OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have now started the season 0-2 four times over the last 10 years (2007, 2011, 2013)...now have a six-game losing streak against the White Sox at the Coliseum...that is Oakland's longest home losing streak to Chicago since Aug. 3, 1989-Sept. 18, 1990 when they also dropped six straight.
- Chris Bassitt** made his first career start and appearance against the White Sox.
- Jed Lowrie** (2-for-5, 2 rbi, 2 so) is a .312 (138-for-443) career hitter in the month of April, his best of any month.
- Marcus Semien** (2-for-3) has reached base safely in each of his last 25 games dating back to Sept. 6, 2015, which is the longest such streak of his career.

CHICAGO NOTES

- The **Chicago White Sox** have now started the season 2-0 for the fourth time in the last five seasons...are 2-0 on the road to start the season for the first time since 2011...have now won six straight games at the Coliseum dating back to last season.
- Jose Quintana** had a no decision, his 53rd no decision since 2012...that is the most in the majors over that span...is 4-3 with a 4.43 ERA (45 er in 91.1 ip) in 16 career starts in April.
- Jose Abreu** (2-for-5, 3 so) has hit safely in each of his last 11 games against Oakland dating back to 2015...is batting .415 (17-for-41) over that span.
- Adam Eaton** (3-for-5, r, 2 so) has now reached base safely in 24 consecutive games dating back to Sept. 9, 2015.
- Jimmy Rollins** (1-for-5, 2 r, hr, rbi) hit the go-ahead solo home run in the ninth inning.
