OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** won their third consecutive game after losing three in a row...improved to 7-8 in one-run games...improved to 10-10 (.500) in day contests...won the first meeting of 2016 with Minnesota...have won 14 of the last 17 games at the Coliseum against the Twins...are 21-10 against Minnesota dating back to the start of the 2012 season...are 27-19 on Memorial Day since moving to Oakland in 1968, which includes 19-11 at the Coliseum...are 3-1 on this six-game homestand against Detroit (2-1) and Minnesota (1-0).
- The **A's** hit their first leadoff home run of the season with a Coco Crisp homer to right...the last leadoff home run was by Billy Burns on August 26, 2015 at Seattle (Felix Hernandez).
- Kendall Graveman** is 1-5 with a 6.62 ERA (26 er in 35.1 ip) over his last seven starts...the win today snaps a five-game losing streak.
- Coco Crisp** (1-for-3, r, hr, rbi, bb, so) hit a home run to leadoff the bottom of the first...it is the 16th time in his career that he has hit a leadoff homer...it was his 14th as an Athletic, which ranks third in franchise history...is batting .280 (33-for-118) with 20 RBI over his last 30 games.
- Khris Davis** (0-for-2, rbi, so, sf) had his hitting streak snapped at five games (.421, 8-for-19)...is 14-for-43 (.326) with six home runs and 13 RBI over his last 13 games...is batting .258 (25-for-97) with 26 RBI in 26 games in May...his RBI total is his single-month best of his career (previous: 24, Aug. 2015).
- Jed Lowrie** (2-for-4, r, 2 so) recorded his team-high 13th multi-hit game of the season.
- Danny Valencia** (1-for-2) is batting .351 (26-for-74) with 16 runs, seven home runs and 16 RBI in 20 games since being reinstated from the 15-day disabled list May 6...is batting 21-for-49 (.429) during the day.
- Stephen Vogt** (1-for-4, 2b, so, gidp) has hit safely in seven straight games (8-for-27, .296)...is 12-for-37 (.324) over his last 11 games and has reached base safely in all 11 contests.

MINNESOTA NOTES

- The **Minnesota Twins** had their season-high tying four-game winning streak snapped...fell to 8-19 on the road...fell to 8-18 in May...lost the first meeting of 2016 against Oakland...are 2-12 at the Coliseum dating back to Aug. 21, 2012...are 3-1 on this six-game road trip against Seattle (3-0) and Oakland (0-1).
- Ervin Santana** is 1-3 with a 4.82 ERA (15 er in 28.0 ip) in five starts in the month of May...is 15-7 with a 2.10 ERA (45 er in 193.0 ip) in 30 career appearances, including 28 starts, against Oakland...is 7-3 with a 2.08 ERA (21 er in 91.0 ip) in 15 appearances, including 13 starts, at the Coliseum.
- Brian Dozier** (1-for-2, rbi, bb, so, sf) extended his hitting streak to five games (5-for-17, .294)...is a .302 (13-for-43) career hitter in 12 games at the Coliseum.
- Joe Mauer** (0-for-3, bb, so) had his six-game hitting streak snapped...was batting .440 (11-for-25) over that span.
- Eduardo Nunez** (1-for-3) is hitting .400 (32-for-80) in 22 road games this season.
- Danny Santana** (2-for-3, r, so) left the game with a left hamstring strain...is hitting .272 (18-for-66) with 10 runs in 19 games since May 10.
