OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics lost their fifth consecutive game...clinched their worst record since going 65-97 in 1997...are 6-10 over the last 16 games and 13-27 (.325) over the last 40 contests...fell to 14-30 (.318) when the opponent starts a left-handed pitcher...finished the year 10-9 against Texas...are 0-3 on the final homestand of the season, a six-game stand against Texas (0-3) and San Francisco (three games).
- A's starting pitchers are 6-21 with a 6.39 ERA (144 er in 202.2 ip) over the last 40 games (dating back to Aug. 11)...have tossed five innings or fewer in 20 of those contests.
- The Athletics have committed two errors in each of the last three games and now have 117 for the season, which is tied with Pittsburgh for the most in the majors.
- Chris Bassitt made his first start since Aug. 26...has a 7.36 ERA (9 er in 11.0 ip) and .367 (18-for-49) opponents batting average in the first inning...is 1-6 with a 3.02 ERA (22 er in 65.2 ip) and .246 (60-for-244) opponents batting average in his 11 starting assignments...has received one run of support or fewer in eight of his 11 starts.
- Billy Butler (1-for-3, 2b, so) recorded his 1,400th career hit with a seventh-inning double to left.

W — Hamels (5-1)

• Marcus Semien (1-for-3, so) extended his hitting streak to eight games (10-for-28, .357), which is one short of his career high (9, Aug. 4-14, 2015)...is batting .288 (44-for-153) with five home runs and 20 RBI over his last 42 games (dating back to Aug. 1).

TEXAS NOTES

- The Texas Rangers have won four of the last five games and 10 of the last 13...improved to 44-34 on the road this season...are 33-36 (.478) against the AL West...are 15-7 in September...are 3-0 on their final road trip of the season, a six-game trip to Oakland (3-0) and Houston (three games).
- Cole Hamels is 5-1 with a 3.41 ERA (26 er in 68.2 ip) in 10 starts since Texas acquired him from Philadelphia on July 31...is 5-0 with a 2.78 ERA (17 er in 49.0 ip) over his last eight starts...the Rangers have gone 8-0 in those games after losing his first two starts with the team...made his second career start against the A's and his first career appearance at the O.co Coliseum...is 1-1 with a 0.56 ERA (1 er in 16 ip) in his two career starts against the Athletics.
- Adrian Beltre (2-for-5, 3 rbi) is 24-for-53 (.453) with three home runs, six doubles and 20 RBI over his last 13 contests...is batting .316 (84-for-266) in 68 games since July 8...put together his 44th multiple hit game of the season.
- Shin-Soo Choo (1-for-4, 2 r, 2b, rbi, bb, 2 so) is 14-for-28 (.500) over his last eight games and is 21-for-47 (.447) with 14 runs and 11 walks over his last 13 contests...has reached base safely in 21 of his last 22 games and in 43 of his last 45 contests.
- Delino DeShields (3-for-5, 2 r, 2 rbi) extended his hitting streak to five games (8-for-19, .421) with a first-inning single...recorded his 25th multiple hit game of the season and his fourth three-hit contest of the year.
- Chris Gimenez (2-for-4, r, bb) has reached base safely in 10 of his last 11 starts...had his seventh multiple hit game of the year...has a hit in four straight games.
- Mitch Moreland (1-for-3, 2b, 2 bb, 2 so) extended his hitting streak to five games (7-for-19, .368).
- Rougned Odor (2-for-5, 2 r) recorded his 30th multiple hit contest of the year.
