OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost six of their last eight games and are now 5-13 (.278) in June...are a season-high tying 13 games under .500 at 29-42 (.408), which is their worst record after 71 games since 1994 (26-45)...fell to 2-5 (.286) in interleague play...dropped to 16-22 (.421) at home...are now 5-4 (556) in two-run decisions...had their three-game winning streak in the Coliseum against Milwaukee snapped, and are now 1-3 against the Brewers this season...however, are 6-4 against Milwaukee in interleague play...finished 3-6 on this nine-game homestand against Texas (1-3), Los Angeles-AL (1-2) and Milwaukee (1-1)...leave following today's game for a six-game road trip to Los Angeles-AL (four games) and San Francisco (two games).
- The A's have committed 10 errors in the last nine games and 13 in the last 15 to bring their total to 50 errors for the season.
- Daniel Mengden is 0-3 with a 3.00 ERA (6 er in 18.0 ip) in three starts since being selected from Triple-A Nashville June 11...struck out a career-high nine batters while also surrendering a career-high three earned runs...has allowed a home run in each of his three starts...is the third pitcher in Oakland history to take the loss in each of his first three career games (also: Brady Rigby, Mike Morgan).
- Yonder Alonso (1-for-4, r, so) is batting .339 (20-for-59) with four doubles and seven RBI over his last 17 games.
- Coco Crisp (2-for-3, r, 2b, hr, rbi, bb, so) snapped an 0-for-9 hitless streak with a double in the first inning...recorded his 14th multi-hit game this season.
- Max Muncy (1-for-3, rbi) is batting 6-for-19 (.316) in Oakland.
- Danny Valencia (1-for-4) is batting .341 (47-for-138) with 10 home runs and 25 RBI in 37 games since being reinstated from the disabled list May 6...is a career .341 (14-for-41) hitter against Milwaukee with two homers and nine RBI in 11 games...is batting .378 (31-for-82) during the day.

MILWAUKEE NOTES

- The **Milwaukee Brewers** snapped their season-high tying four-game losing streak, but are 2-7 in their last nine contests...improved to 13-23 (.361) on the road to snap a season-high tying four-game road losing streak...are now 9-5 (.643) in interleague play...improved to 14-14 (.500) in day games...are 7-4 (.636) when playing on a Wednesday...snapped a three-game losing streak in Oakland and are 3-1 against the A's this season...finished 2-7 on this nine-game road trip against San Francisco (0-3), Los Angeles-NL (1-3) and Oakland (1-1)...leave following today's game for a six-game homestand against Washington (three games) and Los Angeles-NL (three games).
- Junior Guerra is 1-0 with a 3.96 ERA (11 er in 25.0 ip) in his last four starts...is 1-0 with a 4.30 ERA (14 er in 29.1 ip) in five road starts this season...faced the A's for the first time in his career.
- Ryan Braun (2-for-5, 3 so) extended his hitting streak to six games (11-for-26, .423)...finished this nine-game road trip hitting .343 (12-for-35) with a homer and two RBI.
- Ramon Flores (2-for-4, r, 2b, so) is batting .303 (30-for-99) with 10 RBI over his last 40 games...recorded his first three-hit and eighth multi-hit game this year.
- Scooter Gennett (3-for-5, r, hr, 2 rbi) finished 12-for-35 (.343) with two home runs and six RBI on this nine-game road trip.
- Aaron Hill (1-for-5) is hitting .311 (46-for-148) with six home runs and 15 RBI over his last 45 games...finished 10-for-33 (.303) on this nine-game road trip.
- Yadiel Rivera (1-for-3, r, rbi, so) made his first start since being recalled from Triple-A Colorado Springs June 21.
