OAKLAND NOTES

- **The Oakland Athletics** have lost four in a row...have 88 losses, which match the most by an A's team over the last 18 years...are 6-9 over the last 15 games and 13-26 (.333) over the last 39 contests...hit their 41st triple of the year, which is the best single-season total in Oakland A's history (40, 1968)...are 0-2 on the final homestand of the season, a six-game stand against Texas (0-2) and San Francisco (three games).
- **A's starting pitchers** are 6-20 with a 6.36 ERA (141 er in 199.2 ip) over the last 39 games dating back to Aug. 11...have tossed five innings or fewer in 19 of those contests.
- **Felix Doubront** is 2-2 with a 8.33 ERA (25 er in 27.0 ip) over his last five starts...is 0-6 with a 12.83 ERA (38 er in 26.2 ip) in eight career appearances (six starts) against the Rangers...Has allowed seven home runs in his last four starts.
- **Billy Burns** (1-for-3, 3b) is batting .333 (29-for-87) over his last 20 contests...is 14-for-46 (.304) against Texas in his career.
- **Josh Reddick** (1-for-3, r, hr, rbi, bb) snapped an 0-for-10 hitless streak with a home run in the sixth inning...made two errors in right field, which is his first ever multi-error game.
- **Eric Sogard** (2-for-4, r, hr, rbi) hit his first home run of the season, which snaps a 457 at bat homerless streak...it was also his first home run in his last 141 games...is batting 9-for-28 (.321) over his last eight games...recorded his 21st multiple-hit game of the season.
- **Danny Valencia** (1-for-3, bb, k) extended his hitting streak to six games (9-for-21, .429)...is batting 6-for-19 (.316) in six games against Texas this season.

TEXAS NOTES

- **The Texas Rangers** have won three of the last four games and nine of the last 12...are 43-34 on the road this season...are 8-10 this season against the A's...are 32-36 (.471) against the AL West...are 14-7 in the month of September...are 31-29 when the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher...are 2-0 on their final road trip of the season, a six-game trip to Oakland (2-0) and Houston (three games).
- **Colby Lewis** is 5-4 with a 3.59 ERA (23 er in 57.2 ip) over his last nine starts...is 3-0 with a 1.64 ERA (6 er in 33.0 ip) in five starts against Oakland this season...is 8-2 with a 2.84 ERA (27 er in 85.2 ip) in 14 career starts at O.co Coliseum.
- **Elvis Andrus** (2-for-4, r, 2b, hr, 3 rbi) extended his hitting streak to five games (7-for-19, .368)...hit his seventh home run of the season, which is a new career high (6 in 2009)...recorded his 41st multiple-hit game of the season.
- **Adrian Beltre** (2-for-5, 2 r, hr, 3 rbi) is 22-for-48 (.458) with three home runs, six doubles and 17 RBI over his last 12 contests...is batting .314 (82-for-261) in 67 games since July 8...is a career .643 (9-for-14) hitter with three home runs and 12 RBI against Doubront...recorded his 43rd multiple hit game of the year.
- **Prince Fielder** (1-for-5, r) snapped an 0-for-20 hitless streak with a single in the fourth inning...it was the second longest such streak of his career (22 at bats, 5/8-13/12 with Detroit).
- **Mitch Moreland** (1-for-4, r, rbi, k) is batting 9-for-27 (.333) with three home runs and nine RBI in seven games at O.co Coliseum this season.
