OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost three straight and seven of the last eight games after winning five of the previous six contests...are now a season-high nine games under .500 at 20-29...are now 7-17 in May and are currently on a six-game homestand against Detroit (0-1) and Minnesota (three games)...dropped to 1-4 against the Tigers in the season series.
- Sean Manaea was charged with his third career loss in his sixth start of the season and of his career since being selected from Triple-A Nashville on April 29...Friday's start was his first career appearance versus Detroit.
- Billy Burns (0-for-3) had his six-game hitting streak snapped (8-for-21) after going 3-for-25 (.120) over his previous six contests...is batting .200 (3-for-15) this season against Detroit.
- Coco Crisp (1-for-4, 2b) extended his hitting streak to a season-high 10 games (12-for-42)...is batting .283 (30-for-106) with 17 RBI over his last 27 games after hitting .158 with one RBI over his first 12 contests.
- Khris Davis (1-for-4, 2 so) is 10-for-32 (.313) with two doubles, five home runs and nine RBI over his last 10 games...has hit 10 homers in the month of May, which is the most by an Athletic since Josh Reddick did so in 2012.
- Stephen Vogt (1-for-4) has hit in five straight games...is 14-for-65 (.215) with two extra base hits (double and homer) over his last 18 games after hitting .316 with eight extra base hits over his previous 15 contests.

DETROIT NOTES

- The **Detroit Tigers** have now won nine of their last 11 games after starting off the month of May at 2-11... are currently on a six-game road trip to Oakland (1-0) and Los Angeles-AL (three games).
- Michael Fulmer allowed two hits in a career-high 7.2 innings to earn his fourth win in the sixth start of his career and season since making his debut on April 29 at Minnesota. Friday's start also marked his first career appearance against Oakland.
- Miguel Cabrera (0-for-3, 2 bb) saw his four-game hitting streak snapped...was 8-for-15 (.533) during that stretch.
- Ian Kinsler (3-for-5, r, 2b, 3b) snapped an 0-for-9 slump with his third inning triple.
- J.D. Martinez (1-for-5, rbi, 3b, 2 so) has now hit in six consecutive games (7-for-25, .280)...is hitting .309 (21-for-68) over his last 17 games.
- Cameron Maybin (1-for-3, r, rbi, 2b, bb) extended his hitting streak to a season-high 10 games (19-for-36, .528).
