WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers won the opener last night of their final roadtrip of the regular season, a 6-game trip with 3 contests each in Oakland and Houston...Texas has won 2 of 3 and 7 of 9 and is 13-7 (.650) in September, the 3rd best winning percentage in the majors for the month to CHI at .714 (15-6) and SEA at .684 (13-6)...Texas has dropped consecutive games just twice in the last 38 contests beginning 8/13... team has won 8 of 11, 10 of 15, 17 of 25, 20 of 30, 26 of 38, and 34 of the last 51 games, the longer span beginning 7/29...club has gone 38-20 (.655) beginning 7/21, 3rd in ML (TOR-.684, 39-18; CHI-.667, 40-20)...team's 39-23 (.629) record since the All-Star break is 2nd in A.L. and T3rd in ML (see chart at left)...club is 69-51 starting 5/10 and 73-53 since 5/4...at 81-69 (.537), team has the 4th-best record in the A.L...club is a season high 12 games above .500 for the 3rd time in the last 6 days, its best record since the end of 2013 (91-72)...team was a season high 8 G under .500 on 5/3 (8-16).

THE .500 MARK: The Rangers won their 81st game of 2015 on Tuesday for its 6th season with a .500 or better record in the last 7 years (beginning 2009), one of 5 ML clubs to accomplish that feat (7--NYY and STL; 6--DET and LAD)...it is the 21st time in the club's 44 years in Texas that it has had a .500 or better record for the year.

DRAMATIC IMPROVEMENT: At 81-69, Texas has 14 more wins than in all of 2014 (67-95)...the 14-win improvement is 2nd-best in MLB to only a +16 for the Cubs (89-62 in 2015, 73-89 in 2014) in 2015...the 14-win improvement is already the 5th-best in Rangers history (full seasons only), and only other year with an improvement that large since 1986 came in 2004 (+18)...with one more victory, Texas will have 6th season with .500 or better record in the last 7 years

FIRST PLACE RANGERS: Texas has had sole possession of 1st place in the A.L. West for the last 8 days beginning 9/15...that is the team's longest span of being along at the top since 23 straight days, 8/10-9/1/13...the Rangers increased their lead in the division to 2.0 games on Tuesday, the 5th time in the last 9 days Texas has gained ground in the A.L. West...largest lead is 2.5 games for 3 straight days, 9/17-19, the team's biggest September lead since 9/29/12 (2.5 GA)...last time team led A.L. West by more than 2.5 games was 8/29/13 (+3.0 GA).

- Texas had not been alone in 1st place all season until win on 9/15 vs. HOU in game #144...became just 6th team in division era (since 1969) to take sole possession of a division lead for the 1st time in game #144-or-later of a season (credit Elias): 2012 A's (game no. 162), 2007 Phillies (160), 2006 Twins (162), 1978 Yankees (144), and 1973 Mets (154).
- Texas was 8.0 GB on 8/2 and 9.0 games out of 1st on 7/22...Rangers are trying to become 5th team in past 40 years and 1st since 2006 Twins to win its division after trailing by at least 8.0 games in August (credit Elias).
- The season-high 9.5-game deficit in 2015 (5/3, 5/19-20) is the largest in club history before reaching 1st place at some point later in a campaign, as previous high was 9.0 GB before reaching 1st place in 1977.

ON THE ROAD: The Rangers have won 9 of 14 away from home beginning 8/21...at 42-34 (553), the Rangers are 3rd in the majors in road winning percentage (.573-STL; .560-CHI) and T2nd in wins...42 wins are T3rd most in club history after 76 road games: 45-31 in 1977; 43-33 in 2013; 42-34 in 1999 and 2012...Texas finished at 34-47 away from home in 2014...the Rangers' +8 in road wins from 2014 is 2nd most in ML to the Cubs at +10.

VERSUS OAKLAND: Texas is 7-10 vs. the A's in 2015, winning 3 of 4 but losing 6 of 9 beginning 6/10...the Rangers are 34-40 against OAK since start of 2012...club is 4-4 at O.co Coliseum in 2015 and 11-6 since start of 2014...all-time, Texas leads, 341-332 overall with the A's having a 174-161 advantage here in Oakland.

