OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** snapped a season-high four-game losing streak...snapped a five-game home losing streak, which matched the A's longest home losing streak from last year (April 11-26 and Sept. 1-6)...snapped a five-game home losing streak against the Royals, which was the second longest such streak in Oakland history (7, Sept. 11, 1987 to Sept. 16, 1988)...are 1-4 on this six-game homestand against Los Angeles-AL (0-3) and Kansas City (1-1).
- Sonny Gray is 9-2 with a 2.08 ERA (21 er in 90.2 ip) in 13 career starts in the month of April...is 1-2 with a 2.77 ERA (8 er in 26.0 ip) in four career starts against Kansas City...tossed 114 pitches, which is the third-most of his career.
- John Axford has not allowed a run in his first six games and 6.2 innings (7 h, 3 so).
- Yonder Alonso (2-for-3, r, bb) snapped a 0-for-13 hitless streak with a single to leadoff the second inning...recorded his first multi-hit game of the year.
- Josh Reddick (1-for-4, r, hr, 3 rbi, bb) is 8-for-27 (.296) with eight RBI over his last eight games after going 2-for-13 (.154) with no RBI over his first four contests.
- Marcus Semien (0-for-3, r, rbi, bb, 2 so, sf) had his five-game hitting streak snapped...was batting 6-for-15 (.400) over that span.
- Stephen Vogt (2-for-4, r, hr, rbi) homered in consecutive games for the third time in his career (last: Aug. 29-30, 2015).

- The **Kansas City Royals** had their season-high four-game winning streak snapped...had its five-game winning streak against Oakland at the Coliseum snapped...are 4-2 on this seven-game road trip against Houston (3-1) and Oakland (1-1).
- Chris Young is 4-5 with a 3.86 ERA (25 er in 58.1 ip) in 12 career appearances, including 11 starts, against Oakland.
- Lorenzo Cain (1-for-4, rbi, so) has hit safely in each of his last five games...is batting 6-for-20 (.300) over that span...is a career 11-for-33 (.333) hitter at the Coliseum
- Eric Hosmer (1-for-4, so) has hit safely in each of his last seven games, batting 11-for-30 (.367) over that span.
- Omar Infante (1-for-3, 2 r, bb, so) has hit safely in a team-high eight straight games, batting .323 (10-for-31) over that span...Is batting .327 (16-for-49) against Oakland since the start of 2014.
