#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The **Oakland A's** have lost three straight games, 10 of the last 12, and are a season-low 12 games under .500... are now 14-19 (.424) at home...dropped to 12-14 (.462) during the day...have lost three straight to Texas but are still 44-39 against the Rangers over the last five years...have committed five errors in the last five games and eight in the last 10, totaling 45 errors for the season...are 1-3 on this nine-game homestand against Texas (1-3), Los Angeles-AL (three games) and Milwaukee (two games).
- Daniel Mengden made his first career start at home...is 0-2 with a 2.25 ERA (3 er in 12.0 ip) in two starts since being selected from Triple-A Nashville last Saturday...struck out a career-high seven batters, including striking out the side in order in the sixth inning.
- Ryan Dull has stranded all 29 of his inherited runners and opponents are 1-for-39 (.026) with runners in scoring position.
- Max Muncy (1-for-3, r, 2b) snapped a no-hitter in the top of the ninth with a no-out double.
- Marcus Semien (0-for-3) had his six-game hitting streak snapped...was batting .360 (9-for-25) over that span.
- Danny Valencia (0-for-3, so) had his eight game hitting streak snapped...was batting .303 (10-for-33) over that span.

## None TEXAS NOTES

Pitching Lines
Colby Lewis

- The **Texas Rangers** have won five of six, 11 of 14, and 17 of their last 22 games...improved their record to 42-25 (.627), which is the best 67-game start in club history (previous: 41-26, 1996)...are a season-high 17-games above .500, the first time being more than 17-games over since the end of the 2013 season (19-above, 91-72)...it is also the earliest date ever for Texas to reach 17-over (previous: twice, June 22, 1996 and 2012)...matched a club record by winning their eight consecutive series (three times, last: June 1-27, 2010)...have won five of six, 10 of 13 and 13 of their last 19 road games to improve to 18-15 (.545) on the road...are 3-4 against the A's in 2016, and have won eight of the past 13 meetings dating back to 2015...are 21-14 at the Coliseum since the start of the 2013 season...are 5-2 on this 10-game road trip to Seattle (2-1), Oakland (3-1), and St. Louis (three games).
- Colby Lewis took a perfect game into the eighth inning (Alonso walk) and a no-hitter into the ninth inning before allowing a double to Max Muncy with no outs...he is the first Rangers pitcher to take a no-hitter into the ninth inning and retire the first 21 batters of a game since Yu Darvish (26) did so against Houston on April 2, 2013...the two-hitter matched the low-hit complete game of Lewis' career (twice: Sept. 11, 2015 vs. Oak, June 19, 2010 at Houston)...is 6-0 with a 2.81 ERA (29 er in 93.0 ip) in 14 starts this season...it is the first time in his career that he has started a season 6-0...it is his longest single-season winning streak and matches the longest win streak of his career (also: Sept. 9, 2011-April 28, 2012)...it is also the first 6-0 start by a member of the Rangers' season-opening rotation since Alexi Ogando in 2011...is 4-0 with a 1.29 ERA (7 er in 49.0 ip) in seven road starts...is 12-4 with a 2.80 ERA (53 er in 170.1 ip) in 28 career games, including 26 starts, against Oakland...has five consecutive wins against the A's...is 5-0 with a 2.83 ERA (17 er in 54.0 ip) in eight starts against American League West competition.
- Adrian Beltre (3-for-5, 2b, 2 rbi) made his first start in seven games due to a left hamstring strain...recorded his third three-hit game and 17th multi-hit game this season.
- lan Desmond (2-for-3, 2 r, hr, rbi, 2 bb) is batting .388 (40-for-103) over his last 24 games...is hitting .358 (78-for-218) over his last 53 games...recorded his team-leading 29th multi-hit game of the season.
- Nomar Mazara (0-for-5, r) is hitless in his last 21 at-bats.
- Mitch Moreland (2-for-4, rbi, so) extended his hitting streak to eight games (.387, 12-for-31)...recorded his 10th multi-hit game.
- Rougned Odor (2-for-5, r, 2b, 2 so) is batting .278 (15-for-54) with five home runs and eight RBI over his last 13 games...recorded his 20th multi-hit game.
