OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's won their second consecutive game to begin a seven-game homestand against Texas (1-0) and the New York Yankees (four games)...have
 won three out of their last four contests...are 41-36 against the Rangers over the last five years.
- Sean Manaea earned his first career win...is now 1-1 with a 7.91 ERA (17 er in 19.1 ip) in four career starts since being called up from Triple-A Nashville.
- Billy Burns (1-for-3, r, so) has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games (14-for-45, .311)...extended his hitting streak against Texas to nine games (12-for-35, .343)...is now a career .306 (15-for-49) hitter against the Rangers.
- Khris Davis (0-for-2, rbi, sac fly) is 0 for his last 14...is batting .245 (24-for-98) with eight home runs and 21 RBI over his last 25 games after hitting .143 with no home runs and one RBI over his first 12 contests.
- Matt McBride made his home debut, going 0-for-3 behind the plate.
- Josh Reddick (1-for-3, r) is 17-for-35 (.486) with five multiple hit games over his last 11 games...is now batting .383 (31-for-81) over his last 22 games.
- Danny Valencia (0-for-2, bb) had his 10-game hitting streak snapped...was 15-for-37 (.405) during that span.
