TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue a 7-game, two-city road trip with the second of three games against Oakland (1-0)...will also play at Houston (4 G) on this trip...on recently concluded homestand, took 2-of-3 from AL West rival the Houston Astros, before taking two of three from the Kansas City Royals... tonight's game will be televised in the Mariners TV market on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners are 9-4 in their last 13 games, 12-5 in their last 17...are 12-5 since a 5-game losing streak...are 5-7 at home, but 9-4 on the road...played 12 of first 18 games of the season away from Safeco Field.

- **Runs/Game** - the Mariners are averaging 4.20 runs per game, ranking 5th in the American League.
- **Goodbye Baseball** - The Mariners homered in 9 straight games April 21-30, their longest streak this season...their 15 home runs since April 21 rank 4th in the AL & T7th in MLB (also: NYM).
- **For Openers** - the Mariners are 5-4 in the first game of a series; 9-7 in all other games.
- **Batting Around** - the Mariners have batted around (10 men to plate) once this season (4/5 at TEX).

COLISEUM SUCCESS...the Mariners are 20-11 at the Oakland Coliseum since the start of the 2013 season, including 5 straight wins...Seattle was 7-3 against the A's in Oakland last season...Seattle is undefeated in its last 5 series in Oakland (4-0-1)...have not lost a series in Oakland since April 3, 5-6, 2014 (2nd game postponed due to poor field conditions).

KEEPING THINGS CLOSE...of the last 13 games at the Coliseum between these two clubs, seven games have been decided by one run, including the last two games...nine of those 13 games have been decided by three runs or less...Seattle is 7-0 in the last seven games decided by one run at the Coliseum.

BULLPEN BULLIES...Seattle's bullpen has posted a 1.57 ERA (8 ER, 46.0 IP) with 52 strikeouts in its last 16 games since April 13...in that span, the bullpen has the best ERA in Majors ahead of Chicago-AL (1.65), Oakland (2.21) & Kansas City (2.24)...overall, Seattle's bullpen has a 2.41 ERA (19 ER, 71.0 IP), which ranks 4th in the Majors behind Chicago-AL (1.60), Baltimore (2.23) and Kansas City (2.33)...four Mariners relievers have ERA's under 2.50: **Steve Cishek** (0.75), **Nick Vincent** (1.74), **Vidal Nuno** (2.16) and **Joel Peralta** (2.45)...**Tony Zych** (3.00) and **Mike Montgomery** (3.09) are right behind.

ROAD TRIPPIN'...**Nelson Cruz** went 3-for-4 last night and has hit safely in his last 6 road games...overall on the road, he's hitting .360 (18x50) with 7 runs, 4 doubles, 3 home runs, 9 RBI and a 1.051 OPS in 13 games...his .360 batting average is the 7th-best road average in the American League.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN...the Mariners are 9-4 on the road this season, T3rd-best record in the American League behind Chicago (12-5), Boston (7-3) and tied with Detroit (9-4)...Seattle has won all four road series this season, winning two of three at Texas, at New York-AL, at Cleveland & at Los Angeles-AL...the last time the Mariners won four straight road series to open a season was part of a 7-series streak in 2001.

KUMA & THE KING...**Hisashi Iwakuma** & **Felix Hernandez** are a combined 14-4 with a 2.76 ERA (55 ER, 179.1 IP) with 143 strikeouts in 26 starts against the Athletics in Oakland...Felix is 11-3 with a 2.67 ERA (46 ER, 155.0 IP) with 126 strikeouts in 22 starts at the Coliseum, while Iwakuma is 3-1 with a 3.33 ERA (9 ER, 24.1 IP) with 17 strikeouts in four starts.

ROAD OPS...the Mariners have three players in the Top-12 in the American League for road OPS...**Nelson Cruz** (1.051) ranks 4th, **Robinson Canó** (1.014) ranks 8th and **Seth Smith** (.958) ranks 12th...Seattle's .769 road OPS ranks 3rd-best in the American League behind Boston (.811) & Detroit (.789).

