WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers and A's conclude their season series this afternoon...Texas has won 2 straight and 3 of its last 4 games...club has also captured 8 of 10 and is 14-7 (.667) in September, the 2nd best winning percentage in the majors for the month to CHI at .682 (15-7)...team has won 9 of 12, 11 of 16, 18 of 26, 21 of 31, 27 of 39, and 35 of the last 52 games, the longer span beginning 7/29...club has gone 39-20 (.661) beginning 7/21, 2nd best in ML to TOR at .690 (40-18)...team's 40-23 (.635) record since the All-Star break is 2nd in A.L. and T3rd in ML (see chart at left)...club is 70-51 starting 5/10 and 74-53 since 5/4...at 82-69 (.542), team has the 4th-best record in the A.L...Texas is a season high 13 games above .500, its best record since the end of 2013 (91-72)...team was a season high 8 G under .500 on 5/3 (8-16)...Texas has dropped consecutive games just twice in the last 39 contests beginning 8/13.

A WINNING RECORD: The Rangers won their 82nd game of 2015 on Wednesday for their 6th winning season in the last 7 years (beginning 2009 every year but 2014), one of just 4 ML clubs to accomplish that feat to date (7--NYY and STL; 6--LAD)...ATL, SF and TB have 5 winning seasons since 2009 entering 2015...it is the 21st time in the club's 44 years in Texas that it has had a winning record for the year.

DRAMATIC IMPROVEMENT: At 82-69, Texas has 15 more wins than in all of 2014 (67-95)...the 15-win improvement is 2nd-best in MLB to only a +16 for the Cubs (89-63 in 2015, 73-89 in 2014) in 2015...the 15-win improvement is already the 5th-best in Rangers history (full seasons only), and only other year with an improvement that large since 1986 came in 2004 (+18).

FIRST PLACE RANGERS: Texas has had sole possession of 1st place in the A.L. West for the last 9 days beginning 9/15...that is the team's longest span of being along at the top since 23 straight days, 8/10-9/1/13...the Rangers increased their lead in the division to a season high 3.0 games on Tuesday, the 6th time in the last 10 days Texas has gained ground in the A.L. West...the current 3.0 game advantage is Texas' largest since 8/29/13 (+3.0 GA)...it the the club's biggest division lead in September since 9/28/12 (3.0 GA)...last larger advantage at any point was 8/23/13 (3.5 GA).

- Texas had not been alone in 1st place all season until win on 9/15 vs. HOU in game #144...became just 6th team in division era (since 1969) to take sole possession of a division lead for the 1st time in game #144-or-later of a season (credit Elias): 2012 A's (game no. 162), 2007 Phillies (160), 2006 Twins (162), 1978 Yankees (144), and 1973 Mets (154).
- Texas was 8.0 GB on 8/2 and 9.0 games out of 1st on 7/22...Rangers are trying to become 5th team in past 40 years and 1st since 2006 Twins to win its division after trailing by at least 8.0 games in August (credit Elias).
 The season-high 9.5-game deficit in 2015 (5/3, 5/19-20) is
- The season-high 9.5-game deficit in 2015 (5/3, 5/19-20) is the largest in club history before reaching 1st place at some point later in a campaign, as previous high was 9.0 GB before reaching 1st place in 1977.

ON THE ROAD: The Rangers have won 3 of 5 and 10 of the last 15 away from home, the longer span beginning 8/21...at 43-34 (558), the Rangers are tied with STL for 1st in wins and rank 3rd in the majors in road winning percentage (.573-STL; .560-CHI)...43 wins are T2nd most in club history after 77 road games: 46-31 in 1977; 43-34 in 1999 and 2013...Texas finished at 34-47 away from home in 2014...the Rangers' +9 in road wins from 2014 is 2nd most in ML to the Cubs at +10. and team's biggest improvement since 2007 (28-53) to 2008 (39-42).

VERSUS OAKLAND: Texas is 8-10 vs. the A's in 2015, winning 3 straight and 4 of 5...club is 5-4 at O.co Coliseum in 2015 and 12-6 since start of 2014...all-time, Texas leads, 342-332 overall and A's lead, 174-162 in Oakland.

AGAINST THE A.L. WEST: The Rangers are 32-36 (.471) in their own division in 2015...Texas is 12-4 against Houston but has combined for an 20-32 (.385) mark vs. Los Angeles, Oakland, and Seattle...club is 14-8 vs. the A.L. West beginning 8/17 and is 20-11 since 7/24...the Rangers are 17-17 in A.L. West parks in 2015.

ELVIS AND THE LONG BALL: Elvis Andrus' game-winning home run in the 4th inning on Wednesday was his career high 7th overall long ball, one more than in 2006...it was the 1st 3-run homer he has hit in his 27 total HR...Andrus entered last night's game with a .256 slugging percentage in 242 AB at O.co Coliseum, the lowest mark of any active players woith at least 200 AB in this park.

