## OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's had their two-game winning streak snapped and are now 2-3 in the last five games...with the loss, the A's currently have a streak of 39 consecutive home series of three or more games without a sweep, which is the longest such streak in Oakland history (previous: 35, May 13, 1983-Aug. 1, 1984)...are 11-11 against the Astros dating back to the start of 2015...are 2-1 on this six-game homestand against Houston (2-1) and Seattle (three games).
- Rich Hill is 3-2 with a 2.15 ERA (7 er in 29.1 ip) over his last five starts... is 0-3 with a 4.85 ERA (7 er in 13.0 ip) in three starts at home compared to 3-0 with a 0.95 ERA (2 er in 19.0 ip) in three road starts.
- Billy Burns (0-for-4, so) had his five-game hitting streak snapped...was batting 6-for-20 (.300) over that span.
- Chris Coghlan (1-for-4, r) snapped an 0-for-8 streak with a single in the seventh inning.
- Khris Davis (1-for-4, so) is batting .292 (14-for-48) with three home runs and eight RBI over his last 12 games after hitting .143 with no home runs and one RBI over his first 12 contests.
- Jed Lowrie (1-for-4, 2b, so) is batting .404 (19-for-47) with six multiple hit games over his last 13 games after hitting .209 over his first 12 contests.
- Marcus Semien (1-for-4, rbi, so) is batting .306 (11-for-36) at home compared to .130 (6-for-46) on the road.

## HOUSTON NOTES

- The Houston Astros snapped their two-game losing streak, but are just 2-5 over the last seven games and 3-9 over the last 12...won their first game against a left-handed starter this season (1-4)...are now 11-11 against Oakland dating back to the start of the 2015 season...finished 2-4 on this six-game road trip to Seattle (1-2) and Oakland (1-2)...will return to Houston following today's game for a 10-game homestand against Minnesota (three games), Seattle (four games), and Cleveland (three games).
- Doug Fister is 6-6 with a 3.40 ERA (31 er in 82.0 ip) in 14 career starts against Oakland... is 3-4 with a 3.16 ERA (15 er in 42.2 ip) in eight career starts at the Coliseum.
- Jose Altuve (1-for-3, r, hr, rbi, bb, so, gidp) snapped an 0-for-9 streak with a leadoff home run...it was his eighth career leadoff home run, the fourth this season...it is the most in a season by an Astro since Craig Biggio had six in 2006...is a career .325 (82-for-252) hitter against the A's.
- Jason Castro (1-for-3, r, bb, so) has hit safely in a season-high three consecutive games (.333, 3-for-9).
- George Springer (0-for-4, so) had his streak of reaching base safely snapped at 15 games.
