WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

The Chicago White Sox continue the 2016 season tonight against the Oakland Athletics ... LHP Jose Quintana, who ranked second in the American League with 25 guality starts in 2015, takes the mound for the White Sox.

 Quintana will be followed tomorrow by LHP Carlos Rodon and RHP Mat Latos in Thursday's finale.

Following this four-game series, the White Sox open the home portion of their schedule with three games vs. Cleveland (4/8-10) before taking a six-game, seven-day trip to Minnesota (4/11-14) and Tampa Bay (4/15-17).

■ The Sox have one off day in April (4/12) before beginning a stretch of 19 straight games without an off day from 4/13-5/1 they play 17 of their first 27 games on the road and nine of their first 42 outside the AL Central division.

TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

■ The White Sox are looking to start 2-0 for the third time in the last four seasons and 2-0 on the road for the first time since 2011. The Sox have won five straight games at The Coliseum fol-

lowing a seven-game losing streak ... they are looking for their first six-game winning streak in Oakland since 8/3/89-9/18/90. Jose Quintana, who makes his second career start at The

Coliseum, is 11-7 with a 2.88 ERA (52 ER/162.1 IP) over his last 25 road starts dating back to 6/19/14.

Adam Eaton has reached base safely in 23 consecutive games dating back to 9/9/15, hitting .376 (35-93) with a .453 on-base percentage and a .980 OPS.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

The White Sox scored all four of their runs in the third inning and held on for a 4-3 victory over Oakland.

Chris Sale earned the victory, allowing three runs on seven hits with eight strikeouts over 7.0 IP ... four relievers combined for 2.0 scoreless IP, with Zach Duke (0.1) and Nate Jones (0.2) posting holds and David Robertson (1.0) earning the save.

Adam Eaton gave the Sox a 1-0 lead with a RBI triple. Jimmy Rollins followed with a RBI single and 1B Mark Canha's error allowed two more runs to score

Rollins, 3B Todd Frazier, 2B Brett Lawrie, C Dioner Navarro and CF Austin Jackson made their White Sox debuts.

OPENING DAY LEFTOVERS

- The White Sox have won six of their last eight season openers to improve to 61-55 overall.
- Chris Sale improved to 3-0 with a 2.45 ERA (6 ER/22.0 IP) and 23 strikeouts in three career Opening Day starts.

SS Jimmy Rollins made his 16th consecutive Opening Day start, tied with Albert Puiols for the longest active streak in the major leagues ... Rollins (37 years, 126 days) became the Sox oldest Opening Day shortstop since Luke Appling (42 years, 17 davs) in 1949.

Adam Eaton became the first left-handed hitter to start in right field for Chicago on Opening Day since Harold Baines in 1987.

HOW THE WEST WAS WON

The White Sox are 22-12 (.636) vs. the American League West since 2015, the second-best winning percentage in the major leagues behind San Francisco (.650).

- Sox pitchers have recorded a 3.32 ERA (117 ER/317.1 IP) and have made 27 quality starts in 34 games
- Chicago's three-game sweep on 5/15-17 at Oakland was its first at The Coliseum since 5/16-18/97

SPRING RECAP

■ The White Sox went 17-13-1 in spring training, concluding with a pair of wins at San Diego from 4/1-2.

The Sox finished with a winning record in spring training for the first time since 2004 (15-13-1), and the 17 wins were their

most since 2003 (also 17). Chicago led the major leagues with 51 home runs, its most during spring training since at least 1980.

ROSTER QUICK FACTS

 The White Sox 25-man roster includes 12 pitchers (six lefties), two catchers, six infielders and five outfielders ... the average age is 28.8 (28.9 for position players and 28.6 for pitchers) ...

the rotation averages 27.0, compared to 29.7 for the bullpen. SS Jimmy Rollins (37) is the oldest player, LHP Carlos Rodon (23) is the youngest, and LHP John Danks (2007-) is the longest tenured, followed by LHP Chris Sale (2010-).

The White Sox began the season with no players on the disabled list (four in 2015) and no rookies (two in 2015) ... Rollins made the club as a non-roster invitee to spring training.

WHITE SOX VS. OAKLAND

The White Sox posted a 4-3 victory last night to improve to 2-2 all-time vs. Oakland on Opening Day.

The Sox have won 12 of their last 17 games overall against the A's, including five in a row at The Coliseum after losing the previous seven.

