OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's have won four straight and five of the last six games...swept their first series of three or more games in the Coliseum since July 3-6, 2014 against Toronto (four games)...had a streak of 40 consecutive home series of three or more games without a sweep, which was the longest such streak in Oakland history (previous: 35, May 13, 1983-Aug. 1, 1984)...are now 5-4 (.556) in games facing a left-handed starting pitcher...have won all three contests against the Rangers this season and are 43-36 against Texas over the last five years...are 3-0 on this seven-game homestand against Texas (3-0) and New York-AL (four games).
- The A's have 14 home runs over the last six games after hitting just six home runs over the prevous 11 contests.
- Rich Hill has allowed four hits or fewer in each of his last six starts...has tossed at least five innings in each outing and his streak of six consecutive outings with five innings or more and four hits or fewer is the longest such streak by an A's pitcher since at least 1913...is 5-1 with a 1.96 ERA (8 er in 36.2 ip) over his last six starts...is 3-1 with a 1.44 ERA (4 er in 25.0 ip) in four starts on four days rest.
- Billy Burns (1-for-5, r, 2 so) is a .274 (17-for-62) career hitter against Texas.
- Khris Davis (2-for-2, 2 r, hr, rbi, 2 bb) is batting 15-for-57 (.263) with nine home runs and 20 RBI over his last 14 games.
- Josh Reddick (1-for-3, 2 r, bb) is 20-for-44 (.455) with five multiple hit games over his last 13 games... is now batting .375 (33-for-88) over his last 24 games... is hitting .400 (22-for-55) in 16 games in May... is a .308 (71-for-230) career hitter against Texas.
- Marcus Semien (2-for-4, 2 rbi) is 13-for-43 (.302) with eight RBI over his last 13 games...is batting .309 (17-for-55) at home...is hitting .292 (14-for-48) against AL West competition.
- Danny Valencia (3-for-4, 2 r, 2 rbi) is 15-for-33 (.455) with nine runs, six home runs and 12 RBI in nine games since his return from the disabled list.

TEXAS NOTES

- The **Texas Rangers** have lost three straight games and are 12-13 since April 22...are 4-6 in the last 10 road games...have lost all three games against Oakland in 2016 and are 9-13 against the A's dating back to the start of the 2015 season...fell to 5-7 in day games, snapping a four-game day winning streak...are 0-3 on this six-game road trip to Oakland (0-3) and Houston (three games).
- Martin Perez is 0-3 with a 4.20 ERA (14 er in 30.0 ip) in five road starts this season...is winless in his last 14 road starts dating back to May 5, 2014...is 3-5 with a 5.81 (31 er in 48.0 ip) in nine career starts against the A's...is 2-2 with a 3.77 ERA (13 er in 31.0 ip) in five career starts in Oakland.
- Elvis Andrus (1-for-3) is batting .297 (33-for-111) over his last 31 games.
- Ian Desmond (2-for-4, r, so, sb) is batting .356 (16-for-45) in day games this season.
- Prince Fielder (1-for-4, rbi) is batting .333 (26-for-78) in his last 20 games against Oakland.
