OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** finished 1-3 on this season-opening four-game homestand against Chicago-AL...have not started a season 1-3 since they did so in consecutive years from 2011-12...leave following the game today for a three-game road trip to Seattle.
- Kendall Graveman made his first career start against the White Sox...has lost each of his last six decisions dating back to last season, which is the longest losing streak of his career...has a 6.08 ERA (27 er in 44.0 ip) over that span.
- Chris Coghlan (2-for-4, rbi, 2 so) broke up a no-hit bid with a single to left field in the fifth inning with one out.
- Andrew Lambo (0-for-1) made his A's debut with a pinch-hit ground out in the seventh inning.
- Marcus Semien (0-for-1, bb) has reached base safely in each of the first four games and now has a career-high 27-game reaching base streak dating back to Sept. 6, 2015.

- The Chicago White Sox finished 3-1 on this season-opening four-game road trip against Oakland...have won consecutive series at The Coliseum for the first time since 2008-09...leave following the game today for a three-game homestand with Cleveland.
- · Robin Ventura recorded his 300th win as White Sox manager.
- Mat Latos made his White Sox debut...is 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 er in 15.1 ip) in three career appearances, two starts, against Oakland.
- Matt Albers extended his career-high scoreless streak to 22 appearances and 24.1 innings dating back to Aug. 5, 2015.
- Jose Abreu (1-for-4, r, hr, 3 rbi, so, sf) has hit safely in each of the first four games of the season (.313, 5-for-16)...has hit safely in each of his last 13 games against Oakland dating back to 2015...is batting .388 (19-for-49) over that span.
- Adam Eaton (2-for-5, 2b, so) is the first player to open the season with four straight multi-hit games for the White Sox since Nellie Fox in 1955...is the only AL player with four multi-hit games this season...has now reached base safely in 26 consecutive games dating back to Sept. 9, 2015.
- Tyler Saladino (2-for-4, r, rbi, so) recorded his first hit of the season in his first at-bat of the year, a single in the third inning.
