#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The **Oakland A's** snapped a three-game losing streak...snapped a season-high tying five-game home losing streak (April 7-15)...improved to 6-5 (.545) against opposing left-handed starters...snapped a three-game regular season losing streak against Detroit and are now 2-4 in the season series...are 251-246 against Detroit since moving to Oakland in 1968...are 1-1 on this six-game homestand against Detroit (1-1) and Minnesota (three games).
- The A's made their 37th error this season after going a season-high tying four consecutive games without an error (also: April 28-May 1)...have allowed 40 home runs in May, which is tied for the second highest May home run total in Oakland history (41 in 1997, 40 in 1994).
- Jesse Hahn is 3-0 with a 1.64 ERA (4 er in 22.0 ip) in three career starts against Detroit...is 2-0 with a 2.79 ERA (6 er in 19.1 ip) in three starts at home this year.
- Billy Butler (2-for-3, r, hr, 3 rbi) snapped an 0-for-11 hitless streak with his first home run of the year in the second inning...it snapped a 29-game homerless streak, the longest season-opening homerless streak of his career (previous: 27, in 2014).
- Coco Crisp (2-for-5, 2 rbi, 2 so) extended his hitting streak to an A's season-high 11 games (14-for-47, .298)...is batting .288 (32-for-111) over his last 28 games.
- Khris Davis (2-for-5, 2 r, 2b, hr, 3 rbi, so) hit his 11th home run in the month of May...he is the first Athletic to hit more than 10 home runs in a month since Jason Giambi hit 13 in Sept. 2000...the 11 home runs are the best single-month total of his career (previous: 10, Aug. 2015)...is batting .252 (23-for-91) with 25 RBI in 24 games in May...his RBI total is his single-month best of his career (previous: 24, Aug. 2015).
- Danny Valencia (3-for-4, 3 r, hr, rbi, bb, so) snapped an 0-for-9 hitless streak with a home run in the fourth inning...has a .371 (13-for-35) batting average against left-handed pitchers...recorded his 10th multi-hit game and third three-hit game of the season.

#### **DETROIT NOTES**

- The **Detroit Tigers** have lost two of their past three games...fell to 12-13 (.480) on the road...are now 5-7 (.417) against American League West competition... fell to 4-2 in the season series against Oakland...snapped a three-game winning streak against the A's...are 1-1 on this six-game road trip against Oakland (1-1) and Los Angeles-AL (three games).
- Matt Boyd made his first start of the year... is 0-3 with a 10.17 ERA (29 er in 25.2 ip) on the road in seven career appearances, including six starts.
- Miguel Cabrera (0-for-2, r, bb) has reached base safely in each of the last 15 games.
- Ian Kinsler (2-for-3, bb) has hit safely in 17 of his last 19 games (.354, 28-for-79)...has recorded multiple hits in six of his last 13 games, and in 20 total games.
- Victor Martinez (2-for-3, r, hr, 2 rbi) is hitting .350 (98-for-280) with seven home runs and 33 RBI in 76 career games against Oakland...has hit safely in 15 of his last 16 games against the A's (.466, 27-for-58)...recorded his 16th multi-hit game of the season.
- Cameron Maybin (0-for-4, so) had his 10-game hitting streak snpaped...was batting .528 (19-for-26) over that span.
