**WINS AND LOSSES:** Texas suffered a walkoff loss to Oakland last night, 8-5...have dropped 2 straight to begin this trip and team has gone 12-12 since 4/22 after opening the year with a 10-6 mark...club has gone 8-8 in May...team has still won 4 of 7, 7 of 11, and 12 of last 20 G beginning 4/26...Rangers are 0-2 on this 6-game, 7-day road trip to Oakland (0-2) and Houston (3 G)...at 22-18, Texas has 5th-best overall record in the A.L. (.550)...after win on Sunday, were season-high 6 games over .500 for the 1st time...team was 17-23 after 40 G last year and this is best record at this point since 2013 (26-14)...club has won a season-best 4 straight games twice (4/16-21; 4/26-30), separated by a season-long 4-game losing skid, 4/22-25...since 5/1/15, Rangers have best record and most wins in A.L. (103-77, .572).

**STANDINGS:** Rangers dropped back into 2nd place with last night's loss, 1.0 game behind Seattle...had 2 days in 1st on Sunday/Monday, but have now been in 2nd place for 13 of last 15 days beginning 5/3...Texas also held at least a share of 1st place for 16 of 19 days from 4/11-5/2...team has had at least a share of 1st place for 23 days this season, including sole possession of the division lead for 15 different days...already have more days in 1st place this season than last year (21) in division title run.

**SERIES STUFF:** This marks just 2nd time in '16 to lose 1st 2 games of a series, the other 4/22-23 at CWS, which ended in a 3-game sweep...Rangers are now 8-4-1 in series this season overall after dropping this 3-game set, but have still won 3 of 4 and 5 of last 7...club is now 2-3-1 in road series, losing 3 of last 4 (including this week)...team is 6-1-0 in series in Arlington, winning 6 straight, longest such span since Aug. 10-Sept. 16, 2012 (also 6).

**ON ROAD:** Texas has lost 2 straight after a season-best 3-game road win streak, as club has now won 3 of last 5 away tilts...club has dropped 9 of 13 after opening with a 4-2 away record...team's .421 (8-11) road winning pct. ranks 11th in the A.L...of team's 11 road defeats in '16, 7 have been one or 2-run losses.

**VS. OAKLAND / A.L. WEST:** Rangers are 0-2 vs. A's to begin 2016, but have still won 4 of 6 and 5 of last 8 games...Texas was 9-10 vs. A's in 2015, as season series has been decided by a 10-9 margin in each of the last 3 years...have gone 13-8 at Coliseum since start of '14, 18-12 since start of '13...Texas leads all-time series, 343-334, and A's have 175-164 edge here at the Coliseum  
 • This road trip begins a stretch of 9 straight vs. A.L. West opponents, 1st such games since 4/29-5/1 vs. LAA...Rangers are 10-8 vs. the West, winning 5 of 8 and 10 of last 15.

**OFF DAY IN HOUSTON:** Rangers are scheduled to fly to Houston after today's game for an off day tomorrow ahead of Friday's series opener against the Astros...marks 2nd installment of the Silver Boot Series Presented by The Texas Lottery in '16, as Rangers won all 3 games from 4/19-21 in Arlington...the Rangers have won 11 of the last 13 meetings between the teams dating to 2015...Rangers' .629 (83-49) winning pct. all-time against the Astros is highest versus any Texas opponent with more than 15 meetings...club was 5-4 at Minute Maid in '15, but have lost 3 of 4 and 4 of 6 there.

**NOT YOUR EVERY DAY LINE:** Cole Hamels posted a quality start last night despite giving up 3 HR, just 2nd Ranger in last 19 years to pull that trick...the other?: Colby Lewis on 6/30/15 at BAL (6.0 IP, 6 H, 5 R-3 ER, 3 HR).

**HIGH QUALITY:** Last night was Rangers' 27th quality start of the year, tied with CHC and TOR for most in MLB, and a club record for 1st 40 G of a season (previous 26 in 1978)...of the 10 teams with 20+ QS, Rangers have 3rd-lowest win pct., better than only the Jays (19-22) and Dodgers (21-19).

**MORE LATE HEROICS FROM DESMOND:** Ian Desmond hit a go-ahead 2-R HR in the 9th inning last night, putting Texas in position to win before the blown save...it was the 2nd time in 3 days for a Desmond HR to turn a Texas deficit into a lead in the 7th-or-later (also Sun. vs. TOR-7th inn.)...he is just the 8th player in Rangers history to have multiple HR of that kind in a season, and no Ranger had ever hit a pair in such close proximity...others to do it: Richie Zisk in 1978, Gary Ward in 1984, Juan Gonzalez in 1992, Ivan Rodriguez in 1999, Mark Teixeira in 2004, Richard Hidalgo in 2005, Josh Hamilton in 2008 and 2012.

**BACK-TO-BACK:** Mazara and Beltre hit back-to-back HR in the 4th inning last night to tie the game...the Rangers' 3 back-to-back efforts this season have all come in the team's past 4 road games.  
 • Mazara and Beltre both have 5 road HR, tied for team lead and T10th in the A.L...the duo has accounted for 10 of club's 22 road HR in 2016 (45.5%).

