### OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost consecutive games to snap a two-game winning streak and are 3-4 in the last seven contests...the losses also snap a season-high four-game home winning streak...lost to Seattle for the first time this season but are 3-1 in the season series...have a five-game home losing streak against Seattle dating back to July 5, 2015, which is the A's second longest home losing streak against the Mariners (8, July 6, 2007-April 17, 2008)...are now 47-52 against the Mariners over the last six years...are now 5-5 (.500) in one-run games...are winless when playing on Monday (0-4)...are 2-2 on this six-game homestand against Houston (2-1) and Seattle (0-1).
- Kendall Graveman has allowed 10 runs in his last 11 innings over his last two starts after allowing four runs in 17.2 innings over his first three starts...is 0-2 with a 3.57 ERA (7 er in 17.2 ip) in three starts at home this season.
- · Mark Rzepczynski allowed his first inherited runner to score...had stranded each of his first 11 inherited runners.
- Khris Davis (2-for-4, 2 r, 2 hr, 3 rbi, so) hit two home runs, his seventh career two-home run game (last: Sept. 27, 2015 at St. Louis)...is batting .308 (16-for-52) with five home runs and 11 RBI over his last 13 games after hitting .143 with no home runs and one RBI over his first 12 contests.
- Josh Reddick (1-for-4, r, so) is batting .300 (15-for-50) over his last 12 games...has a .317 (20-for-63) average at night.
- Stephen Vogt (3-for-4, 2b, so) is batting .315 (17-for-54) with three home runs and five RBI over his last 14 games...is batting .340 (18-for-53) at night compared to .167 (5-for-30) during the day...recorded his sixth multi-hit game and third three-hit game of the season.

### **SEATTLE NOTES**

- The Seattle Mariners are 9-4 in their last 13 games and 12-5 in the last 17...are 9-4 in road contests this season...won their first game against the A's this season (1-3) and are 14-6 against Oakland dating back to the start of the 2015 season...have a five-game winning streak against the A's in Oakland dating back to July 5, 2015...have won each of the last four starts by Nathan Karns...are 1-0 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (1-0) and Houston (four games).
- Nathan Karns is 3-0 with a 3.09 ERA (8 er in 23.1 ip) over his last four starts...is 2-0 with a 4.41 ERA (8 er in 16.1 ip) in three starts on the road this season.
- Norichika Aoki (2-for-4, r, 2b, bb, so) has hit safely in all 13 career games against the A's and is batting .346 (18-for-52) over that span...the 13-game hitting streak is tied for the second-longest active streak against Oakland behind Boston's Dustin Pedroia (14) with Chicago-AL's Jose Abreu (13).
- Robinson Cano (3-for-4, 2 r, 2b) becomes the fifth second baseman with 2,000 hits, 450 doubles, 200 home runs and 1,000 RBI...recorded his seventh multi-hit game and second three-hit game this season.
- Nelson Cruz (3-for-4) snapped an 0-for-10 hitless streak with a single in the first inning...recorded his team-leading ninth multi-hit game and first three-hit game this season.
- Ketel Marte (1-for-4, so) has reached base safely in all 13 career games against Oakland...is batting .360 (18-for-50) over that span.
