ERA (23 ER/23.1 IP)...last lefty starter to defeat the Rangers was tonight's opponent, Sean Nolin on 9/12 in Arlington...overall, the Rangers are 29-29 in games in games started by opposing lefthanders in 2015, 14-14 on the road...the 58 starts by lefthanders vs. the Rangers are the most of any major league team.

ON THE ACTIVE ROSTER: With the recall of OF Leonys Martin on Sunday, the Rangers have 37 players on their active roster...according to STATS, Inc., that currently is tied for 3rd most among ML clubs: 39--NYY; 38--NYM; 37--ARI; LAA; OAK; TEX...Texas has used 57 players overall in 2015, 2nd most in the majors (ATL-60) and the 2nd most in team history to the ML record 64 in 2014...The Rangers have employed 31 pitchers this season, tied for 3rd most among ML clubs.

--of Texas' current 40-man roster, the only 3 players not on the active roster are pitchers Phil Klein, Spencer Patton, and Anthony Ranaudo, who have all seen action with the Rangers in 2015 and are all on option at Round Rock.

SHORTS: Round Rock manager Jason Wood, who led the Express to the PCL Championship Series before a loss to Fresno in the 5th and deciding game on Sunday, has joined the club for this trip...Rangers lead the A.L. with 16 SB in 19 tries in September...Texas tops A.L. with 157 DP turned.

TEAM PITCHING: Staff issued 9 runs on Sunday, most since 8/26 vs. TOR (12)...was 18th time with 9+ R in 2015, T3rd in A.L. (20-DET; 19-BOS; 18-OAK and SEA)...14 H were most since 9/1 at SD (14)...still, Texas has 3.48 ERA (82 ER/212.0 IP) last 24 G to lower season mark from 4.42 to 4.27, 13th in A.L. ...club has a 3.58 ERA (155 ER/389.2 IP) last 44 G to drop from 4.56...have used 3+ pitchers in 68 of last 74 G (beg. 6/28)...club is 43-3 when allowing 2-R-or-less, 37-66 when permitting 3+ runs...staff has A.L.-high 471 BB...1003 SO are 2nd-fewest in A.L. (MIN-948)...4.09 road ERA is 7th in A.L.

STARTERS: Rotation has 4.88 ERA (28 ER/51.2 IP) over last 9 G with a 3.89 ERA (78 ER/180.1 IP) last 29 G to lower season mark from 4.42 to 4.31, 11th in A.L....Texas has gone 25-3 in rotation's 28 QS since the break...rotation is 25-14 since 7/29...club-record 12 straight quality starts, 6/4-16...franchise-record 17 straight allowing 3-R-or-less, 6/4-21...club is 59-25 when starters go 6.0+ IP, just 21-44 when starters last less than 6.0 IP...lead the A.L. in walks (284) and have fewest K's (580)...have 56 wins, 5th in A.L., after 46 all of 2014.

RELIEVERS: Bullpen's 2.08 Sept. ERA (12 ER/52.0 IP), tied with SF for 2nd lowest in MLB for the month (SEA-1.74), MLB-low .198 opp. avg. this month...has 2.86 ERA (40 ER/126.0 IP) in its last 43 G of work beg. 8/2 to drop season ERA from 4.73 to 4.22, 4th-highest in A.L. but matching lowest since 7/3 (4.20)...have converted 12 of last 13 and 36 of 43 save tries...T5th in A.L. in saves (42), 3rd in holds (8).
