OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost two consecutive games to snap their four-game winning streak...have committed 34 errors this season, most in the American League...fell to 5-5 (.500) in games when facing an opposing left-handed starter...dropped to 8-13 (.381) at home this season...fell to 3-2 in the season series with New York-AL and are 242-274 against the Yankees since moving to Oakland in 1968...are 3-2 on this seven-game homestand against Texas (3-0) and New York-AL (0-2).
- Sonny Gray** is 0-4 with a 10.38 ERA (25 er in 21.2 ip) over his last five starts...the losing streak matches his career high (also: Aug. 1-16, 2014)...has allowed at least four runs in each start, the first time in his career he has allowed four or more runs in more than two consecutive starts...is 0-3 with a 9.61 ERA (21 er in 19.2 ip) in four starts in May...has received no runs of support twice this year and two runs or fewer five times.
- Ryan Dull** has stranded all 16 of his inherited runners, which are the most in the majors among relievers that have not allowed an inherited runner to score.
- Coco Crisp** (1-for-4, 2b, rbi) is batting .272 (22-for-81) with 13 RBI over his last 21 games...seven of his last 11 hits are doubles.
- Khris Davis** (1-for-4, so) is 16-for-64 (.250) with nine home runs and 20 RBI over his last 16 games, including four homers in the last four games.
- Tyler Ladendorf** (1-for-4, r) snapped an 0-for-15 hitless streak with a single in the seventh inning.
- Matt McBride** (1-for-4, rbi) is 4-for-13 (.308) in five games, including four starts, since being recalled from Triple-A Nashville last Friday.
- Danny Valencia** (1-for-4, so) has hit safely in four straight games (7-for-17, .412)...is 16-for-39 (.410) with nine runs, six home runs and 12 RBI in 11 games since his return from the disabled list on May 6.

NEW YORK-AL NOTES

- The **New York Yankees** have won three consecutive games...are 10-5 in their last 15 games...improved their road record to 7-12...improved to 2-3 in the season series against Oakland and are 17-13 in their last 30 games at the Coliseum...are 3-2 on this seven-game road trip to Arizona (1-2) and Oakland (2-0).
- CC Sabathia** came off the disabled list and won his 100th game as a Yankee in his first start since May 4 at Baltimore...is the 18th pitcher to reach 100 wins as a Yankee...became the eighth pitcher in the modern era (since 1900) with at least 100 wins with multiple franchises...is one of 10 pitchers in the modern era to make at least 200 starts with multiple franchises...is now in 15th place on the Yankees' all-time starts list with 204 career starts as a Yankee...is only one of 17 pitchers to start 200 games with New York-AL...is 3-1 with a 2.52 ERA (7 er in 25.0 ip) in four road starts this season.
- Carlos Beltran** (3-for-5, 3 2b, 3 rbi) hit three doubles in a game for the fourth time in his career...the last came as a member of the New York Mets on April 2, 2008 at Florida...is 14-for-43 (.326) with 13 RBI over his last 12 games...is 7-for-19 (.368) on the current road trip...recorded his ninth multi-hit game and first three hit game this season...it was his first three hit game since he had four hits on April 16 vs. Seattle.
- Jacoby Ellsbury** (2-for-4, r, 3b, 2 rbi, bb) is batting .329 (25-for-76) over his last 22 games.
- Didi Gregorius** (3-for-5, 2 r, gidp) has hit safely in each of his last five games (7-for-21, .333)...recorded his sixth multi-hit game and third three-hit game this year.
- Ronald Torreyes** (2-for-4, 2 r, 3b, 2 rbi, bb, 2 so) snapped an 0-for-7 hitless streak with a triple in the fourth inning...recorded his fourth multi-hit game this year.
