OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have won five consecutive games, which is one short of their longest winning streak of the season...recorded their fourth series sweep of the season...are 6-3 over the last 9 contests and 9-7 over the last 16 ...won their season-high fifth straight home game and are now 13-16 at the home... are now 25-29 at the one-third mark of the season...have beaten the Twins at the Coliseum 16 of the last 19 meetings...are 23-10 against Minnesota dating back to the start of the 2012 season...finished 5-1 on this six-game homestand against Detroit (2-1) and Minnesota (3-0)...will travel Thursday to begin an eight-game road trip against Houston (three games), Milwaukee (two games) and Cincinnati (three games).
- Sean Manaea** struck out a career-high eight batters to win his second career game in his seventh start since being selected from Triple-A Nashville April 29... improved to 2-3 with a 6.16 ERA (26 er in 38 ip)...has allowed just one home run over his last four starts after surrendering four over his first three.
- Billy Butler** (2-for-3, r, rbi, 2b, bb) is batting .297 (11-for-37) with nine RBI over his last 15 games after hitting .186 with three RBI over his first 18 contests.
- Jake Smolinski** (1-for-3, hr, rbi, r, bb) hit his first homer of the season in his 11th game (fifth start in right field) since being recalled from Nashville May 20.
- Danny Valencia** (3-for-4, 2 2b, so) extended his hitting streak to five games (12-for-18, .667)...is now batting .378 (31-for-82) with 18 runs, eight home runs and 19 RBI in 22 games since being reinstated from the 15-day disabled list May 6...recorded his team-high tying 13th multi-hit game of the season...is hitting a team-high .346.

MINNESOTA NOTES

- The **Minnesota Twins** have lost three consecutive games after winning a season-high tying four straight...suffered their ninth sweep of the season and fell to 7-22 on the road...are 2-14 at the Coliseum dating back to Aug. 21, 2012...finished 3-3 on this six-game road trip against Seattle (3-0) and Oakland (0-3)... return to Minnesota to begin a 10-game homestand against Tampa Bay (four games), Miami (three games) and Boston (three games).
- Pat Dean** gave up four earned runs to fall to 1-2 in his sixth career appearance (fourth start) since making his debut vs Baltimore May 11.
- Robbie Grossman** (1-for-3, bb, so) has hit safely in eight of 12 games (14-for-39, .359)...leads the Twins in doubles since May 20 with six.
- Eduardo Nunez** (0-for-5, so) had his hitting streak snapped at seven (was .469, 15-for-32 in that span)...is batting .316 (50-for-158) with 22 runs and 19 RBI over his last 38 games...is hitting .378 (34-for-90) in 24 road games this season.