Chicago went 5-2 against Oakland last season (3-0 at The Coliseum) and won back-to-back season series (2014-15) against the A's for the first time since 1993-95.

■ The White Sox trail the all-time series, 282-300 ... they are 147-142 at home (88-82 at U.S. Cellular Field) and 135-158 on the road

FAMILIAR FACES

This series marks the return of shortstop Jimmy Rollins and coaches Todd Steverson and Greg Sparks to the Bay Area.

Rollins graduated in 1996 from Encinal High School in Alameda and was selected by Philadelphia in the second round of

the 1996 draft. Steverson worked nine seasons in the Oakland organization.

including two as the A's first base coach and two as the minorleague hitting coordinator.

Sparks spent 19 seasons (1997-2015) in the Athletics organization, including nine as the minor-league hitting coordinator.

A BUSY OFFSEASON

The White Sox Opening Day roster featured eight players who were acquired in the offseason, compared to 12 in 2015.

CAlex Avila (11/25), C Dioner Navarro (12/4), RHP Mat Latos (2/9), SS Jimmy Rollins (2/22) and OF Austin Jackson (3/7) were

signed as free agents. ■ INF Brett Lawrie (12/9 from Oakland) and INF Todd Frazier

(12/16 from Cincinnati) were acquired via trade ... INF/OF Jerry Sands (12/23 from Cleveland) was claimed off waivers.

QUALITY IS JOB ONE

The White Sox have made 1,158 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, the second-highest total in the major leagues behind the Mets (1,163).

The Sox led the American League with 98 guality starts in 2015, their highest total since 2003 (also 98) ... Jose Quintana (2nd, 25) and Chris Sale (5th, 23) ranked second and fifth in the AL in 2015.

ABREU IN ELITE COMPANY

Jose Abreu (2014-15) and Albert Pujols (2001-02) are the only players in major-league history to record 30-plus home runs and 100-plus RBI in each of his first two seasons.

Abreu batted .290 with 30 homers and 101 RBI last season after hitting .317 with 36 and 107 as a rookie in 2014

Pujols accomplished the feat in each of his first 10 seasons before the streak ended in 2011.

HONORING EDDIE

The White Sox mourn the loss of sports broadcasting legend and long-time Sox executive Eddie Einhorn, who passed away on 2/23/16 from complications involving a stroke

Einhorn, who was 80 years old, served as vice chairman of the White Sox for 25 years and was the team's president and chief operating officer from 1981-90 ... he also was a member of the Chicago Bulls board of directors.

The Sox will honor Einhorn by wearing an "Eddie" patch on their uniform sleeve during the 2016 regular season.

AT THE HELM

Robin Ventura is in his fifth season as White Sox manager

owns a 298-351 (.459) record, including a 76-86 mark in 2015. Ventura has managed 649 games with the Sox, 10th-most in franchise history ... was a finalist for American League Manager of the Year in 2012.

QUINTANA AT A GLANCE

The 27-year-old left-hander is making his first start of the season, fourth career vs. Oakland and second at the Oakland Coliseum Enters his fourth full season with the White Sox and fifth overall ... has made 32-plus starts every season since 2013 ... ranks ninth in baseball

with a 13.4 fWAR over the last three seasons. ■ Finished 2015 with 600 career strikeouts ... is attempting to reach the .500 mark for his career tonight with his 34th win (currently 33-34).

Is looking to extend his overall winning streak to a career-high four games \dots the streak began on 8/20/15 at Los Angeles-AL.

Is 19-16 with a 3.31 ERA (135 ER/367.1 IP) lifetime on the road.

Owns a 4-3 record with a 4.52 ERA (43 ER/85.2 IP) in 15 career starts

in April ... has gone 4-6 with a 3.82 mark (58 ER/136.2 IP) in 24 career outings (23 starts) vs. the American League West.

He and his wife, Michelle, welcomed their first child, daughter Ariana, this offseason

SPRING IS IN THE AIR

Went 1-1 with a 5.19 ERA (10 ER/17.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts over four spring starts ... opponents hit .254 with five walks

Suffered the loss in his final spring outing on 3/30 at Cincinnati, al-

lowing four runs on nine hits and three walks Recorded his only quality start on 3/25 at Seattle (2 ER/6.0 IP; 7 SO).

