#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** lost their second consecutive game to snap a three-game winning streak...are 7-4 over the first 11 days of this 20-game stretch without a day off heading into the All-Star break...fell to 5-7 in interleague play and are now 17-24 overall at the Coliseum this season...fell below .500 (9-10) against opposing left-handed starters...are 1-2 on this current five-game homestand against San Francisco (1-1) and Pittsburgh (0-1).
- The **A's** have homered in a season-high 10 consecutive games (15 home runs total).
- Sonny Gray** allowed seven earned runs in six innings and was charged with his sixth consecutive loss and is now winless in his last 11 starts...is now 3-7 with a 5.42 ERA (51 er in 84.2 ip)...is now 3-4 with a 3.61 ERA (27 er in 67.1 ip) in 11 career interleague appearances, including 10 starts.
- Yonder Alonso** (1-for-3, r) has hit safely in three straight games, including back-to-back home runs in the previous two contests...is batting .342 (13-for-38) in interleague play, but is a career .164 (10-for-61) hitter against Pittsburgh.
- Khris Davis** (0-for-4, 3 so) had his six-game hitting streak snapped tonight after missing the previous two contests with a left shoulder contusion...is hitting .303 (20-for-66) with five homers, 17 RBI and 13 runs scored over his last 17 games.
- Jed Lowrie** (1-for-3, 2b, r, rbi, bb) extended his hitting streak to eight games (10-for-31, .323)...is batting .285 (35-for-123) in 31 games since being reinstated from the 15-day DL May 25.
- Marcus Semien** (1-for-4, hr, 2 rbi, r, so) hit his 17th homer of the season, an on-going career high, and has now scored a run in each of his last nine games (13 total runs)...is hitting .326 (14-for-43) over his last 11 games.

#### PITTSBURGH NOTES

- The **Pittsburgh Pirates** have won five out of their last seven games after dropping eight of their previous nine contests...won their first game in Oakland after losing all six previous meetings at the Coliseum...are now 2-11 all-time against the A's...improved to 17-22 on the road...are 2-1 on this nine-game road trip to Seattle (1-1), Oakland (1-0) and St. Louis (four games).
- Jeff Locke** allowed three earned runs over five innings to win his third consecutive game and improve to 8-5 with a 5.13 ERA (54 er in 94.2 ip)...is now 8-1 with a 2.80 ERA (22 er in 70.2 ip) in 11 career interleague starts, including an 1-1 record against the A's.
- Starling Marte** (0-for-3, r, hbp, so) had his six-game hitting streak snapped...is batting .423 (22-for-52) in 13 interleague games this season.
- Andrew McCutchen** (1-for-4, r, 2b, so) has hit safely in six of his last eight games...is batting .250 (14-for-56) with three homers in 15 games since moving to the third spot in the lineup.
- Jordy Mercer** (2-for-4, hr, r, 2 rbi, so) has now hit safely in 13 of his last 15 games, going 16-for-49 (.327) during that span.
