### THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY:

#### MAY 1

**1969** - For only the 2nd time in Major League history, back-to-back no-hitters are tossed...Astros RHP **Don Wilson** tallies 13 strikeouts in his 2nd career no-hitter, a 4-0 win over the Reds at Crosley Field...Reds RHP **Jim Maloney** had no-hit the Astros the day before.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Astros will conclude this 6-game, 7-day, 2-city road trip with the finale of this 3-game series today at the Coliseum, with the 1st pitch scheduled for 3:05 p.m. CT...RHP **Doug Fister** (1-3) will get the start for Houston opposite LHP **Rich Hill** (3-2) and the Oakland A's.

**VS. OAK:** The Astros went 10-9 against the A's last year, including a 5-5 record at the Coliseum...Houston has 2 pitchers that are former A's in RHP **Luke Gregerson** (2014) and RHP **Pat Neshek** (2012-13), while the A's have 2 former Astros on their roster in IF **Jed Lowrie** (2012, 2015) and RHP **Fernando Rodriguez** (2011-12).

**TO THE LEFT:** The Astros enter today's game leading all American League clubs in batting average (.274) and on-base percentage (.367) against left-handed pitchers, while ranking 2nd in slugging (.452)...today will be the club's 5th game opposite a left-handed starter as they enter today's game with the 4th fewest plate appearances (169) in the AL opposite lefties.

**ON THE BUMP:** RHP **Doug Fister**, who has recorded consecutive quality starts for the club, will be making his 5th start as an Astro today after joining the club on a 1-year deal this offseason...just 2 years ago, Fister was 1 of the best pitchers in the Majors (16-6, 2.41 ERA) before an injury-plagued 2015 campaign in which he went 5-7 with a 4.19 ERA (48ER/103IP) in 25 appearances, including 15 starts.

**ABOUT YESTERDAY:** The Astros were shut out for the 1st time this season as they collected only 4 hits in their 2-0 loss to RHP **Jesse Hahn** (1-0) and the A's...the pitching was stellar, as RHP **Chris Devenski** (0-1) received the loss despite allowing just 2 runs in 5.0 innings in what was his 1st Major League start.

**DEVENSKI GETS THE START:** RHP **Chris Devenski** made his 1st Major League start of his career yesterday as he slid into the rotation spot of RHP **Scott Feldman**...Devenski continued to impress, as he now leads all AL rookies in ERA (1.45), while ranking 2nd in innings pitched (18.2), tied for 3rd in strikeouts (16) and 5th in opponent batting average (.239) (min. 10 IP).

**INJURY UPDATES:** CF **Carlos Gomez** was not in the lineup yesterday after being diagnosed with left rib cage soreness, which was sustained on his 9th-inning dive in the outfield on Friday...X-rays on his rib cage came back negative and he is day to day...RHP **Lance McCullers**, who's on the DL with right shoulder soreness, threw 3.0 innings in an extended Spring Training game on Wednesday, and is scheduled to throw 4.0 innings in extended Spring Training tomorrow.

**TEAM RANKINGS:** Among American League teams, the Astros rank 2nd in extra-base hits (80) and in doubles (49), while ranking tied for 3rd in stolen bases (18) and in home runs (29).

**PLAYERS OF THE MONTH:** With American League Player of the Month ballots going out today, the Astros have several players in consideration...both **2B Jose Altuve** (11 doubles, 1.011 OPS) and **LF Colby Rasmus** (7 HR, 19 RBI) are on the AL Player of the Month ballot, while **1B Tyler White** (19 H, 14 RBI) and RHP **Chris Devenski** (1.45 ERA, 7g) are among the AL Rookie of the Month candidates.

**APRIL SHOWERS:** **2B Jose Altuve** is the 1st player in Major League history to reach 11 doubles and 9 stolen bases in April of any single season...the last Major League player to reach both marks in any month was also Altuve (11 2B, 9 SB) in May of 2014...prior to Altuve, the last player to reach both marks in a single month was **2B Jason Kipnis** (12 2B, 9 SB) in June of 2013.

**YES WAY JOSE:** **2B Jose Altuve** is closer towards the top of multiple leaderboards across Major League Baseball...Altuve leads the Majors in steals (9), ranks tied for 1st in doubles (11), while ranking tied for 3rd in the AL in runs scored (20), tied for 4th in OBP (.400), 5th in slugging (.611) and 6th in OPS (1.011).