**LATE LOSS:** Texas suffered its MLB-high 6th walk-off loss of the year last night, already matching club's 2015 total, as over half of team's away defeats being walk-offs...Rangers' 8 last at-bat losses are tied with ATL for most in majors.  
 • Last night was 8th walk-off slam ever against the Rangers, 2nd in last 24 seasons (1992-2016), the other on 9/22/13 at KC (Justin Maxwell off Joakim Soria in 10th).

**FLYING AT THE COLISEUM:** Texas (3) and Oakland (4) combined for 7 HR last night, a season high in any Rangers game, and tying 4 other contests for most HR in any ML contest in '16: also 5/15 OAK at TB; 5/9 KC at NYY; 5/7 MIL at CIN; 4/15 CIN at STL.  
 • Marked Rangers' 1st loss all season when hitting multiple HR (9-1), and was 1st road loss when hitting 3+ HR since 7/6/14 at NYM (lost 8-4 despite 3 HR).  
 • Khris Davis' effort last night was 1st 3-HR game vs. TEX since CLE's Lonnie Chisenhall, 6/9/14 in Arlington, 1st opponent to do it on road since Melvin Upton, 9/9/12 at TB.  
 • TEX has now allowed A.L.-high 55 HR, 3rd-most in MLB (CIN-66, MIL-58).

**SUN COME THROUGH:** Texas has a 5-6 record in day games entering today's tilt, winning 4 in a row after opening with a 1-6 mark...over the 4-G day win streak, Rangers are batting .308 (41-133) with a .966 OPS, 31 runs, and 9 HR...club is 2-4 in road day contests, winning last 2 after losing 1st 4.  
 • Nomar Mazara has hits in 7 straight and 8 of 9 day games overall at .371/.410/.657/1.067 (13-35) with 3 HR, 6 RBI, and 5 R...his .371 day avg. ranks 5th in the A.L...Ian Desmond has a .341 (14-41) day avg. in '16, including a .480 (12-25) figure over club's last 7 away tilts with 2 HR, 9 RBI, and 10 R scored.

**LEFTY-PALOOZA:** Today ends a span in which Texas is starting 4 consecutive left-handed pitchers, which would match longest such span in club history...according to STATS LLC, only time Rangers have started 4 straight LHP came in 1973: Aug. 26 (DH at CLE)-27-28 (at BAL)...starters in those 4: Jim Merritt, Mike Paul, David Clyde, Charlie Hudson.  
 • 26 of the Rangers' 1st 40 games have featured a left-handed starter for the club, 2nd-most lefty starts in MLB (CWS-28)...the 26 instances are a club record through 40 games, as team had 25 LH starts in 1st 40 G in 1993 (also 25 in 1st 41 G in 1993).

**SHORTS:** Matt Bush is 1st pitcher in Rangers history to retire at least 3 batters while allowing no hits and no walks in each of his 1st 3 ML outings...last night was the 2nd time this season for all 9 starters in the Texas batting order to have at least one hit (also 4/30 vs. LAA), 1st road instance since 6/30/15 at BAL.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#33 Martin Perez, LHP**  
**(1-3, 3.23)**

**TODAY:** The 25-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 9th start of the season in today's series finale in Oakland...has a 1.93 ERA (5 ER/23.1 IP) over his last 4 starts to drop season ERA from 4.50 to 3.23, lowest since his 1st start of the year...Rangers have not scored a run with Perez on the mound in either of his last 2 starts...took loss in Rangers' 5-0 defeat on Fri. vs. TOR, as he has started each of the 2 games in which Texas has been blanked in '16...has quality starts in 6 of 8 starts this season, and has lasted at least 5.0 IP in all 8 outings...of the 17 ML pitchers with 8+ starts and one-or-zero wins, only ATL's Julio Teheran has a lower ERA (3.17) than Perez...Texas' 2-6 record in his starts are T3rd most team losses in any pitcher's starts in the A.L...career 5-5, 2.61 (27 ER/93.0 IP) in 14 G/13 GS in daytime, making 10 straight quality starts in day tilts with 2 CG...seeking his first career win in the month of May, as he enters today with an 0-4 record and 4.88 ERA (17 ER/31.1 IP) over 6 career starts...seeking 1st full season w/ Texas since 'Tommy John' ligament replacement surgery on left elbow on 5/19/14... returned to majors on-schedule just after 2015 All-Star break and made 14 starts last year...produced a breakout April in 2014 and appeared to be on the verge of a strong season before his elbow issues arose.

**LAST START:** Took loss on Fri. vs. TOR in Rangers' 5-0 shutout defeat (6.1 IP, 5 H, 2 R-1 ER, 3 BB, 3 SO, 0 HR, 100 pitches/60 strikes)...game was scoreless through 5 innings, and only run allowed by Perez while he was on the mound was unearned due to an Andrus error in the 6th...Sam Dyson permitted an inherited runner to score on a wild pitch in the 7th...Tom Wilhelmsen gave up 3 R on 2 HR in the 8th for the final margin...for 2 starts vs. TOR in '16, had 0-1 record despite 0.79 ERA (1 ER/11.1 IP).

