OAKLAND NOTES

• The **Oakland A's** are 3-2 in their last five games...snapped a four-game home losing streak to improve their record to 18-26 (.409) at home...are now 11-15 (.423) in one-run games...improved to 25-30 (.455) at night...improved to 2-2 against the Blue Jays this season and are 31-38 against Toronto dating back to 2008...are 1-0 on this current 10-game homestand against Toronto (1-0), Houston (three games), and Tampa Bay (three games).

• Yonder Alonso and Bob Melvin were ejected by home plate umpire Mark Wegner in the fourth inning for arguing balls and strikes, their first respective ejections this season...Ryon Healy (0-for-4, so, gidp) made his Major League debut.

• The A's have made five errors in the past two games to snap an Athletics franchise record streak of 15 consecutive games without an error...hit back-to-back home runs from Davis and Vogt in the fifth inning, the fourth time the A's have done so this season (last: Khris Davis and Coco Crisp, April 21 at New York-AL).

- Daniel Mengden is 0-2 with a 10.80 ERA (16 er in 13.1 ip) over his last three starts... is 0-2 with a 8.16 ERA (13 er in 14.1 ip) in three starts against American League teams... now has 39 punch outs this season, placing him fifth for most strikeouts by an Athletic through his first seven games (fourth: Blake Stein, 41, 1998).
- Jed Lowrie (1-for-4, r, 2 so) has hit safely in four straight games (6-for-18, .333)...has hit safely in each of his three games against Toronto (4-for-13, .308).
- Khris Davis (3-for-4, hr, 3 rbi) is hitting .300 (60-for-200) with 17 of his 20 home runs at night...it is his third straight season with 20 or more home runs.
 Josh Reddick (2-for-2, 4 r, hr, rbi, 2 bb) is batting .239 (11-for-46) with one home run and three RBI in 13 games since being reinstated from the disabled
- list...scored four runs in a game for the first time this season and second time in his career (also: May 11, 2012 vs. Detroit).
 Danny Valencia (1-for-2) played first base for the first time since July 22, 2015 (with Toronto at Oakland)...had played 120 games since last appearing at first
- base...it is his 26th career game playing first base...snapped an 0-for-5 hitless streak with a single in his first at-bat in the sixth inning.
- Stephen Vogt (3-for-4, 2 r, hr, 3 rbi) is batting .356 (21-for-59) over his last 17 games...has eight home runs, all solo shots off right-handed pitchers.

• The **Toronto Blue Jays** have lost two of their past three games...fell to 24-21 (.533) on the road...dropped to 8-3 (.727) in July...are now 14-25 (.359) when opponents score first...are 2-2 against the A's this season, but are still 10-7 against Oakland since the 2014 season...have scored 190 runs in 29 games since June 11 (6.55 runs per game)...are 0-1 on this five-game road trip to Oakland (0-1) and Arizona (two games).

• Marcus Stroman is 1-2 with a 6.43 ERA (20 er in 28.0 ip) over his last five starts...is 3-1 with a 5.46 ERA (35 er in 57.2 ip) in nine starts at night...is 0-0 with a 4.63 ERA (6 er in 11.2 ip) in two starts against Oakland...allowed three home runs in a game for the first time in his career (2, twice, last: May 28, 2016 vs. Boston).

• Josh Donaldson (1-for-4, r, rbi, bb, gidp) has reached base safely in 20 straight games and is batting .403 (31-for-77) over that strech.

• Kevin Pillar (1-for-4, r, rbi) has hit safely in eight straight games (12-for-29, .414)...is batting .326 (42-for-129) over his last 32 games.

• Devon Travis (2-for-3, rbi, bb) extended his road hitting streak to 11 games (21-for-42, .500)...is batting .348 (24-for-69) on the road...is batting .344 (33-for-96) with 17 RBI over his last 24 games.