2015 SEASON IN REVIEW

■ Ranked among American League leaders in quality starts (2nd, 25), home runs per 9.0 IP (4th, 0.70), walks per 9.0 IP (5th, 1.92), strikeoutto-walk ratio (6th, 4.02), ERA (9th, 3.36) and IP (10th, 206.1).

Mike Leake ■ Established career highs in IP, QS, SO/BB ratio and walks per 9.0 IP.

Reached 30-plus starts, 200.0-plus IP and 160-plus strikeouts for the third straight season, joining Madison Bumgarner, Cole Hamels, Felix Hernandez, Jon Lester, Jeff Samardzija, Max Scherzer and James Shields as the only pitchers to accomplish the feat every season since 2013.

Became the first White Sox left-hander to make 30 starts in three straight seasons (2013-15) since Mark Buehrle did it in 11 consecutive from 2001-11.

Limited lefties to a .233 (42-180) average, while right-handers batted .283 (176-622).
Did not commit an error for the second straight season, the first White Sox starting pitcher to accomplish the feat since John Danks from 2010-11 (source: STATS LLC)

QUALITY ASSURANCE

- Made 25 quality starts in 2015, the second-most in the American League and tied for sixth-most in baseball . his 63 QS since 2013 rank third among AL left-handers and seventh among lefties in MLB over that span.
- Owns a 28-16 record when making a guality start (29 no decisions) ... the White Sox have scored a total
- of 15 runs in the 16 losses (one run or less 11 times), 148 in the 28 victories and 57 in the NDs.
- Chicago is 38-35 in his 73 career quality starts.

CONTROL FREAK

Has issued three walks or less in 113 starts, the fifth-most such outings in the American League since 2012 ... teammate Chris Sale (108) ranks seventh in the AL.

- Has issued one walk or fewer 55 times in his career ... owns a career 4.02 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- Did not issue a walk over four starts from 6/26-7/12/15, becoming the first White Sox to not allow a walk in four consecutive starts since Danny Darwin from 6/30-7/17/97 (also four).

(NO) DECISIONS, DECISIONS

Owns 52 career no decisions, the most in the major leagues since 2012 ... teammate Mat Latos is tied for sixth with 40 NDs during that span.

Established an American League and franchise record with 17 no decisions in 2013 ... set a franchise record with seven consecutive NDs from 6/1-7/4/13.

His seven career starts of 7.0 scoreless IP without earning a win are the most in club history ... previously shared the mark with Joel Horlen (six).

NOT DIGGING THE LONG BALL

Has allowed just 26 home runs since 2014, tied for the fourth-fewest among American League starters (minimum 40 starts).

■ Has allowed just 19 homers over his last 40 starts (258.2 IP) and 20 over his last 48 (309.0 IP) His career 0.77 homers-per-9.0 IP mark (63 HR/743.0 IP) is the ninth-lowest in the AL since 2012.

HELP IS ON THE WAY

Received a 3.62 RSA (83 RS/206.1 IP) in 2015, the fifth-lowest among American League starting pitchers. Owns a 3.91 lifetime RSA (323 RS/743.0 IP) in 122 career appearances, the second-lowest in the AL and sixth-lowest in baseball since 2012.

■ Has received the following run support marks in his 119 career starts: zero runs (18x), one run (26x), two runs (27x), three runs (16x), four runs (12x) and five runs (4x) ... has received six runs or more just 16 times, including double digits just three times.

NIGHT OWL

Went 9-5 with a 2.50 ERA (41 ER/147.1 IP) in 22 night starts in 2015 (0-5 with a 5.49 mark in day games) his 2.50 night ERA was the lowest in the AL and fifth-lowest in the majors

Is 26-21 with a 3.38 ERA (186 ER/495.2 IP) in 78 career starts at night, compared to 7-13 with a 3.64 ERA (100 ER/247.1 IP) over 44 appearances (41 starts) during the day.

OPENING TROUBLES

Allowed 26 runs in the first inning last season, the third-most in baseball ... owned a 7.03 ERA (25 ER/32.0 IP) in the opening frame in 2015 ... opponents hit .326 (44-135) with 18 extra-base hits in the first.
 Surrendered a first-inning run 16 times last season ... went 3-6 in those outings.

VS. OAKLAND ATHLETICS

■ Will make his fourth career start and appearance vs. Oakland ... has gone 0-0 with a 3.60 ERA (8 ER/20.0 IP) and 12 strikeouts lifetime... did not factor in the decision in his only career start at the Oakland Coliseum