AGAINST THE A.L. WEST: Texas is in a stretch of 23 straight games in its own division that began on 9/4...the Rangers are 31-36 (.463) in their own division in 2015...Texas is 12-4 against Houston but has combined for an 19-32 (.373) mark vs. Los Angeles, Oakland, and Seattle...club is 13-8 vs. the A.L. West beginning 8/17 and is 19-11 since 7/24...the Rangers are 16-17 in A.L. West parks in 2015.

MITCH MORELAND has homered in each of the last 2 games to give him 23 HR for the year, matching his career best (2013)...he has 5 HR and 13 RBI in last 12 G beginning 9/8, tied for 2nd in the A.L. in HR and RBI in that span...Moreland's 81 RBI are 21 more than his previous best (2013) and he also has a career high 123 hits. --of Moreland's 23 HR, a team-high 11 have either tied a game (2) or given Texas the lead (9), including each of his 5 HR in September, T2nd most in ML for the month: 6-Chris Davis; 5-Matt Kemp. --Mitch is 8-for-23 (.348) with 3 HR and 8 RBI in 6 games at O.co Coliseum in 2015...he has 10 HR and 22 RBI here lifetime, his highest totals in any opposing park.

RBI IN BUNCHES: Adrian Beltre hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games at .465 (20-43) with 6 2B, 2 HR, and 14 RBI to rise from .261 to .278, matching a season high...his 19 RBI in September tie BOS' David Ortiz for the A.L. lead, one behind COL's Nolan Arenado...Beltre has 34 RBI in his last 36 G starting 8/15, tied for 3rd most in the majors in that span (40--Edwin Encarnacion; 35--Josh Donaldson; 34--Yoenis Cespedes)...he had just 30 RBI in his 1st 95 G of 2015.

TIME FOR TOLLESON: Shawn Tolleson recorded his 33rd save on Tuesday, the 11th most in club history for a season...all of those have come since 5/20, the most in the A.L. and 3rd-most in the majors in that span (40--Mark Melancon; 34--Trevor Rosenthal)...Tolleson has converted all 21 save tries on the road, the most away saves in the A.L. and 3rd in ML (23 each--Melancon and Rosenthal)...that total matches the 4th highest for a season in team history: 25--Francisco Cordero, 2004; Joe Nathan, 2013; 22--Nefthali Feliz, 2010; 21--Feliz, 2011...Tolleson has converted his last 8 and 20 of last 21 save tries, the longer span starting 7/18.

SACRIFICE FOR THE GOOD: The Rangers recorded 4 sacrifice flies and 3 sacrifice hits, both 2 shy of the single game team mark, on Tuesday night...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, it was just the 3rd time since 1954, when SF became a separate stat from SH, that a team has had at least 4 SF and at least 3 SH in one game...on the previous 2 occasions, the club also recorded 4 SF and 3 SH: ATL on 5/23/91 vs. SD (12 inn.) and HOU on 5/3/09 vs. ATL...the 7 combined sacrifice flies and hits in a game are the 2nd most in Rangers' history...the club had 5 SH and 3 SF on 8/1/77 vs. CWS.

VERSUS LEFTHANDERS: The Rangers are 5-1 in the last 6 games when facing a southpaw starter...in that span, lefty starters are 0-3 with 3 ND and an 8.90 ERA (28 ER/28.1 IP)...last lefty starter to defeat the Rangers was Sean Nolin on 9/12 in Arlington...overall, the Rangers are 30-29 in games in games started by opposing lefthanders in 2015, 15-14 on the road...the 59 starts by lefthanders vs. the Rangers are the most of any major league team.

SHORTS: With his victory on Tuesday, Chi Chi Gonzalez became the 1st Ranger to record wins as both a starter and reliever in 2015...Keone Kela recorded his 20th hold last night, 2nd-most by a rookie in Rangers history (Jeff Zimmerman-24 in 1999)...last 5 and 9 of 10 games have gone at least 3 hours

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#48 Colby Lewis, RHP (16-8, 4.41)

TONIGHT: The 36-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 31st start of the season tonight in the middle installment of this 3-game set in the Bay Area...is seeking to become the first Texas right-hander to win 17 games since Scott Feldman in 2009...

