OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** snapped a two-game losing streak but are just 2-5 in the last seven games...are 41-23 all-time against Houston, including a 22-11 mark in Oakland..are 1-0 on this six-game homestand against Houston (1-0) and Seattle (three games).
- Sean Manaea made his Major League debut.
- Billy Burns (2-for-4, so) has hit safely in each of his last four games (.313, 5-for-16) and 11 of his last 12 (.280, 14-for-50)...is batting .362 (17-for-47) at night...was thrown out attempting to steal a base for the first time this season, but was 1-for-2 on the night and is 7-for-8 (87.5 percent) in stolen base attempts.
- Yonder Alonso had his first career walk-off home run...it was his third career game-ending RBI
- Chris Coghlan (1-for-3, r) snapped an 0-for-13 hitless streak with a single in the second inning.
- Coco Crisp (2-for-3, 2 r, hr, rbi, bb) is 8-for-23 (.348) over his last seven games after going 0-for-15 over his previous five contests...recorded his fifth multiple-hit game of the season.
- Khris Davis (1-for-4, 2b) extended his hitting streak to 6 games (8-for-24, .333)...is batting .325 (13-for-40) with three home runs and eight RBI over his last 10 games after hitting .143 with no home runs and one RBI over his first 12 contests.
- Jed Lowrie (0-for-3, rbi, so, sf) had his A's season-high tying seven-game hitting streak snapped...was batting .459 (17-for-37) over that span.
- Marcus Semien (1-for-3, r, hr, rbi) snapped a 0-for-8 hitless streak with a home run in the eighth inning.

HOUSTON NOTES

- The **Houston Astros** are 1-4 in the last five games and 2-8 over the last 10...are 23-41 all-time against the A's, including a11-22 mark in Oakland...are 0-4 against left-handed pitchers this season...are 1-3 on this six-game road trip to Seattle (1-2) and Oakland (0-1).
- Mike Fiers is 0-1 with a 3.28 ERA (9 er in 24.2 ip) in four career starts against Oakland...is 0-1 with a 3.38 ERA (7 er in 18.2 ip) in three career starts at the Coliseum.
- Jose Altuve (0-for-4) had his 20-game streak of reaching base safely snapped.
- Evan Gattis (2-for-4, 2 r, hr, 2 rbi, 2 so) has hit safely in each of his last games and is 7-for-17 (.412) over that span...recorded his third multi-hit game of the season...hit his first home run of the season in the second inning.
- Marwin Gonzalez (1-for-4, 2b, rbi, so) snapped an 0-for-8 streak with a double in the sixth inning.
- George Springer (1-for-3, r, hbp) extended his season-high hitting streak to eight games (11-for-33, .333)...reached base safely in each of his last 14 games and 51 of his last 55, dating back to June 27, 2015.
