OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost five of their last six games and 12 of their last 15 to drop to 4-12 in June...are 1-5 this season against the Angels and have lost nine of their last 11 overall against Los Angeles-AL dating back to last year...have now lost 14 of their 22 season series this year, including six out of 11 at home...fell to 15-21 at home and 11-17 against division opponents...are 2-5 on this nine-game homestand against Texas (1-3), Los Angeles-AL (1-2) and Milwaukee (two games).
- Eric Surkamp** allowed two earned runs in a career-high tying six innings...tossed six innings one other time in his first career start on Aug. 27, 2011...remains winless in eight starts this season at 0-5 with a 7.20 ERA (28 er in 35 ip), including an 0-2 home record.
- Yonder Alonso** (1-for-3) is batting .353 (18-for-51) with four doubles and six RBI over his last 15 games after going 6-for-44 (.136) with no extra base hits and one RBI over his previous 17 contests.
- Jake Smolinski** (0-for-3) had his career-high seven-game hitting streak snapped...was 9-for-18 during that span, including two home runs and six RBI.
- Danny Valencia** (0-for-3) had his two-game hitting streak snapped and is batting .338 (44-for-130) with 10 home runs and 25 RBI in 35 games since being reinstated from the disabled list May 6.
- Stephen Vogt** (0-for-2, bb) is batting .200 (17-for-85) during day games compared to .308 (37-for-120) at night.

LOS ANGELES-AL NOTES

- The **Los Angeles Angels** have won four of their last five games and took their second season series over the A's this year (5-1 vs Oakland)...have won seven of the last eight games at the Coliseum and are 9-2 in the last 11 meetings against the A's dating back to last season...improved to 14-11 against division opponents and are now 16-18 on the road...are 2-1 on this six-game road trip against Oakland (2-1) and Houston (three games). **Jered Weaver** allowed three hits in a complete game to improve his record to 6-6 with a 5.10 ERA (48 er in 84.2 ip)...is now a career 14-11 with a 2.62 ERA (66 er in 226.1 ip) in 34 starts against Oakland.
- Yunel Escobar** (1-for-3, r, bb, 2 so) is batting .335 (55-for-164) with 11 doubles, 12 RBI and 21 runs over his last 42 games.
- Johnny Giavotella** (2-for-4) extended his hitting streak to eight games...is 13-for-32 (.406) during that span...recorded his 17th multi-hit game of the season.
- Albert Pujols** (0-for-4, rbi, so) is hitting 6-for-21 (.286) after going 2-for-19 (.105)
- Carlos Perez** (1-for-3, hr, r, rbi) belted his third homer of the season in the fifth inning...was hitting .094 (3-for-32) coming into today's game.
