#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The **Oakland A's** won their second consecutive game to clinch their seventh (7 of 16) series of the season...have taken three out of their last six contests... improved to 16-24 against right-handed starters and are now 10-16 at home...finished 3-4 in the season series against Detroit...are now 2-1 on this six-game homestand against Detroit (2-1) and Minnesota (three games).
- Rich Hill won his fifth consecutive game and has a 1.97 ERA (7 er in 32 ip) during that span...is now 5-1 in May and leads the club with eight wins ...his eight wins before the end of May are tied for the most by an A's pitcher since Mark Mulder in 2003...is the 10th pitcher in Oakland history with eight wins before the end of May.
- Billy Burns (0-for-4, so) is 0 for his last 12 at-bats and batting .190 (11-for-58) over his last 15 games.
- Coco Crisp (0-for-4) had his A's season-high 11-game hitting streak snapped (14-for-51, .275)...is batting .278 (32-for-115) over his last 29 games.
- Khris Davis (2-for-4, r, 2b) extended his hitting streak to five games and is batting .263 (25-for-95) with 25 RBI in 25 games in May...his RBI total is his singlementh best of his career (previous: 24, Aug. 2015)...the A's have a 12-7 record when he starts at designated hitter compared to 9-18 when he starts in left.
- Danny Valencia (3-for-4, 2 r) is batting .347 (25-for-72) with 16 runs, seven home runs and 16 RBI in 19 games since being reinstated from the 15-day disabled list May 6...recorded his 11th multi-hit game of the season...is a .344 (45-for-131) career hitter against Detroit.
- Stephen Vogt (2-for-4, gidp, so) has hit safely in six straight games (7-for-23)...recorded his ninth multi-hit game...is batting .175 (10-for-57) during the day compared to .306 (30-for-98) at night.

- The **Detroit Tigers** lost their second consecutive game and have dropped three out of the last four...fell to 12-14 on the road...are now 5-8 against American League West competition...fell to 4-3 in the season series against the A's...are 1-2 on this six-game road trip against Oakland (1-2) and Los Angeles-AL (three games).
- Mike Pelfrey remains winless in his 10 starts this season, including five no-decisions...is now 1-4 with a 7.97 ERA (18 er in 20.1 ip) in four career starts
  against Oakland.
- Miguel Cabrera (0-for-4, 2 so, gidp) had reached base safely in each of his previous 15 games coming into today's contest.
- lan Kinsler (0-for-3, r, bb, 2 so) has reached base in 18 of his last 20 games (.341, 28-for-82).
- Victor Martinez (3-for-4, rbi) has hit safely in seven straight games...is hitting .356 (101-for-284) with seven home runs and 34 RBI in 77 career games
  against Oakland...has hit safely in 16 of his last 17 games against the A's (.484, 30-for-62)...recorded his 17th multi-hit game of the season.
