OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics snapped a five-game losing streak...also snapped a four-game home losing streak...are 7-10 over the last 17 games and 14-27 (.341) over the last 41 contests...are 1-3 against San Francisco this season...are 1-3 on the final homestand of the season, a six-game stand against Texas (0-3) and San Francisco (1-0).
- A's starting pitchers are 5-12 with an 8.03 ERA (94 er in 105.1 ip) in 22 games in September...have tossed five innings or fewer 12 times over that span.
- Sonny Gray recorded his 14th win of the season, which ties his career high from last season...is 2-1 with a 6.84 ERA (20 er in 26.1 ip) in five starts in September...is 4-4 with a 3.74 ERA (35 er in 84.1 ip) in 13 starts since the All-Star Break...is 2-0 with a 2.08 ERA (3 er in 13.0 ip) in two career starts against San Francisco...Has allowed nine home runs in his last nine starts.
- · Ryan Dull allowed the first home run of his career, a solo shot by Jarrett Parker in the seventh inning.
- Billy Burns (2-for-4, r, 2b, hr, 2 rbi) is 8-for-25 (.320) over the last seven games...is batting .340 (32-for-94) with 11 multiple hit games over his last 22 contests...recorded his team-leading 45th multiple hit game of the season.
- Billy Butler (1-for-3, r, hr, rbi, bb, k) has five home runs and 15 RBI in 22 games in September..
- Marcus Semien (0-for-3, bb, k) had his eight-game hitting streak snapped...was batting 10-for-28 (.357) over that span.
- Eric Sogard (2-for-4, 3b, rbi) is batting 11-for-32 (.344) over his past nine games...hit hit third triple of the season, first since Sept. 15 at Chicago-AL.
- Danny Valencia (1-for-4, 2b, k) extended his hitting streak to eight games and is 11-for-29 (.379) with five walks over that stretch.
- Stephen Vogt (0-for-4) is hitless in his last 18 at bats.

SAN FRANCISCO NOTES

- The San Francisco Giants have lost three consecutive games...are winless in their last six games at O.co Coliseum...have lost 19 of their last 25 road games...are 1-3 on their final road trip of the season, a six-game trip to San Diego (1-2) and Oakland (0-1).
- Mike Leake is 1-3 with a 6.97 ERA (16 er in 20.2 ip) over his last four starts...is 1-5 with a 4.86 ERA (25 er in 46.1 ip) in eight outings with the Giants...is 0-1 with a 3.75 ERA (5 er in 12.0 ip) in two career starts against Oakland...has allowed eight home runs in eight starts with the Giants.
- Marlon Byrd (1-for-4, rbi, 2 k) is batting .291 (35-for-121) with 27 RBI in 32 games with the Giants...is a career .311 (71-for-229) hitter against Oakland.
- Brandon Crawford (2-for-4, 2b) has hit safely in each of the last four games (7-for-14, .500)...recorded his 32nd multiple hit game of the season.
- Matt Duffy (1-for-4, 2 r, hr, 2 rbi) hit his first home run since Aug. 14 against Seattle, a two-run homer in the first inning...is a career .292 (19-for-65) hitter against Oakland...batting 4-for-17 (.235) on the current roadtrip.
- Jarrett Parker (1-for-3, r, hr, rbi, bb, 2 k) is 6-for-13 (.462) with five runs, a double, three home runs and five RBI since his Sept. 11 call-up.
- Buster Posey (2-for-4) snapped an 0-for-10 hitless streak with a single in the fourth inning...recorded his 45th multiple hit game of the year.
- Mac Williamson (2-for-4, k) made his first career start...recorded his first Major League hit with a single in the top of the fifth inning.
