OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost each of the first four games of May... the season-high tying four-game skid snaps a season-high four-game home winning streak... have also lost nine of the last 12 games after winning a season-high six straight contests...have matched their worst home record after 16 games in Oakland history at 5-11 (1968, 1994, 2001, 2015)...now have a seven-game losing streak against Seattle in Oakland, which is the second longest such streak against the Mariners in Oakland history (8, July 6, 2007-April 17, 2008)...finished 2-4 on this six-game homestand against Houston (2-1) and Seattle (0-3)...leave tomorrow for a nine-game road trip to Baltimore (three games), Boston (three games) and Tampa Bay (three games).
- Sean Manaea** is 0-0 with a 7.20 ERA (8 er in 10.0 ip) in two starts since coming up to Oakland.
- Billy Burns** (2-for-5, r, so) is 6-for-19 (.316) against Seattle this year and is a .325 (27-for-83) career hitter against the Mariners.
- Khris Davis** (1-for-5, r, rbi) is batting .295 (18-for-61) with six home runs and 13 RBI over his last 15 games after hitting .143 with no home runs and one RBI over his first 12 contests.
- Jed Lowrie** (1-for-4, r, rbi, bb) is batting .393 (22-for-56) over his last 16 games after hitting .209 over his first 12 contests...is a .305 (71-for-233) career hitter against Seattle with seven home runs and 32 RBI in 66 games...the RBI are his most against any team.
- Marcus Semien** (2-for-4, 2 r, hr, rbi, so) is hitting .289 (13-for-45) at home compared to .130 (6-for-46) on the road...has seven home runs and 15 RBI in his career against Seattle, which are his best totals against any team.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The **Seattle Mariners** recorded their first sweep of the season...are 11-4 in their last 15 games and 14-5 in the last 19...are 11-4 in road contests this season...are 16-9 against Oakland dating back to the start of the 2015 season...have a seven-game winning streak against the A's in Oakland dating back to July 5, 2015...are 22-11 at the Coliseum since the start of the 2013 season...are 3-0 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (3-0) and Houston (four games).
- Felix Hernandez** tossed 4.0 innings, his shortest outing of the season...it was the shortest since Aug. 15, 2015 at Boston when he pitched 2.1 innings...it matches his shortest outing against Oakland...also tossed 4.0 innings against the A's on May 16, 2006...allowed eight runs and four earned runs, his most in a start this year.
- Norichika Aoki** (1-for-5, r, rbi, so) has hit safely in all 15 career games against the A's and is batting .328 (20-for-61) over that span...it is the longest active hitting streak against Oakland, ahead of Boston's Dustin Pedroia (14) and Chicago-AL's Jose Abreu (13).
- Nelson Cruz** (3-for-4, r, hr, 2 rbi, bb) recorded his team-leading 10th multi-hit game of the season...also had his second three-hit game of the year.
- Ketel Marte** (2-for-6, r, 2 2b, rbi, so) has reached base safely in all 15 career games against Oakland...is batting .367 (22-for-60) over that span.
- Dae-Ho Lee** (2-for-4, 2 r, 2 hr, 3 rbi, bb) had his first multi-home run game of his career.
