OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's have won three consecutive games and four of the last five after losing a season-high five consecutive games from May 7-11...won a game on a walk-off grand slam for the seventh time in Oakland history (last: Brandon Inge on May 8, 2012 vs. Toronto)...are now 4-4 (.500) in games started by a left-handed pitcher...have won both meetings against the Rangers this season and are 42-36 against Texas over the last five years...are 2-0 on this seven-game homestand against Texas (2-0) and New York-AL (four games).
- Jesse Hahn is 1-1 with a 3.38 ERA (7 er in 18.2 ip) on the season... is 0-1 with a 5.51 ERA (10 er in 16.1 ip) in three career starts against Texas, all in Oakland.
- Ryan Madson blew his first save of the season...was a perfect 12-for-12 prior to the blown save.
 Danny Valencia and Khris Davis hit back-to-back home runs in the second inning...it was the second time this season the A's hit back-to-back home runs
- Danny Valencia and Khris Davis hit back-to-back home runs in the second inning...it was the second time this season the A's hit back-to-back home runs (last: Khris Davis and Coco Crisp, April 21 at New York-AL).
- Khris Davis (3-for-5, 3 r, 3 hr, 6 rbi, 2 so) had the first three-homer game of his career...it was the 16th in Oakland history and the 28th in Athletics history... it was the second this year as Danny Valencia hit three home runs on Sunday at Tampa Bay...it was Davis' eighth career multi-homer game, his second this season (last: May 2 vs. Seattle)...matched his career high with six RBI (Aug. 16, 2015 vs. San Diego)...snapped an 0-for-14 hitless streak with his home run in the second inning.
- Josh Reddick (1-for-4, bb) is 19-for-41 (.463) with five multiple hit games over his last 12 games...is now batting .376 (32-for-85) over his last 23 games.
- Danny Valencia (2-for-5, r, hr, 2 rbi) is 12-for-29 (.414) with seven runs, six home runs and 10 RBI in eight games since his return from the disabled list.

TEXAS NOTES

- The **Texas Rangers** have lost two consecutive road games but are still 3-2 in the last five road contests...have lost at least two consecutive games for just the fourth time this season...have lost the first two meetings against the A's this are 9-11 dating back to the 2015 season against Oakland...are 1-1 on this six-game road trip to Oakland (1-1) and Houston (three games).
- Cole Hamels is 1-1 with a 2.18 ERA (5 er in 20.2 ip) in three career starts against Oakland.
- Nomar Mazara and Adrian Beltre hit back-to-back home runs in the fourth inning...it is the third time this season the Rangers have hit back-to-back home runs (last: Bobby Wilson and Delino DeShields, May 8 at Detroit)...all three instances have come in the last four road games.
- Adrian Beltre (2-for-5, r, hr, rbi, so) has hit safely in nine of his last 10 games and is batting .308 (12-for-39) with four home runs and 11 RBI over that span.
- Prince Fielder (2-for-4, r) recorded his fifth multi-hit game of the season.
- Nomar Mazara (2-for-5, r, hr, rbi, so) is batting 8-for-24 (.333) over his last six games...is batting .306 (19-for-62) on the road this season.
- Rougned Odor (2-for-5, r, 2b) is 13-for-38 (.342) with seven runs in his last eight road games.