THREE-RUN DINGERS: In addition to Andrus, Adrian Beltre also connected for a 3-run homer on Wednesday...it was the the 2nd time in 8 days that Texas has a pair of HR with 2 men aboard (9/16 vs. HOU)...the Rangers have 7 3-run HR in the last 15 games beginning 9/8 after producing just 11 in the season's 1st 136 games...Texas had just 9 3-run homers in all of 2014...Texas and Tampa Bay are the only ML clubs without a grand slam in 2015.

SEPTEMBER SURGE: Adrian Beltre hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games at .458 (22-48) with 6 2B, 3 HR, and 17 RBI to rise from .261 to a season best .279...his 22 RBI in September are the most in the majors...Beltre has 37 RBI in his last 37 G starting 8/15, 2nd most in the majors in that span to 40 for TOR's Edwin Encarnacion...he had just 30 RBI in his 1st 95 games of 2015...the 3 RBI last night tied Jim Rice for 60th all-time with 1451 career RBI, 2 behind Eddie Mathews.

YOUTH IN SERVED: Rougned Odor connected for his 15th homer last night, the 2nd most ever in a season for a 2B at age 21 or under (age as of June 30 that season)...Odor passed Hall of Famer Joe Morgan and trails only Hall of Famer Bill Mazeroski, who had 19 HR for Pittsburgh in 1958... the only other Rangers with 15+ HR in a season at age 21 or younger are Ruben Sierra (1986 and 1987) and Juan Gonzalez (1991).

<u>WINNER:</u> Colby Lewis won his 17th game on Wednesday, one shy of the A.L. lead (Felix Hernandez and Dallas Keuchel)...it is the most wins for a Ranger since Matt Harrison (18) in 2012 and the most for a righthander since Scott Feldman (17) in 2009, matching most in last 16 years...Lewis joins Ferguson Jenkins (1978), Charlie Hough (1986 and 1987), and Kenny Rogers (2004) as the only Rangers to win at least 17 games in a year at the age of 35 or older.

ON TO HOUSTON: The Rangers will conclude the road portion of the regular season schedule with a 3-game series in Houston this weekend...Texas swept a 4-game set from the Astros in Arlington, 9/14-17 to go from 1.5 GB to a 2.5 game advantage in the A.L. West...Rangers are 12-4 vs. the Astros in 2015, winning the last 7, all at TEX since a loss on 7/19 at HOU, to capture to coveted Silver Boot for the 8th time in 9 years...club is 4-2 at Minute Maid Park in 2015.

--All 3 games of the HOU series will be nationally televised: Friday by ESPN, Saturday by FOX, and Sunday by TBS (Sunday blacked out in DFW market).

SHORTS: Rangers are 21-21 in day games in 2015, 12-12 on the road...this is the 10th time that Texas has won the 1st 2 games of a 3-game series in 2015...club is 5-4 in the finale of those series, winning the last 3...Texas bullpen has the majors' lowest ERA (2.10) and OPP AVG (.190) in September...Delino DeShields' 73 runs are 3rd most ever for a Texas rookie (87--Bump Wills, 1977; 82--Pete Incaviglia, 1986).

#35 Cole Hamels, LHP (10-8, 3.67)

TODAY: The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 30th start of the season and 10th in a Texas uniform in today's series finale against the A's here at O.co Coliseum...will be working on regular 4-days' rest, earning the win in his last start on Sat. vs. SEA, a 10-1 Texas victory...has gone 4-1, 3.73 (26 ER/62.2 IP) in his 9 G/GS w/ the Rangers, averaging just under 7.0 innings per start...is 4-0, 3.12 (17 ER/49.0 IP) his last 7 starts, dropping season ERA from 3.86 to 3.67...quality starts in 6 of those 7 outings, with 47 SO to 13 BB in that span...Rangers are 7-0 in those games after losing his 1st 2 starts...has allowed 7 or 8 hits in 8 of his 9 Texas starts...is 5-3, 4.36 (47 ER/97.0 IP) over his last 15 starts to raise his season ERA from 2.96...has received the 17th-lowest run support average (3.90 per 9 innings) in the majors in 2015...owns two of four 10+ SO performances by Texas starters in 2015 (Gallardo, 10 - 6/10 at OAK and Holland - 11, 8/30 vs. BAL)...missed a turn in the rotation on 8/13 at MIN due to left groin soreness, but has made 7 straight starts on schedule...threw his first career no-hitter on 7/25 at Wrigley Field, becoming 1st pitcher in ML history w/ a no-hitter in his last start before a midseason trade (see paragraph below)...joined Rangers after having spent his entire career in the Phillies organization since being selected in the first round of the 2002 June draft...has been a 3-time All-Star (2007, 2011, 2012), posted 200+ IP 6 times, had 6 different 10-win seasons, and was MVP of 2008 NLCS and 2008 World Series.

ON THE LEADERBOARD: His 9.27 SO/9 ranks 13th in MLB, 5th among lefties... has received the 17th-lowest run support average (3.90 per 9 innings) in MLB in 2015...ranked among NL leaders in strikeouts (T6th) and strikeouts per 9 innings (7th, 9.6) at time of trade.

