OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost seven of the last eight games...with 91 losses, the A's clinched the worst record in the AL for the third time in Oakland history (1993 and 1997)...are 7-12 over the last 19 games and 14-29 (.326) over the last 43 contests...finished 1-5 against San Francisco this year...finished the year 34-47 at home, which is the second worst home record in Oakland history (1979)...sold out the O.co Coliseum for the third consecutive game and the sixth time this season...finished 1-5 on the final homestand of the season, a six-game stand against Texas (0-3) and San Francisco (1-2).
- A's starting pitchers are 5-13 with an 8.29 ERA (101 er in 109.2 ip) in 24 games in September... have tossed five innings or fewer 14 times over that span.
- Sean Nolin made his first career appearance against the Giants...is 1-2 with a 5.25 ERA (14 er in 24.0 ip) in five starts this season.
- Billy Burns (2-for-5, 2b, 2 rbi, 2 k) has hit safely in each of his last six games (8-for-26, .308)...is batting .333 (35-for-105) with 13 multiple hit games over his last 24 contests...recorded his team-leading 46th multiple hit game of the season.
- Billy Butler (1-for-4, r, k) is batting .319 (29-for-91) with six home runs and 17 RBI in 24 September games...is 8-for-20 (.400) against San Francisco this year.
- Max Muncy (1-for-1, r, 3b, rbi) snapped an 0-for-8 hitless streak with his first career triple in the sixth inning...has 20 hits, 11 of which are for extra bases (eight doubles, one triple, two homers).
- Marcus Semien (0-for-2, bb) has reached base safely in a career-high and A's season-high 18 consecutive games...is 15-for-58 (.259) with 11 walks during the streak.
- Danny Valencia (0-for-1, hbp) has reached base safely in each of his last 14 games, which is the longest such streak of his career...is 17-for-51 (.333) with seven walks over that span...had his nine-game hitting streak snapped, which was two short of his career high of 11 (July 18-27, 2011)...was batting 14-for-33 (.424) over that span.

- The San Francisco Giants have won four of the past seven games...won their first road series since taking two of three at Atlanta from Aug. 3-5...finished the season 37-44 on the road...are 4-12 at the O.co Coliseum against Oakland since 2010...finished 3-3 on their final road trip of the season, a six-game trip to San Diego (1-2) and Oakland (2-1).
- Chris Heston is 1-5 with a 4.86 ERA (26 er in 48.0 ip) over his last 10 starts...is 2-1 with a 2.87 ERA (10 er in 31.1 ip) in five career Interleague starts.
- Trevor Brown (1-for-3, 2 rbi, sf) is 6-for-17 (.353) in five games with the Giants.
- Brandon Crawford (1-for-3, 2 r, bb) is 8-for-20 (.400) over his last six games.
- Kelby Tomlinson (2-for-5, rbi) is 9-for-20 (.450) in his past four games...recorded his 12th multiple hit game of the year.
- Jarrett Parker (2-for-3, r. bb, k) is 11-for-20 (.550) with nine runs, a double, six home runs and 12 RBI in 11 games since his Sept. 11 call-up.
- Buster Posey (2-for-5, r) is 13-for-25 (.520) in six games against the A's this season...recorded his 47th multiple hit game of the season.
