OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have won three consecutive games and six of their last seven after going 4-13 over a 17-game stretch from June 3-22...have now won three straight against San Francisco this season to improve their interleague record to 5-5...have won 13 of the last 17 meetings against the Giants in Oakland...are 11-14 in June and improved to 17-22 at the Coliseum...are currently 7-2 during their 20-game stretch without a day off...are 1-0 on this current five-game homestand against San Francisco (1-0) and Pittsburgh (three games).
- Sean Manaea** threw 5.2 scoreless innings and recorded the win in his first start since being reinstated from the disabled list today...improved his record to 3-4 with a 5.40 ERA (33 er in 55 ip) in his 10th start of the year and career since being selected from Triple-A Nashville April 29.
- Coco Crisp** (2-for-4, 3b, r, rbi) extended his hitting streak to seven games...is 12-for-28 (.429) with 11 runs, four doubles, a triple, two home runs, nine RBI and six walks over that span...is 5-for-12 (.417) against San Francisco this year and a career .304 hitter (31-for-102) against the Giants.
- Khris Davis** was a late scratch from the starting lineup due to a left shoulder contusion.
- Jed Lowrie** (1-for-4, hr, r, 2 rbi) extended his hitting streak to six games with his second homer of the season in the third inning...is batting .284 (33-for-116) in 29 games since being reinstated from the 15-day DL May 25.
- Marcus Semien** (0-for-4, roe twice, 2 r, 3b) had his six-game hitting streak snapped after a scoring change...is 12-for-34 (.353) including three homers, 12 RBI and 11 runs over his last nine games.

SAN FRANCISCO NOTES

- The **San Francisco Giants** have lost three consecutive games and are now 5-6 in interleague play this season...have lost three straight games against the A's and are now an all-time 21-33 at the Coliseum during interleague, including 13 losses in the last 17 meetings in Oakland...the loss marks the fourth straight game they have given up seven or more runs, which is the most since 2006 when they gave up seven or more in five straight...are 0-1 on this five-game road trip against Oakland (0-1) and Arizona (three games).
- Jake Peavy** gave up seven runs (three unearned) over 3.1 innings of work and was charged with his seventh loss of the year...had his two-game winning streak end and is now 4-7 with a 5.23 ERA (48 er in 82.2 ip)...allowed his first home run in the last seven starts...is now 2-2 with a 3.23 ERA (11 er in 30.2 ip) in five career starts against the A's...recorded his sixth career start in which he failed to record a strikeout.
- Brandon Crawford** (1-for-3, rbi, so) is 31-for-82 (.378) with runners in scoring position this season.
- Angel Pagan** (0-for-3) had his nine-game hitting streak snapped...was 15-for-37 (.405) during that span, including 11 RBI over his last eight games.
- Ramiro Peña** (0-for-1) had his three-game hitting streak end...was 6-for-13 during that span...has appeared in 11 games (seven starts) and is hitting .400 (14-for-35) with six RBI.
