OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** won their second consecutive game...are 5-7 at home...are now 42-23 all-time against Houston, including a 23-11 mark in Oakland...are 2-0 on this six-game homestand against Houston (2-0) and Seattle (three games)...finish the month of April with a winning record for the third time in the last four years.
- Jesse Hahn** earned the win in his 2016 debut...it was his first start since July 1, 2015 against Colorado as he spent the final three months of the 2015 on the disabled list with a strained right forearm.
- John Axford** has not walked a batter in his 12.1 innings pitched.
- Billy Burns** (1-for-4, 2 rbi) has hit safely in each of his last five games (.300, 6-for-20) and 12 of his last 13 (.296, 16-for-54).
- Khris Davis** (0-for-4, so) had his six-game hitting streak snapped...was 8-for-24 (.333) during that span...is batting .295 (13-for-44) with three home runs and eight RBI over his last 11 games after hitting .143 with no home runs and one RBI over his first 12 contests.
- Josh Phegley** (1-for-2, r, bb, 2b) is 5-for-13 over his last four games and is hitting a team-high .360.

- Evan Gattis** (0-for-3, bb, so) had his four-game hitting streak snapped...was 7-for-17 (.412) over that span.
- George Springer** (0-for-3, bb, so) had his season-high eight-game hitting streak snapped, but has reached base safely in each of his last 15 games.