**COLBY JACK:** **LF Colby Rasmus** is the 1st Astros player to hit 7 home runs thru the club's first 24 games of a season since 2006, when **1B Lance Berkman** (10) and **3B Morgan Ensberg** (9) each did so....Berkman finished with 45 home runs that season, while Ensberg finished with 23.

**ON-BASE STREAK:** **RF George Springer** has reached base safely in 15 consecutive games and in 52 of his last 56 games, dating back to June 27, 2015...his 15-game streak ties as the 2nd-longest active on-base streak in the AL along with **Mark Trumbo** and trailing only **Joe Mauer** and his 24-game streak.

**STRONG-WILLED:** Since allowing a run in his 1st outing of the season, RHP **Will Harris** has ran off 9 consecutive scoreless appearances (9.2IP), while allowing just 1 walk and 6 hits in that time frame...among relievers with at least 10 innings pitched this season, Harris' 0.82 ERA ranks tied for 8th in the AL.

**CLUBHOUSE HOURS/HINCH AVAILABILITY:** The Astros clubhouse will be open to the media today from 10:15-11:05 a.m...Astros manager **A.J. Hinch** will be available to the media at 11:05 a.m. in the Astros dugout.

**BALLPARK PASS:** Fans can catch 7 games out of the Astros upcoming 10-game homestand with the Astros Ballpark Pass for May, a ticket special which gets fans entrance to all 10 Monday-Thursday home games in May for just \$49...the sale ends today at 5 p.m. CT and can be accessed at [www.astros.com/ballparkpass](http://www.astros.com/ballparkpass).

**KEUCHEL'S KORNER:** The Astros will kick off their 10-game homestand tomorrow with the 2nd edition of Keuchel's Korner, presented by Houston Methodist...tickets for the dedicated fan section, located in sections 105 and 106, include a signature **Dallas Keuchel** beard giveaway and an exclusive Keuchel's Korner T-shirt.

**LAST START - 4/25 AT SEA:** after a rocky start to the season, posted his 2nd consecutive quality start, despite taking the loss to Seattle... allowed 3 runs on a season-low 4 hits in 6.0 innings...is the putting together consecutive quality starts 1st time since 5/3-9/15.

- walked a career high 7 batters in the game...became one of 8 pitchers since 2011 to walk at least 7 batters in a quality start.

**MR. FISTER:** 32-year-old signed a 1-year contract with Houston as a free agent this offseason...has spent the last 2 seasons with Washington, following a stint with Detroit that lasted from 2011-13.

- has started 171 games in the Majors in his career, posting a 66-66 record and a 3.47 ERA (427ER/1108.1IP) in those starts.

- his 3.42 ERA from the 2011-15 seasons ranked 15th in the Majors in that time frame...posted an ERA below 3.70 in 4 of those 5 seasons.

**VS. OAK:** will be making his 14th career appearance against Oakland today...is 5-6 with a 3.58 ERA (30ER/75.1IP)...last faced the A's on 5/9/14, taking the loss as he gave up 7 runs (5 earned) on 9 hits in only 4.1 innings.

**IN CONTROL:** has a career 1.82 walks per 9.0 innings ratio, which is the best mark among all active Major League pitchers with at least 1000 innings pitched.

**SUNS OUT, GUNS OUT:** will be making his 1st daytime start of the season...in his career, has fared better in day games...is 24-15 with a 3.06 ERA (118ER/346.2IP), compared to being 45-51 with a 3.65 ERA (309ER/761.2IP) at night.

**THIS SPRING:** struck out 16 batters in 16.1 Spring Training innings...gave up 15 runs (8.27 ERA) in his 5 official starts.

**ASTROS FRONT COURT:** at 6-foot-8, joins RHP J.R. Richard (6'8") and LHP Randy Johnson (6'10") as the tallest pitchers in Astros history.

**AS A NAT:** spent the 2014-15 seasons with Washington...in 2015, made 15 starts before converting to a relief role in early August...battled right forearm soreness that landed him on the DL on May 15...began the season strong, going 2-1 with a 2.87 ERA (12ER/37.2IP) in his first 6 starts of the year.

- in 2014, finished 8th in the NL Cy Young Award voting after going 16-6 with a 2.41 ERA (44ER/164IP)...ranked 4th in the NL in ERA and led the Nats with a career-high 16 wins.