ON THE LEADERBOARD: Ranks among the A.L. leaders in wins (5th, 16), BB/9 (4th, 1.85), quality starts (T8th, 19), and pitches per inning (8th, 15.3)...has had 21.1% of his pitches put in play, 3rd-highest percentage in the A.L....his 6.25 run support average is 4th-highest in the A.L., this despite Rangers being shut out in 2 of his past 4 starts...

LAST START: Earned the win in an 8-2 victory over the Astros on Thursday in Arlington (6.0 IP, 7 H 2 R-ER, 0 BB, 3 SO, 0 HR, 90 pitches/59 strikes)...was 9th career win vs. HOU and helped the Rangers finish off a 4-game sweep of the Astros...HOU lineup featured 5 LHB, who went a combined 3-for-12...allowed 4 straight batters to reach with 2 outs in the 4th inning, leading to the only 2 HOU runs in the contest.

VS. OAKLAND: Is 2-0, 1.33 (4 ER/27.0 IP) in 4 starts vs. the Athletics this season, including 1-0, 1.50 (6.0 IP, 1 ER) at O.co Coliseum...is 7-2, 2.82 ERA (25 ER/79.2 IP) in 13 career starts at O.co, including 5-1, 2.82 (16 ER/51.0 IP) in 8 starts since 9/26/10...pitched a complete-game shut-out in his last outing vs. Oakland, a 4-0 Texas win on 9/11 in Arlington...took a perfect game thru the 7th inning before allowing a leadoff double by Danny Valencia in the 8th...

ON THE ROAD: Has gone 8-6, 4.33 (46 ER/95.2 IP) in 15 starts away from Arlington this season, T4th-most road wins in the A.L....has lost last 2 road starts, allowing 11 ER in 10.2 IP...opponents are batting .275/.310/.456 on the road compared to .245/.295/.387 at home...has quality starts in 9 of 15 road outings...is currently tied for the 3rd-most road wins by a Texas starter over the last 5 seasons (2011-15)...last Texas starter to win more than 8 road starts in a season was Matt Harrison with 10 in 2012.

WINNING: Has already established a new career high with 16 wins, 5th in the A.L....has won 2 straight starts since the end of a 3-game losing streak...1st Ranger to win 14+ games after losing 14+ games the previous season since Jose Guzman in 1986-87, 1st in MLB to do it since Phil Hughes in 2013-14...Lewis has gone 12-5, 4.27 (62 ER/130.2 IP) over 19 starts since 6/2, T2nd-most wins in the A.L. (TOR's David Price has 13)...T4th-most in MLB...is tied for A.L. lead with team-high 8 wins since the break...is 13th Ranger with multiple 14-win seasons, 1st since Matt Harrison (2) in 2011-12, and 1st Texas 16-game winner since Harrison (18) and Yu Darvish (16) in 2012...has posted 10+ wins in 5 different seasons with Texas (2003-10-11-14-15), trailing only Charlie Hough and Kenny Rogers (9 each) in that category...has 70 career wins with Texas, 6th-most in club history...next on list is 5th-place Kevin Brown (78).

