OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's snapped their season-opening two-game losing streak...snapped a six-game losing streak against the White Sox at The Coliseum, which was the longest home losing streak to Chicago-AL since Aug. 3, 1989 to Sept. 18, 1990 when they also dropped six straight.
- Sonny Gray is 8-1 with a 1.95 ERA (17 er in 78.1 ip) in 11 career starts in the month of April.
- Ryan Madson extended his regular season scoreless streak to 14 games and 13.0 innings dating back to last year by earning his first save of the season.
- Billy Burns (2-for-4, r) is 8-for-19 (.421) with two walks and five runs scored in seven career games agaisnt Chicago-AL.
- Mark Canha (1-for-4, r, hr, rbi, 2 so) recorded his first hit of the season, a home run to right field in the second inning.
- Jed Lowrie (0-for-3, rbi, sf) had a sacrifice fly in the first inning, and now has five RBI in the first three games.
- Marcus Semien (1-for-3, so) has reached base safely in each of the first three games and now has a career-high 26-game reaching base streak dating back to Sept. 6, 2015.

- The Chicago White Sox had their season-opening two-game winning streak snapped...had their six-game winning streak at The Coliseum snapped, which
 tied their longest such streak since also winning six straight from Aug. 3, 1989 to Sept. 18, 1990.
- Carlos Rodon is 0-1 with a 5.73 ERA (7 er in 11.0 ip) in two career starts against Oakland... is 4-2 with a 2.27 ERA (16 er in 63.1 ip) in 10 career starts against the American League West.
- Jose Abreu (1-for-4, so) has hit safely in each of his last 12 games against Oakland dating back to 2015...is batting .400 (18-for-45) over that span.
- Adam Eaton (2-for-3, bb) has now reached base safely in 25 consecutive games dating back to Sept. 9, 2015...has recorded two or more hits in each of the first three games of the season.
- Austin Jackson (1-for-3, r, 2b) has hit safely in each of his first three games with the White Sox...is batting .286 (3-for-10) to start the year.
- Jimmy Rollins (0-for-3, rbi, sf) had a sacrifice fly in the third inning, and now has three RBI in the first three games.
