PITTSBURGH PIRATES (39-41) vs. OAKLAND ATHLETICS (35-45)

JULY 2, 2016 at Oakland Coliseum, Oakland, CA --- GAME #81/ROAD #40 RHP CHAD KUHL (1-0, 5.40 ERA) vs. LHP RICH HILL (8-3, 2.25 ERA)

THE PIRATES... have gone 5-2 in their last seven games after losing eight-of-nine... Were a season-high nine games over .500 following their win in Texas on 5/27 (28-19); have gone 11-22 since then... Won a season-high six straight games from 4/24-30... Were 46-34 after 80 games in 2015 (47-34 after 81).

ON THE MOUND: Pittsburgh's ninth-round selection in the 2013 First-Year Player Draft, Chad Kuhl, is making his second big league start tonight...He made his Major League debut last Sunday night and defeated Clayton Kershaw and the Dodgers, 4-3, at PNC Park (5.0ip/3er)...Kuhl went 6-2 with a 2.58 ERA (76.2ip/22er) in 14 starts with Triple-A starts with Indianapolis this season, posting a 0.99 ERA (45.2ip/5er) in his first eight assignments thru 5/21...In addition, Kuhl's 2.89 ERA since the start of the 2014 season is the fourth-lowest in all of minor league baseball among pitchers with at least 350.0ip.

LEADING THINGS OFF: In his last six starts from the leadoff position, **Jordy Mercer** has gone 6-for-17 with a home run, three walks and three runs scored...He connected off Jon Lester for his first career leadoff homer on 6/18 at Wrigley Field...Mercer is hitting .318 (21-for-66) with five doubles, two home runs, a .400 on-base percentage, .485 slugging percentage and an .885 OPS in 17 games this season from the leadoff spot in the order.

<u>HOT ROD:</u> Sean Rodriguez tied his career high (fourth time) with four RBI Wednesday in Seattle...He reached base safely four times in five plate appearances Wednesday and has gone 4-for-7 with five RBI and four walks in his last three games with an at bat...Rodriguez has hit safely in each of his last nine starts, going 11-for-30 (.367) with eight RBI.

PEN PALS: The Bucco relievers have combined to retire 24 of the last 25 batters they have faced...They have pitched 24.2 consecutive scoreless innings and have struck out 20 batters, dating back to the seventh inning last Friday night (6/24).

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: Since the start of the 2013 season, the Pirates have posted a 44-29 (.603) record in interleague play; the second-best record behind the Red Sox (42-27, .609) among all Major League teams...In that same time, the Bucs have gone 24-14 against American League teams on the road.

<u>BUCS/A's:</u> The Pirates have gone 2-11 against the Athletics during interleague play, which includes a 1-6 record here in Oakland...The Bucs lost each of their first 10 meetings with the A's before winning the last two meetings.

JUNG HO AND THE A.L.: Jung Ho Kang is hitting .333 (8-for-24) with three home runs and seven RBI in seven interleague games this season and .360 (32-for-89) with six homers and 15 RBI in 24 career games against American League teams... In his last 12 interleague games, Kang is hitting .422 (19-for-45) with five home runs.

MOVING UP THE CHARTS: Andrew McCutchen is tied with Frank Thomas (163) for seventh place on the club's all-time home run list...Brian Giles ranks sixth with 165 and Dave Parker is fifth with 166...In Pittsburgh's 130 seasons of play in the National League, only two right-handed batters have hit more home runs than McCutchen; Hall-of-Famers Ralph Kiner (301) and Roberto Clemente (240).

SAVING THE DAY: Bucco closer **Mark Melancon** has converted each of his last 18 save situations dating back to 4/27...He has gone 22-for-23 in save opportunities this season, suffering his only blown save on 4/24 at Arizona...His 73 saves since the beginning of last season are tops in all of Major League Baseball and his 106 since the start of the 2014 season rank second in the Majors behind Trevor Rosenthal (107)...Melancon's 93.8 save pct. since 2014 is the best mark in MLB.

BUCN ON THE ROAD: The Bucs are 2-1 on this nine-game, 10-day road trip following their two-game split in Seattle and last night's 7-3 victory...The trip concludes with four games in St. Louis, beginning with a 4th of July contest at 1:15 CDT.

<u>PLEASED WITH FELIZ:</u> Neftali Feliz has produced a 1.96 ERA (18.1ip/4er) in his last 22 appearances and has been scored upon in just five of his 35 games overall...In his last 15 games against Oakland, Feliz has posted a 0.64 ERA (14.0ip/1er).

A STARLING SHINING BRIGHT: Starling Marte hit .345 (29-for-84) in 25 games last month and currently ranks third in the league with a .327 average...Marte also ranks third in the league in multi-hit games (31), second in stolen bases (21) and is seventh in hits (92).

HOW MAY I ASSIST YOU?: 2015 Gold Glove Award winner Starling Marte shares the National League lead in outfield assists (nine) after leading the circuit with 16 last season...As a team, the Pirates rank second in the league with 19 outfield assists, trailing only the Atlanta Braves (22).

LEADING THINGS OFF: John Jaso connected off Jeff Samardzija for his second leadoff home run of the season on 6/22 and the sixth of his career...Jaso is hitting .360 (18-for-50) with seven walks and 11 runs scored in the first inning this season... As a team, Pittsburgh's leadoff hitters rank first in the league in batting average (.303), third in OPS (.833), third in on-base percentage (.379) and fourth in slugging percentage (.454).

REJOYCE REJOYCE: Matt Joyce, who is hitting .320 (8-for-25) overall in his last 11 games, has gone 10-for-28 (.357) as a pinch hitter this season, leading MLB in home runs (4), RBI (13) and runs scored (9)...Joyce's four pinch hit home runs are tied with **Mark Johnson** (1996) for the second-most in club history behind **Craig Wilson** (7 in 2001), and his 13 RBI are three shy of the club record of 16 set by **Willie Stargell** in 1982.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

July 2, 1990: The Padres took a 3-0 lead in the first inning but never scored again as the Pirates came back for a 4-3, 14-inning win at Jack Murphy Stadium in San Diego. Jay Bell broke a 3-3 tie in the 14th inning, bringing home Jose Lind with the winning run. Lefty Bob Patterson earned the win in relief for the Bucs after tossing 3.0 scoreless frames.