ELITE 2B...**Robinson Canó** recorded his 450th career double in the 4th inning last night...he became the 5th second baseman in Major League history with 2,000 hits, 450 doubles, 200 home runs and 1,000 RBI... he joins Roberto Alomar, Craig Biggio, Jeff Kent and Rogers Hornsby.

SETH THE SPARK...**Seth Smith's** .413 on-base percentage this season ranks 4th in the American League and 15th in the Majors...his .920 OPS is the 13th-best in the American League...Seattle is 10-4 when he hits in the second spot in the lineup, where he's hitting .313 (15x48) with 9 runs, 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 7 RBI, 8 walks and a .945 OPS.

A-OAK-I STREAKING...**Norichika Aoki** has hit safely in all 13 career games against Oakland (with an at-bat)...in 14 career games against the A's is hitting .346 (18x52) with 8 runs, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 5 RBI and a .404 on-base percentage...the 13-game hitting streak is T2nd-longest active hitting streak against Oakland behind Boston's Dustin Pedroia (14) and Chicago-AL's Jose Abreu (13).

GETTING SERIE-OUS...the Mariners have won 5 straight series (2-1 at NYY, 2-1 at CLE, 2-1 at LAA, 2-1 vs. HOU & 2-1 vs. KC) and have won 6 of 8 series overall this season...the Mariners last won at least 5 straight series when they won 6 consecutive series from May 18-June 5, 2011...in that stretch: vs. LAA: 2-0, at SD: 3-0, at MIN: 2-1, vs. NYY: 2-1, vs. BAL: 2-1, vs. TB: 3-1.

TWO OUTS, SO WHAT...the Mariners have recorded 44 two-out RBI this season, which ranks T3rd in American League, T9th in Majors...**Robinson Canó** is tied for A.L. with 12 two-out RBI (2nd in Majors behind Bryce Harper-WAS, 17), **Kyle Seager's** 8 two-out RBI ranks T7th & **Nelson Cruz's** 7 ranks 13th.

LEAGUE LEADER...**Robinson Canó** ranks 2nd in the American League with 8 home runs, behind Toronto's Josh Donaldson (9)...he leads the A.L. and is T4th in the Majors in RBI with 24, trailing only Colorado's Nolan Arenado (25), New York-NL's Yoenis Cespedes (25) & Chicago's Anthony Rizzo (25) and tied with Washington's Bryce Harper.

AS YOU KNOW...the Mariners are 20-11 in Oakland since the start of 2013...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that the .645 winning percentage in that span is the best by any visiting team at the Oakland Coliseum?...Seattle ranks just ahead of Texas (18-10/.643)...Seattle has won 5 straight games at the Oakland Coliseum...the 5-game win streak is the 2nd-longest by the Mariners in Oakland, trailing only an 8-game streak July 6, 2007-April 17, 2008...the current win streak began July 5, 2015 and included a three-game sweep Sept. 4-6, 2015.

ABOUT IWAKUMA...

- Pronounced: he-sash-ee ee-wah-ku-mah
- 35-year-old right-hander is making his 117th career appearance, 103rd ML start & 6th GS of 2016 tonight vs. the Astros.
- Re-signed with Seattle as a free agent to a 2016 contract with vesting options for 2017 and 2018 on Dec. 17, 2015.
- 107-69, 3.25 ERA (557 ER, 1,541.0 IP) in 226 G/225 GS w/Kintetsu (2001-04) & Rakuten (2005-2011) in the Japan League.
- Pitched in the 2004 Athens Olympics as a member of the Japan national team (bronze medal)...also part of gold medal-winning Japan squad in the 2009 WBC.
- 2008 Pacific League MVP & winner of Eiji Sawamura Award (Cy Young equivalent) going 21-4, 1.87 ERA (42 ER, 201.2 IP).
- Originally signed by Seattle as a free agent Jan. 5, 2012.
- 1 of 5 Mariners pitchers born in Japan, but is only the 2nd to make a start...only other Japan-born pitcher to make a start for the Mariners was Mac Suzuki (9 GS, last: 5/17/99 vs. MIN).
- Named to the 2013 American League All-Star Team.
- Tossed at least 6.0 innings in 74 of his 102 career MLB starts, including 49 of his last 67 starts, dating back to July 14, 2013.
- Is 7-2, 2.99 ERA (32 ER, 96.1 IP) in 15 G/12 GS in May.

