OAKLAND NOTES

• The **Oakland A's** snapped a three-game losing streak and are now 1-3 against the Angels this season...the A's face the Angels in six of their next eight contests...improved to 11-15 against division opponents and 15-19 at home...have commited nine errors in their last 11 games (45 for the season)... celebrated their third walk-off victory of the season and are now 8-12 in one-run ballgames...are 2-3 on this nine-game homestand against Texas (1-3), Los Angeles-AL (1-0) and Milwaukee (two games).

• Kendall Graveman allowed one run in seven innings to earn his fourth no-decision in his last five starts... is now 1-3 with a 2.97 ERA (12 er in 36.1 ip) in six home starts...has now won or come away with a no-decision in seven of his 13 starts this season.

- Yonder Alonso (2-for-3, sac fly, rbi) is hitting .386 (17-for-44) with four doubles and six RBI over his last 13 games after going 6-for-44 (.136) with no extra base hits and one RBI over his previous 17 contests.
- Coco Crisp (1-for-4, 3b, so) surpassed Carney Lansford, Reggie Jackson and Billy North for fifth on Oakland's all-time triples list with 24.
- Khris Davis (2-for-4, hr, rbi, r, so) is 9-for-25 (.360) with nine RBI over his last seven games...is batting .282 (42-for-149) with 13 of his 16 home runs at night.
- Jed Lowrie (1-for-4, so) is batting .280 (21-for-75) in 19 games at second base since being reinstated from the 15-day disabled list May 25.
- Danny Valencia (2-for-4, r, 2b, 2 so) is batting .347 (43-for-124) with 10 home runs and 24 RBI in 33 games since being reinstated from the DL May 6.

LOS ANGELES-AL NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels have lost eight of their last 11 games and 14 of the 22...had their five-game winning streak at the Colisuem dating back to last year snapped...dropped to 5-10 in June and 12-11 against division opponents...fell to 14-18 on the road...are 0-1 on this six-game road trip against Oakland (0-1) and Houston (three games).
- Matt Shoemaker gave up two runs (one earned) over six innings and is now 2-2 with a 2.19 ERA (12 er in 49.1 ip) in his last seven starts after posting a 1-5 record with a 9.12 ERA (25 er in 24.2 ip) in his first six.
- Kole Calhoun (1-for-4, hr, r, rbi, so) has hit safely in three straight games...is 7-for-17 (.412) against the A's this season...has scored 28 runs over his last 32 games and recorded 13 RBI in his last 14 contests.
- Johnny Giavotella (1-for-3, rbi, sac fly, 2b) extended his hitting streak to six consecutive games... is 10-for-23 (.435) during that span.
- Albert Pujols (1-for-3, bb) surpassed Roberto Alomar (2,724) for 60th on the all-time hits list in the first inning... is now one hit shy of tying Chipper Jones (2,726) on the all-time list... is now a career 5-for-11 (.455) with a homer against Oakland's Kendall Graveman.