2015: Has held right-handed batters to a .244 average (41-168) over his last 13 outings despite RHBs going 9-for-14 vs. Lewis on 9/6 at LAA...left-hander batters are hitting .211 (19-90) over last 8 starts...has exited in position for the win, but did not receive the victory 4 times, T5th-most in A.L....starts by catcher: Robinson Chirinos (19 GS, 4.62 ERA), Carlos Corporan (3, 2.60), Bobby Wilson (4, 5.06), Chris Gimenez (5, 3.77)...has 9 walkless starts this season, T4th in the A.L....the 9 starts with no walks match his most in any season for Lewis (9 in 2014)...has 15.0 straight walkless innings (club record is 29.1 IP by Jon Matlack, 6/24-7/22/78)...batters hitting first in order are hitting .302 (29-96), including 10-for-30 (.333) when leading off games...bottom 2 spots in the order are batting a combined .372 (54-145) with 5 walks...opponents hitting .319 (46-144) w/ RISP, 3rd-highest in the A.L. (MIN's Mike Pelfrey-.360; TOR's Drew Hutchison-.344), incl. 18-for-46 (.391) in his past 9 starts...has allowed 24 of 101 runs in the 3rd inning...lost on 4/18 at SEA in matchup with Felix Hernandez...took ND 4/12 vs. HOU in Rangers' 14-inning defeat...tossed 6.0 SHO IP and exited with 3-0 lead, but took ND 5/1 vs. OAK...win on 5/6 at HOU finished Rangers' 3-G sweep, holding Astros scoreless thru 7.0 frames...retired final 15 BF and did not return after rain delay of 1:19 on 6/13 vs. MIN...earned win on 6/19 at CWS, as Rangers were held scoreless by Chris Sale over first 8 innings and rallied against David Robertson in the 9th...allowed season highs in hits (12) and earned runs (10) in loss on 7/5 vs. LAA...Yankee hitters went 2-for-last-14 vs. Lewis in win on 7/29 vs. NYY...earned win in 12-9 Texas victory on 8/3 vs. HOU, becoming 1st Texas starter to win when allowing 7+ runs since Derek Holland (6.2 IP, 7 R-ER) in an 8-7 win on 9/30/12 vs. LAA-G2...won 4 straight starts, 7/18-8/3, 1st time he has ever done that in a single season...took loss in matchup with Felix Hernandez on 8/9 at SEA, but logged his 8th career CG...allowed one run over 13.0 IP while winning back-to-back starts 8/15-21.

RANGERS LEADERS: Ranks among Texas' all-time leaders in strikeouts (6th, 849), starts (6th, 172), wins (6th, 70), and innings (6th, 1043.1)...is one of just 8 pitchers with at least 4 different 10-win seasons for the Rangers...his 5 career RBI are the most ever by a Rangers pitcher...went 4-1, 2.34 (13 ER/50.0 IP) in 8 playoff starts in 2010-11...has most career postseason wins of any pitcher in franchise history, and ranks 2nd in innings and strikeouts (44).

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER — LHP COLE HAMELS (10-8, 3.67 in 29 games/starts in NL/AL)

The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 30th start of the season and 10th in a Texas uniform in tomorrow's series finale against the Athletics...has gone 4-1, 3.73 (26 ER/62.2 IP) in his 9 G/GS w/ the Rangers, averaging just under 7.0 innings per start...is 4-0, 3.12 (17 ER/49.0 IP) his last 7 starts, dropping season ERA from 3.86 to 3.67...quality starts in 6 of those 7 outings, with 47 SO to 13 BB in that span...Rangers are 7-0 in those games after losing his 1st 2 starts...earned the win in his last start on Saturday vs. SEA in Arlington, a 10-1 Texas victory (7.0 IP, 7 H, 1 R-ER, 0 BB, 12 SO, 113 pitches/81 strikes)...recorded 5 of final 6 outs via punchout to notch his 4th double-digit strikeout performance of the season...owns two of four 10+ SO performances by Texas starters in 2015...will be facing the A's for just the second time in his career and first time since 6/25/11 with PHI...took loss in the outing despite allowing just 2 R-ER over 8.0 IP (8 H, 2 BB, 5 SO)...has never pitched at O.co Coliseum...has gone 6-6, 4.24 (46 ER/97.2 IP) over 15 away outings in 2015, and is 2-0, 4.05 (9 ER/20.0 IP) over his last 3 road starts...was acquired from the Phillies in an 8-player trade on 7/31 prior to the deadline...threw his first career no-hitter on 7/25 vs. the Cubs at Wrigley Field (9.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R-ER, 2 BB, 13 SO)...has received the 17th-lowest run support average (3.90 per 9 innings) in majors in 2015...has been a 3-time All-Star ('07, '11, '12), posted 200+ IP 6 times, tallied 10 wins in 6 different seasons, and was selected as MVP of both the 2008 NLCS and 2008 World Series.