LAST START...tagged with L #3, allowing a season-high 5 runs in 5.0 innings pitched in Seattle's 4-7 loss vs. HOU...matched season high with 7 strikeouts (also: 4/11 at TEX), but walked 2, hit a batter and allowed a home run for 4th straight game.

HEY HEY, IT'S MAY...Kuma is 7-2 with a 2.99 (32 ER, 96.1 IP) with 1 save in 15 games (12 starts) in the month of May...his .778 winning percentage in May is his best of any month (13-5/.722 in Aug. is 2nd) and his 2.99 ERA is his 3rd best month (2.81 in Sept./Oct. and 2.93 in Aug.).

THIS HAS GONE ON LONG ENOUGH...Iwakuma is 0-3 this season and, dating back to Sept. 27, 2015, has dropped his last four consecutive decisions...the 4-game losing streak is a career-high for Iwakuma (prev: 3, 2x, last 9/10-21/14).

MOVING ON UP...with his 103rd Major League start in tonight's game, Iwakuma moves past Kazuhisa Ishii for 6th-most ML starts by a Japanese-born pitcher...Iwakuma ranks behind Hideo Nomo (318), Hiroki Kuroda (211), Tomo Ohka (178), Daisuke Matsuzaka (132) and Masato Yoshii (118).

BUILDING UP...Iwakuma increased his innings pitched in each of his first 4 starts: went 5.0 IP in his 2016 debut 4/5 at TEX...tossed 6.0 IP on 4/11 vs. TEX...posted 7.0 IP on 4/17 at NYY...went 8.0 IP 4/22 at LAA.

JUST GET HIM THREE...owns a career record of 40-7 in 60 career starts when receiving at least 3 runs of support...lost his only start (4/17 at NYY) this season in which he got 3 or more runs of support...the Mariners have give Iwakuma 2 or fewer runs of support in 4 of his 5 starts this season.

THE RIGHT STUFF...since 2012, Hisashi Iwakuma ranks 5th in the American League with a 4.24 strikeout-to-walk ratio...Kuma has recorded 576 strikeouts to 136 walks during that time...teammate Felix Hernandez ranks 6th in the AL during that same time with a mark of 4.04 K/BB.

ASA STARTER...since making his first MLB start 7/2/12 has gone 46-27 with a 3.16 ERA (230 ER, 654.1 IP) in 102 starts...since his first MLB start, Iwakuma's ERA is 7th-best in the American League (min. 75 GS), with rotation-mate **Felix Hernandez** holding the top spot with a 2.83 mark (OAK's Sonny Gray is 2nd at 2.93).

SPRING TRAINING RECAP...went 2-0 with a 6.00 ERA (8 ER, 12.0 IP) with 4 walks and 7 strikeouts in 4 official Spring Training starts...also made starts in 2 MiLB games on on March 26 (6.0,6.5,2,6) and March 31 (2.0,2,1,1,1,2).

CAREER...in 4+ seasons with Seattle, Iwakuma has combined to go 47-28 with a 3.23 ERA (246 ER, 684.2 IP) with 576 strikeouts in 116 games, including 102 starts...since joining the Mariners rotation on July 2, 2012, his 3.16 ERA (230 ER, 654.1 IP) as a starter is the 7th-best in the American League (min. 600.0 IP) and 11th-best in the Majors: he ranks behind just **Felix Hernandez** (2.83), **Chris Sale** (2.97) & **David Price** (3.04) among current A.L. starters...in 2013, he was an American League All-Star and was named the Mariners MVP Pitcher by the Seattle Chapter of the BBWAA.

100 STRONG...has made 116 career appearances in the Major Leagues (102 starts) since joining the Mariners in 2012...amongst American League pitchers with at least 80 starts since his debut season, Iwakuma has the 4th-lowest ERA (3.23; **Felix Hernandez** is 1st at 2.86) and the 5th best strikeout-to-walk ratio at 4.24.

