**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is Game 8 (1-6) of a 9-game, 10-day road trip to San Francisco (0-3), Los Angeles (1-3) and Oakland (2g)....following this trip, the team returns to Miller Park for a 6-game, 8-day homestand against Washington (3g) and Los Angeles (3g).

**IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM:** RHP **Yhonathan Barrios** (right shoulder strain), OF **Rymer Liriano** (facial fractures) and LHP **Sean Nolin** (left elbow soreness) are currently on the 60-day disabled list....LHP **Chris Capuano** (left elbow soreness) and OF **Domingo Santana** (right elbow soreness) are currently on the 15-day disabled list.

**BREWERS IN THE STANDINGS (79 days):** The Brewers have spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the NL Central: **FIRST:** 0, **SECOND:** 1, **THIRD:** 1, **FOURTH:** 54, **FIFTH:** 23....the team is currently in fourth place, trailing the first-place Cubs by 17.0 games....the Brewers trail the second-place Cardinals by 5.5 games and the third-place Pirates by 3.0 games....are ahead of the fifth-place Reds by 4.0 games.

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** The Brewers are 6-11-6 in series play this season....**Game 1:** 10-13, **Game 2:** 7-16, **Game 3:** 11-8, **Game 4:** 3-2....**Sweep Wins (2):** at Atlanta (3g, 5/24-5/26) and vs. Oakland (2g, 6/7-6/8)....**Sweep Losses (3):** at Chicago-NL (2g, 4/26-4/28), at New York-NL (3g, 5/20-5/22) and at San Francisco (3g, 6/13-6/15).

**BREWERS AT HOME:** The Brewers are 19-17 at home this season, going 5-4-3 in series play....the team has two season-high 3-game home winning streaks (5/1-5/3 and 6/1-6/8) and a season-high 3-game home losing streak (4/21-4/23)....the team went 34-47 at home last season, going 8-15-3 in series play.

**BREWERS ON THE ROAD:** The Brewers are 12-22 on the road this season, going 1-7-3 in series play....the team had a season-high 4-game road winning streak from 5/24-6/2 and three season-high 4-game road losing streaks....the team went 34-47 on the road last season, going 8-17-1 in series play.

**LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE:** The Brewers have made 20 replay challenges, going 10-10....their last challenge (lost) came on 6/16 at Los Angeles as a safe call at home plate involving Joc Pederson scoring on a sacrifice fly before an out was made at second base stood....the team went 16-14 in replay challenges last season.

**MANAGER:** **Craig Counsell** is in his second season as manager of the Brewers (92-115) and first full season....he was named the 19th manager in franchise history on 5/4/15, replacing **Ron Roenicke**....he went 61-76 last season....bio is on p. 48 of the media guide.

**COACHES:** Returning from the 2015 staff: hitting coach **Darnell Coles** (2nd season), third base coach **Ed Sedar** (10th season, 6th as 3B coach) and bullpen coach **Lee Tunnell** (4th season)....new to the staff are pitching coach **Derek Johnson**, coach **Jason Lane**, bench coach **Pat Murphy** and first base/infield coach **Carlos Subero**.

# TONIGHT'S STARTER: #52 - RHP JIMMY NELSON (14gs, 5-6, 3.92)

**NELSON AT A GLANCE:** Jimmy Nelson, 27, is making his 15th start of the season and first against the Athletics....Nelson last started last Wednesday at San Francisco and took a 10-1 loss (3.2ip, 8h, 8r, 6er, 3bb, 2k)....he is 0-3 with a 9.69 ERA over his last 3 starts (13ip, 14er), raising his overall ERA from 2.88 to 3.92....Nelson has a team-leading 8 quality starts this season....opponents are batting .253 (79-for-312, 12hr)....the team is 7-7 in his starts....he was named Brewers Pitcher of the Month for May (6gs, 2-1, 2.66era)....Nelson was selected in the second round of the 2010 First-Year Player Draft....bio is on p. 114 of the media guide.

**LAST SEASON:** Nelson went 11-13 with a 4.11 ERA in 30 starts during his first full Major League season....he led the team in wins, starts, quality starts (13), innings (177.1) and strikeouts (148)....the Brewers went 14-16 in his starts....he posted an 8-1 record with a 1.08 ERA in his 13 quality starts (91.1ip, 11er)....in his final start of the season, 9/17 vs. St. Louis, he left the game in the third inning after being struck in the head by a Tommy Pham line drive....Nelson was placed on the 60-day disabled list on 9/22 with a head contusion.

**WE'RE GOING STREAKING!** From 7/24-8/9 last season, Nelson had a streak of 25.2 innings without allowing an earned run, the fifth-longest streak in a single season by a Brewers starter.

**CAREER:** Is 18-28 with a 4.14 ERA in 62 games, including 57 starts (341.2ip, 157er)....made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2013.

**CAREER AT MILLER PARK:** Is 10-13 with a 3.74 ERA in 33 games, including 30 starts (194.2ip, 81er)....went 5-4 with a 3.49 ERA in 14 starts last season (90.1ip, 35er)....is 4-3 with a 2.62 ERA in 8 starts this season (55ip, 16er)....**CAREER ON THE ROAD:** Is 8-15 with a 4.65 ERA in 29 games, including 27 starts (147ip, 76er)....went 6-9 with a 4.76 ERA in 16 starts last season (87ip, 46er)....is 1-3 with a 6.30 ERA in 6 starts this season (30ip, 21er).

**CAREER vs. ATHLETICS:** Nelson has never faced the A's.

**CAREER AT THE PLATE:** Is a .115 (12-for-104) hitter....has not homered....has 1 walk and 59 strikeouts....**LAST SEASON:** Batted .109 (6-for-55) with 2 RBI....had 1 walk and 34 strikeouts....had 3 sac bunts.  
**THIS SEASON:** Is batting .115 (3-for-26) with 1 RBI....has not walked and has 16 strikeouts....has 5 sac bunts.
