#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The **Oakland A's** snapped a two-game losing streak to improve to 16-21 at home...are now 5-12 in June...snapped a two-game losing streak to Milwaukee dating back to their first meeting in June...improved to 20-34 against right-handed starters...are 2-4 in interleague play this season (1-2 vs. Cincinnati, 1-2 vs. Milwaukee)...starting today, the A's will play 20 consecutive days without a day off...are 3-5 on this nine-game homestand against Texas (1-3), Los Angeles-AL (1-2) and Milwaukee (1-0).
- Sonny Gray allowed two runs (one earned) over six innings and earned his fourth no-decision in the last nine starts...improved his ERA to 5.20 ERA (42 er in 72.2 ip) with a 3-6 record...is 0-1 with a 3.28 ERA (9 er in 24.2 ip) in four starts since being reinstated from the 15-day disabled list June 5...is now a career 3-3 with a 2.93 ERA (20 er in 61.1 ip) in 10 interleague appearances (nine starts).
- Yonder Alonso (1-for-4, rbi, r) is batting .345 (19-for-55) with four doubles and seven RBI over his last 16 games after going 6-for-44 (.136) with no extra base hits and one RBI over his previous 17 contests.
- Jed Lowrie (3-for-5, 2b) snapped an 0-for-7 slump and is batting .284 (25-for-88) in 22 starts at second base since being activated from the 15-day DL retroactive to May 10...recorded his 20th multi-hit game of the season.
- Marcus Semien (3-for-4, 3 rbi, 3b) snapped an 0-for-15 slump with his first inning single...recorded his 14th multi-hit game of the season...is the only Ahtletic to start and appear in all 70 games this year.
- Danny Valencia (2-for-4, r, 2b, hbp, roe) is now a career .351 (13-for-37) hitter against Milwaukee with two homers and nine RBI in 10 games...is batting .343 (46-for-134) with 10 home runs and 25 RBI in 36 games since being reinstated from the disabled list May 6.
- Stephen Vogt (2-for-5, rbi, 3b) is batting .307 (27-for-88) with 10 RBI over his last 24 games after hitting .238 with seven RBI over his first 33 contests.

#### MILWAUKEE NOTES

- The **Milwaukee Brewers** lost their fourth straight game and have lost seven of their last eight...dropped to 12-23 on the road...had won the previous two meetings against the A's back in June...fell to 8-5 in interleague play this season...are now 18-30 against right-handed starters...are 1-7 on this nine-game road trip against San Francisco (0-3), Los Angeles-NL (1-3) and Oakland (0-1).
- **Jimmy Nelson** allowed one earned run in five innings of work in his first ever appearance against the A's...recorded his fourth no-decision in 15 starts for the year to bring his record to 5-6 with a 3.80 ERA (38 er in 90 ip)...is now a career 8-15 with a 4.56 ERA (77 er in 152 ip) in 30 road games.
- Ryan Braun (2-for-4, rbi, r, 2b, so) extended his hitting streak to five games and is hitting .333 (10-for-30) on the current road trip, including a homer and two RBI...has hit safely in eight of his last nine contests.
- Aaron Hill (2-for-4) is hitting .315 (45-for-143) over his last 44 games, including six homers and 15 RBI...is 9-for-28 (.321) on this road trip.
- Jonathan Lucroy (1-for-3, r, bb) has hit safely in nine of his last 10 games and is batting .370 (10-for-27) on this road trip.