500 Ks...recorded his 500th career strikeout by fanning Mitch Moreland in the 2nd inning of his win at Texas on Aug. 18, 2015...hit the milestone while walking just 118 batters...according to **STATS LLC**, is tied for 6th-fewest walks by a pitcher before recording his 500th strikeout since 1914 (LAD's Kenley Jansen leads with 104 BB/500K)...had 1,175 strikeouts over 11 years in Japan before his MLB career.

2015 SEASON RECAP...went 9-5 with a 3.54 ERA (51 ER, 129.2 IP) with 111 strikeouts in 20 starts with Seattle last season, including 4-2 with a 2.17 ERA (11 ER, 45.2 IP) with 43 strikeouts in his final 7 starts...Seattle won 11 of his final 16 starts of the season when he was 9-4 with a 2.82 ERA (34 ER, 108.1 IP) with 97 strikeouts.

NO-NO...threw the 5th no-hitter in Mariners history (4th by a single pitcher) on Aug. 12, 2015 vs. the Baltimore Orioles...was Iwakuma's first MLB complete game...the 2nd Japanese-born pitcher with an MLB no-hitter (Hideo Nomo, 2x)...4th no-no in MLB this season...first no-hitter in the American League since **Felix Hernandez** (Aug. 15, 2012 vs. TB)...mixed his off-speed pitches well, according to **ESPN Stats & Info**, threw his lowest percentage of pitches in the strike zone in his career (41 percent, 11 percentage points below his season average entering the day), still throwing 77 of 116 pitches for strikes.

THE INJURY...suffered a right lat strain and was placed on the disabled list on April 24, 2015 (retro to April 21)...on the DL April 21-July 6...second DL stint of Major League career after suffering a torn tendon in right index finger during spring training in 2014.

30-year-old right-hander will be making his 6th start of the season tomorrow vs. Oakland...W #2 in last start, tossing 7.2 IP of shutout vs. KC in 1-0 win (7.2,5,0,0,3,4); was career win #145 matching **Jamie Moyer** for most in franchise history...L #2 on 4/23 at LAA (L,7.0,5,3,3,2,4,2HR), passed **Randy Johnson** for most strikeouts in club history (2,163) with a strikeout of Rafael Ortega in the bottom of the 1st inning...**2015** - Went 18-9 with 3.53 ERA (79 ER, 201.2 IP) in 31 starts...among A.L. leaders in wins (T3rd), shutouts (2, T1st), quality starts (20, T8th), strikeouts (191, 8th), K/9.0 IP (8.52, 9th), innings (13th), ERA (14th), opponent OPS (.682, 14th), & opponent average (.240, 16th)...won 18 games, becoming the third Mariners pitcher to post multiple 18 win seasons with the club, joining **Randy Johnson** (3) & **Jamie Moyer** (2)...tied for MLB lead with 2 shutouts...selected to play in his 6th All-Star game...**Career:** 145-103 with 3.09 ERA and 2,170 strikeouts in 339 career starts...tied **Jamie Moyer** for most wins in club history (145) on 4/29, beating KC 1-0...passed **Randy Johnson** for most strikeouts in club history with his 2,163rd strikeout 4/23 at LAA...passed **Mike Johnson** for 2nd-most appearances in club history in his 336th game on 4/10 vs. OAK (Jeff Nelson holds the all-time club record for appearances with 432)...is the Mariners all-time leader in wins (tied), strikeouts, starts and innings pitched...in his 12th Major League season (debuted 8/4/05)...**vs. OAK:** Is 22-8 with a 2.58 ERA (82 ER, 286.1 IP) with 272 strikeouts in 41 career starts against the A's...is 11-3 with a 2.67 ERA (46 ER, 155.0 IP) with 126 strikeouts in 22 career starts vs. the A's at Oakland Coliseum, including 7-1, 2.76 in his last 16 starts here dating back to 4/11/2009...was 3-1, 3.09 (12 ER, 35.0 IP) in 5 GS in 2015, pitching 7.0 or more innings in 4 of 5 starts.