**WHEN IT MATTERS MOST:** carries a tremendous track record in the postseason, as his 2.60 ERA (16ER/55.1IP) in 9 postseason games (8 starts) ranks 4th among active MLB pitchers behind only RHP Matt Cain (2.10), LHP Madison Bumgarner (2.14) and RHP Colby Lewis (2.38).

- pitched in the postseason in 4 straight years, including the World Series in 2012 with DET, the ALCS from 2012-13 with DET and the ALDS in 2014 with WSH.

**LAST START - 4/26 AT SEA:** took his 3rd loss of the season, giving up 5 runs in 6.0 innings with 5 strikeouts.

**ABOUT KEUCHEL:** tomorrow will be Keuchel's 6th start of the season...28-year-old is coming off one of the greatest individual seasons in club history in which he went 20-8 with a 2.48 ERA...was named the 2015 AL Cy Young Award winner while receiving his 2nd consecutive Rawlings Gold Glove Award.

- led the AL in wins (20), innings (232.0), groundball to flyball ratio (3.68) and WAR (7.2) while setting a club record for K's by a LHP (216).

**AT MMP:** has won 17 consecutive games at Minute Maid Park, which dates back to his final start of the 2014 season (9/20/14 vs. SEA)...his streak is tied for the 8th-longest home winning streak in MLB history, most recently accomplished by RHP Jose Fernandez (2013-15)...in that span, Keuchel has gone 17-0 with a 1.36 ERA (22ER/145.1IP), 151 strikeouts and 19 quality starts in 20 games.

**MAY DAY:** will be making his 1st start in the month of May tomorrow... has found success in May throughout his career, going 10-5 with a 3.30 ERA (47ER/128IP).

- was named AL Pitcher of the Month for May 2015... went 4-1 in his 6 starts in May '15, posting a 2.62 ERA (13ER/44.2IP) and 38 strikeouts while allowing a .223 opponent average...closed the month with back-to-back complete game efforts.

- went 0x3 with a walk yesterday...had his streak of reaching base safely in 19 straight games snapped on Friday...that streak ranks as the 3rd-longest on-base streak in the AL this season and was the 2nd-longest streak in his career...hit .351 (27x77) with a .438 OBP in the streak.
- is the 1st player in Major League history to reach 11 doubles and 9 stolen bases in April in a single season...the last Major League player to reach both marks in any month was also Altuve (11 2B, 9 SB) in May of 2014...prior to Altuve, the last player to reach both marks in a single month was **2B Jason Kipnis** (12 2B, 9 SB) in June of 2013.
- hit his 3rd leadoff homer of the season on Wed. at SEA...marked the 7th leadoff homer of his career...is the 1st Astros player to record 3 leadoff home runs in a single season in the month of April...his 17 extra-base hits in April were the 2nd-highest total in a single month in his career, trailing only his 2015 September (19 extra-base hits).
- leads MLB in steals (9, is 9-for-10), ranks T-1st in doubles (11) and tied for 4th in runs (20)... among AL hitters, ranks T-4th in OBP (.400), 5th in slugging (.611) and 6th in OPS (1.011).
- has been a much more patient hitter this season compared to last...his swing % is down to 39.8% from 52.2% in 2015...he has swung at less pitches out of the strike zone (20.6% from 37.7% in '15) and has increased his walk rate (10.9% from 4.8% in '15).
- named the **AL Co-Player of the Week** for the 2nd week of the season along with **Mark Trumbo** was his 2nd career Player of the Week award.
- leads MLB in batting avg. vs. LHP's (.353, 263x745) since his debut season of 2011.
- has hit safely in 26 of his 31 career games at the Coliseum, which included a 20-game hitting streak at the stadium from Sept. 5, 2013-Aug. 9, 2015...is hitting .328 (44x134) with 7 doubles and 11 RBI in his career at the Coliseum.

- ranks T-3rd in the AL in triples...became the 2nd catcher since 2000 to record 2 triples within his club's first 9 games of a season, joining **J.P. Arencibia** (2011 with TOR).
- has recorded 151 extra-base hits as a catcher, which ranks 3rd in club history behind **Brad Ausmus** (222) and **Alan Ashby** (210)...ranks 2nd in club history for HR by a catcher (48), trailing **Ashby** (69).
- has been the top pitch framing catcher in the game this season...per Baseball Prospectus, leads all ML catchers in framing runs (5.3)...**Yasmani Grandal** ranks 2nd with 3.0.
