OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** had their two-game winning streak snapped and are now 7-8 over their last 15 contests...had their season-high six-game home winning streak snapped, which was their longest at the Coliseum over the last two years...fell to 9-6 against opposing left-handed starters...are 1-1 on this nine-game homestand against Texas (1-1), Los Angeles-AL (three games) and Milwaukee (two games).
- Eric Surkamp fell to 0-4 this season in his seventh start and now has an ERA of 8.07 (26 er in 29 ip)...made just his second home start of the year.
- Billy Burns (2-for-5, r, 2b, so) was 7-for-48 (.146) over his previous 13 games...is batting .310 (39-for-126) at night compared to .168 (16-for-95) in daytime.
- Khris Davis (2-for-4, 2 rbi, r, 2b, 2 so) has hit safely in his last four games (7-for-14)...is 9-for-17 (.529) with nine runs, five home runs and 15 RBI in five games against the Rangers...has 35 home runs and 85 RBI over his last 112 games dating back to Aug. 6, 2015.
- Josh Phegley (1-for-3, rbi, 2b, hbp) is 8-for-21 (.381) in six starts at catcher since being reinstated from the disabled list May 27...is a .333 (14-for-42) career hitter against Texas with four home runs and 11 RBI in 15 games.
- Marcus Semien (1-for-4, r) extended his hitting streak to five games and is 8-for-21 (.381) during that stretch.
- Danny Valencia (1-for-4, r) has hit safely in seven straight games (9-for-29, .310)...is now hitting .354 (40-for-113) with 23 RBI in 30 games since being reinstated from the disabled list May 6.

TEXAS NOTES

- The **Texas Rangers** have won 13 of their last 18 games and improved their AL-best record to 40-25...improved to 16-15 on the road...won their first game against the A's this season after losing the previous four meetings and are 10-14 against Oakland dating back to last year...are 3-2 on this 10-game road trip to Seattle (2-1), Oakland (1-1), and St. Louis (three games).
- Martin Perez allowed four earned runs over seven innings to record his fifth straight win and improve his record to 6-4 with a 3.38 ERA (32 er in 85.1 ip).
- Elvis Andrus (3-for-5, hr, 2r, 2 rbi, so) extended his hitting streak to four games...is batting .529 (9-for-17) during that span...recorded his third straight multi-hit game and 17th of the season.
- Robinson Chirinos (1-for-3, hr, 3 rbi, r, bb) snapped an 0-for-6 slump with his homer in the second inning...was reinstated from the DL last Thursday.
- Ryan Rua (2-for-3, hr, 3 rbi, r, bb, sac fly, so) is 20-for-54 (.370) with five home runs and 12 RBI over his last 18 games.