**SEEKING YOUR SUPPORT:** Has averaged just 2.28 runs of support per 9 innings, 2nd-lowest in the A.L. and 5th-lowest in majors...offense has totaled 20 runs in Perez's starts (with or without him on the mound)...Rangers have not scored a run in support of Perez (while he is still in the game) since Rougned Odor's leadoff HR on 5/3 at TOR, a span of 16.1 IP without a run of support... team-high 6 starts with 2-or-fewer runs of support.

**CROSTOWN TRAFFIC:** Has allowed multiple walks in all 8 starts to begin the year, longest streak of his career (single-season or overall)...has averaged 4.94 BB per 9, which would be highest figure of his career (currently 3.6 BB/9 in 2012), and is 5th-highest in the majors (3rd in A.L.).

**GROUND CONTROL:** Has induced a ML-high 14 grounded into double plays, and his 57.4% ground ball percentage is 3rd-highest in A.L. and 6th-highest in majors...just one GIDP last 2 starts, but was just 4th Texas starter to open a season by inducing GIDP balls in at least 1st 6 starts...others: Kenny Rogers (10 in 2002), Rick Honeycutt (7 in 1983), and Fergie Jenkins (6 in 1980).

**VS. OAKLAND:** Is 3-4, 5.93 (27 ER/41.0 IP) in 8 career games/starts vs. A's...8 starts and 4 losses are his most against any opponent, and 5.93 ERA is 3rd-highest against foes he's faced in 3+ starts (7.27 vs. DET; 6.19 vs. BOS)...only outing last season came here at the Coliseum on 9/22/15, taking ND in an 8-6 Texas win (4.0 IP, 6 H, 5 R-ER)...is 0-1, 12.46 (12 ER/8.2 IP) in last 2 starts vs. A's since a CG 3-hit shutout here at the Coliseum on 4/23/14, the most recent of his 3 career shutouts...is 2-1, 3.38 (9 ER/24.0 IP) in his 4 career starts here in Oakland.

**ON THE ROAD:** Is slated for his 5th road start of the season, going 0-2, 3.91 (10 ER/23.0 IP) in his previous 4 outings, including 0-0, 1.64 (2 ER/11.0 IP) last 2 away starts...no HR allowed in 4 road starts in '16...is winless in his last 13 road starts dating back to 5/5/14, going 0-8, 4.82 (38 ER/71.0 IP) in that stretch...has 6 quality starts in that span, but has a run support average of 2.66, including 2 runs-or-less 10 times...offense has totaled 3 runs of support in his last 5 road starts...is the longest road losing streak by a Texas starter since Kevin Millwood's club-record 10-game road losing streak, 6/28/07-5/5/08.

**2016:** Chirinos (3.00 ERA) caught first start, Holaday (4.50 ERA) caught next 4 outings, with Nicholas (0.00 ERA) catching one, and Wilson (2.19 ERA) catching last 2 starts...opponents are 6-for-30 (.200) with RISP...opposing hitters by plate appearance: 1st time-.250 (15-60); 2nd time-.206 (13-63); 3rd time-.220 (9-41); 4th time-BB and HBP in 2 PA...in loss on 4/10 at LAA, became 1st Texas starter to have zero strikeouts in a quality start since Derek Holland on 6/26/11 vs. NYM.

**TO THE LEFT:** Left-handed batters are just 6-for-34 (.176) through 8 starts...over 22 starts since his return from the DL last year, lefties have hit just .198 (19-96) with 2 extra-base hits: a HR by Kyle Seager on 9/9/15 at SEA & a 2B by Adam Eaton on 4/22/16 at CWS.

**2015:** Returned from left elbow surgery and went 3-6, 4.46 (39 ER/78.2 IP) in 14 starts after the All-Star break...logged 8 quality starts from August 1 through the end of the season to match Cole Hamels for the club lead...made season debut in 2nd half opener on 7/17 at HOU and went winless over his first 3 starts with a 10.50 ERA (14 ER/12.0 IP), including 8 runs in the 2nd inning of his 3rd start on 7/28 vs. NYY...allowed just one run over 8.1 IP in Rangers' 2-1 win over SF on 8/2 in Arlington to earn first win of the season...was the 1st ML pitcher to record 25+ outs on 80 pitches-or-less since KC's Luke Hochevar on 6/12/09 vs. CIN in a CG 4-1 win...outing marked his first victory since 4/23/14 at OAK...did not allow a home run in first 7 starts, with Steve Pearce's long ball on 8/29 vs. BAL ending a 40.1-inning homerless streak.

**FRIDAY'S SCHEDULED STARTER — RHP COLBY LEWIS (2-0, 3.12 in 8 games/starts)**
