OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** have lost three consecutive games after winning six of the previous seven contests...fell to 35-46 (.432) on the season, which matches the sixth worst record at the halfway mark in Oakland history (last: 2009)...fell to 2-2 (.500) in extra-inning games...dropped to 6-5 (.545) in two-run games...have lost three consecutive games to the Pirates, including two in a row at the Coliseum...however, are still 11-3 all-time against Pittsburgh...fell to 5-8 (.385) in interleague play...are now 7-5 over the first 12 days of this 20-day stretch without a day off...are 1-3 on this current five-game homestand against San Francisco (1-1) and Pittsburgh (0-2).
- The **A's** played their first extra inning game at the Coliseum after 60 consecutive home games without an extra inning game since Aug. 18, 2015 vs. Los Angeles-NL...it was the second-longest such streak in Oakland history (74, May 29, 1970-May 2, 1971)...have gone a season-high eight consecutive games without an error, which is the longest errorless streak over the last eight years.
- Rich Hill** was reinstated from the disabled list today...is 5-0 with a 2.13 ERA (9 er in 38.0 ip) over his last six starts and has not allowed a home run over that stretch...made his first interleague appearance since Sept. 8, 2013 vs. New York-NL...is 1-2 with a 5.44 ERA (29 er in 48.0 ip) in 19 career interleague appearances, including eight starts...is 3-1 with a 3.69 ERA (19 er in 46.1 ip) in eight career starts against Pittsburgh.
- Ryan Dull** has a 0.50 ERA (1 er in 18.0 ip) and a .097 (6-for-62) opponents batting average over his last 17 games dating back to May 25.
- Coco Crisp** (1-for-5, r, 2b) hit his 300th career double in the 3rd inning to become one of 33 active players with 300 doubles...has hit safely in each of his last nine games (14-for-37, .378)...of his last 15 hits, 11 are for extra bases (seven doubles, two triples, two home runs).
- Khris Davis** (3-for-5) is hitting .324 (23-for-71) with five homers, 17 RBI and 13 runs scored over his last 18 games...recorded his second three-hit game this year.
- Jed Lowrie** (1-for-4, rbi, so, sf) extended his hitting streak to nine games (11-for-36, .306).
- Josh Reddick** (4-for-4, 2b, rbi, bb) recorded four hits, tying a career-high...it is the sixth time he has collected four hits in a single game, the second time this season...it was his 13th multi-hit game this year...snapped an 0-for-11 streak with a single in the first inning.

PITTSBURGH NOTES

- The **Pittsburgh Pirates** have won six out of their last eight games after dropping eight of their previous nine contests...have won three consecutive games against the A's, including two in a row at the Coliseum...improved to 6-8 in interleague play and are 45-29 (.608) against the American League since the start of the 2013 season...improved to 18-22 (.450) on the road...recorded their 10th comeback victory...are 3-1 on this nine-game road trip to Seattle (1-1), Oakland (2-0) and St. Louis (four games).
- Chad Kuhl** is 1-0 with a 4.09 ERA (5 er in 11.0 ip) in two starts this season...made his first career appearance against Oakland.
- Starling Marte** (1-for-3, r, rbi, 2 bb, sb) is batting .354 (23-for-65) in his last 17 games...is batting .418 (23-for-55) in 14 interleague games this season.
- Andrew McCutchen** (1-for-4, 2 r, bb, so) has hit safely in seven of his last nine games (9-for-36, .250)...is batting .250 (15-for-60) with three homers in 16 games since moving to the third spot in the lineup.
- Jordy Mercer** (1-for-4, 2b, so, sac) has now hit safely in 14 of his last 16 games, going 17-for-53 (.321) during that span...is hitting .314 (22-for-70) in 18 games from the leadoff spot in the lineup.