• His 1904 career strikeouts are the 3rd-most among actives since the start of 2006, trailing only Felix Hernandez (2059) and Justin Verlander (1922)...his 118 wins in that span are T11th in MLB among active pitchers.

BEST FOR LAST: Hamels' 2.98 career ERA (111 ER/335.1 IP) in 51 G/50 GS in September ranks 8th among 64 active pitchers with 30+ Sept. starts...marks his 2nd-lowest ERA in any month (2.82 career ERA in Aug.)...in 9 Sept. starts in 2014-15: 4-3, 2.60 (20 ER/69.1 IP).

LAST START: Earned the win in the Rangers' 10-1 victory over Seattle on 9/19 in Arlington (7.0 IP, 7 H, 1 R-ER, 0 BB, 12 SO, 113 pitches/81 strikes), extending his winning streak to 4 games to match his longest run of the season...lone run of the outing came via a Franklin Gutierrez HR in the 2nd...recorded 5 of final 6 outs via punchout...was his 4th outing with 10 or more SO in 2015, 2nd in a Texas uniform, and 31st of his career...notched his 6th quality start in his last 7 outings...posted the first game of 12+ strikeouts and no walks by a Texas starter since Yu Darvish on 8/1/13 vs. ARI (14 K).

VS. OAKLAND: Has made only one start/appearance against the Athletics in his 10-year major-league career...took the loss on 6/25/11 at Citizens Bank Park with PHI despite allowing just 2 R-ER over 8.0 innings of work (8 H, 2 BB, 5 SO)...has never pitched at O.co Coliseum...current A's batters hold a .278/.316/.500 slash line, and 2 XBH (1 2B, 1 HR) in 19 PA.

ALL I NEED IS THREE: Since 2014, Hamels is 19-2 (.905) in 29 starts when receiving at least 3 runs of support...of his 302 career starts, Hamels has received 3 runs of support or more in 165 of them, going 105-16 (.868) in those games...has received 2 runs of support-or-less in 11 outings this season, but has received 3+ in every start with Texas, averaging 6.03 runs of support per 9 IP in that span.

THE NO-NO: Threw first career no-hitter on 7/5 vs. Cubs at Wrigley Field (9.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R-ER, 2 BB, 13 SO, 129 pitches/83 strikes)...logged his first CG of the season and recorded a season-best in SO...was T3rd-most K's in a no-hitter since 1995... most pitches in a game since a career-high 133 on 5/11/14 at NYM...hitless effort was 1st vs. Cubs since Sandy Koufax on 9/9/65, first at Wrigley Field since Cubs' Milt Pappas on 9/2/72...1st pitcher to throw a no-hitter for a team that entered game w/ worst record in baseball as late as 7/25 since Joe Bush for PHI A's vs. CLE on 8/26/1916...according to Elias, he is 2nd player in modern history w/ no-hitter in final start for a team, joining HOF'er Bert Blyleven (for TEX on 9/22/77 at CAL)...after season. Blyleven was traded to Pirates in a 4-team deal on 12/8/77.

WITH PHILADELPHIA: Went 6-7, 3.64 (52 ER/128.2 IP) over 20 G/GS, posting 137 SO to 39 BB with the Phillies prior to 7/31 trade...won 4 straight starts, 5/8-23; was his longest winning streak in consecutive starts since 5/6-28/12 (5 GS)...tossed 7.0+ IP while allowing 2 ER-or-fewer in a career-best 6 consecutive starts (5/8-6/3: 1.83 ERA, 9 ER, 44.1 IP)...named NL Player of the Week on 7/26 following his no-hitter.

2015: The California native has notched quality starts in 6 of his last 7 outings, T3rd-most in the majors (T1st in AL) in that span...has received 3 runs-or-less of support in 19 of 29 starts, including zero runs in 8 outings...LHBs have posted a .236/.315/.333 line compared to .244/.298/.379 by righties...last 4 starts opponents hitting .230/.275/.331/.606 with 37 SO and just 7 BB...is holding cleanup hitters to a .205/.295/.333 line...has retired the leadoff batter in 134 of 193 frames...opponents hitting .188 (42-223) with 2 outs and .219 (39-178) with RISP, including 4-for-32 (.125) in last 5 G...first time through order: .249 (58-233); 2nd time: .256 (60-234); 3rd time: .220 (49-223); 4th time: .243 (9-37)...Bobby Wilson caught first 2 Texas starts (5.93 ERA) and Chris Gimenez has been behind the plate in his last 7 outings (3.12 ERA), as Carlos Ruiz caught all 20 PHI starts (3.64 ERA) this season...took no-decision in his Texas debut on 8/1 vs. SF (7.2 IP, 5 R-ER)...in win 8/28 vs. BAL, faced minimum over final 5 IP of outing (1 BB, 0 H), needing just 55 pitches...was the 30th 10-SO performance of his career, 3rd of the season and 1st as a Ranger...3 walks in the 3rd inning were his most in an inning since a career high 4 on 4/29/14 vs. NYM (4th inning)...made career start no. 300 in his hometown on 9/2 at SD (ND).
