OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost four consecutive contests to snap their four-game winning streak...were swept in a four-game series in Oakland for the first time since April 26-29, 1999 against Cleveland...were swept by New York-AL in a four-game series in Oakland for just the second time since moving to Oakland in 1968 (also: July 6-8, 1979)...lost the season series against the Yankees 4-3, the first time losing the season series since going 3-6 in 2011 (went 5-5 in 2012)...are 242-276 against New York-AL since moving to Oakland in 1968...fell to 8-15 (.348) at home, the second worst record after 23 games in Oakland history (7-16 in 2015)...fell to 6-7 (.462) in one-run games...finished 3-4 on this seven-game homestand against Texas (3-0) and New York-AL (0-4)...leave for a three-game road trip to Seattle following today's game.
- A's starting pitchers are 3-10 with a 7.08 ERA (59 er in 75.0 ip) over the last 15 games.
- Jesse Hahn is 0-2 with a 5.40 ERA (7 er in 11.2 ip) in two career starts against New York-AL.
- Billy Burns (2-for-4, 3 r, 2 sb) is 9-for-27 (.333) with two doubles and two triples in seven games this year against the Yankees...has hit safely in 12 of his 14 career games against New York-AL (21-for-59, .356).
- Coco Crisp (1-for-4, 2b) extended his hitting streak to six games (6-for-25, .240)...is batting .270 (24-for-89) with 13 RBI over his last 23 games...eight of his last 13 hits are doubles...has started a season-high eight consecutive games, matching his longest streak of last season (May 11-19).
- Chris Coghlan (0-for-3) is hitless in his last 14 at-bats and is 1-for-22 (.045) in his last seven games.
- Stephen Vogt (1-for-4, 2b, 3 rbi) hit his first extra base hit in his last 14 games with a two-RBI double in the fifth inning.

NEW YORK-AL NOTES

- The **New York Yankees** have won a season-high five consecutive games...it is their longest winning streak since June 1-9, 2015 when they won seven straight...are 12-5 in their last 17 games...are now 8-8 against American League West competition...won four straight games against Oakland to win the season series 4-3...the four-game winning streak against the A's is the longest since also winning four straight from Aug. 8, 2011 to May 27, 2012...it is the first time winning the season series against Oakland since 2011 when they went 6-3 (went 5-5 in 2012)...won four straight games at the Coliseum for the first time since winning a franchise-best nine consecutive from July 5, 2010 to July 19, 2012...are 19-13 in their last 32 contests at the Coliseum...finished 5-2 on this seven-game road trip to Arizona (1-2) and Oakland (4-0)...leave for a three-game homestand against Toronto following today's game.
- Michael Pineda snapped his career-high streak of five straight losses...is 3-1 with a 2.70 ERA (9 er in 30.0 ip) in five career starts against Oakland...has tossed at least six innings in all five starts...has recorded at least six strikeouts in each of the last four starts.
- Carlos Beltran (2-for-4, r, 2b, rbi) has hit safely in five consecutive games (10-for-22, .455)...is 18-for-51 (.353) with 15 RBI over his last 14 games.
- Jacoby Ellsbury (1-for-4, r, hr, rbi) is batting .310 (26-for-84) over his last 24 games.
- Mark Teixeira (1-for-4, rbi, so) snapped an 0-for-19 hitless streak with an RBI single in the sixth inning.
