Overall have won **eight** of its last **nine** and **18** of their last **25** games...Posted **51** wins before the break, the **3**<sup>rd</sup> most in franchise history prior to the break...The last time the club won 50 prior to the
- break was the 1992 World Series championship team...

  R.A. Dickey recorded 7.0 IP in three consecutive outings for the first time since doing so in four straight starts July 23-August 7, 2015...Has made 60 consecutive home starts with at least 5.0 innings pitched, the longest active streak in baseball...Allowed a stolen base to Cameron Maybin in the 3rd inning was the first stolen base he had given up in his last 35 starts (since July 4, 2015 at DET).

♠ In the 28 games since June 11, TOR has scored 183 runs (6.54) runs per game); most in ML...Have scored 10+ runs an AL-best 10 times this season with eight of those contests coming since June 11...Have also scored **5+** runs in **seven** of their last **nine...**The club's **+75** run differential ranks **2**<sup>nd</sup> in AL (CLE **+81**).

- Blue Jays starting pitchers have allowed just 1 Total Bases in 21 AB (.048 SLG) on 0-0 counts over the past 14 days (10 starts). (MLB Rank: 1st of 30 teams' SP's; League Avg: .570). Blue Jays starting pitchers' BABIP is .268 this season. (MLB

#### THE JULY ROAD TRIP:

- Today, the Blue Jays embark on the lone road trip for the month of July...Will play the **opener** of a **3-GM** set in Oakland, before finishing the trip with a **2-GM** series in Arizona.
- Michael Saunders is batting .297 with 21-XBH (11-HR) & a .587 SLG on the road this season...The .587 SLG & .948 OPS ranks 4th in the AL on the road.

- <u>BLUE JAYS vs. ATHLETICS</u>: All-Time: 189-213...All-Time, Road: 97-105...**2016: 2-1**
- Have won six of their last seven & seven of their last nine vs. the Athletics, dating back to last season....Have outscored them 53-28
- over this stretch, while out homering them **16-6**. Since 2014, the Jays are **10-6** vs. OAK...In that time the pitching staff has held the A's to a **2.56** ERA (144lp/41ER), the  $\mathbf{5}^{\text{th}}$  lowest mark for any team vs. any one opponent (min 15G) over that stretch. **Five** Blue Jays currently sit with a lifetime average of **.300** or better
- vs. Oakland...Darwin Barney .571 (4-7), Russell Martin .400 (10-25), Kevin Pillar - .375 (15-40), Ezequeil Carrera - .368 (7-19) & Josh Donaldson - .324 (12-37).

- LEGENDARY COMPANY:

  ♣ Only five players in AL history have ever scored 80 runs and hit 20 homers prior to the All-Star break...Josh Donaldson joined that group on Sunday...The list includes **Lou Gehrig** (1936), **Ted Williams** (1946), **Reggie Jackson** (1969), **Frank Thomas** (1994) & Alex Rodriguez (2000).
- Josh has recorded a hit in 27 of his last 31G while batting .408 (49-120) with 22-XBH, 33-RBI, 25-BB, .517 OBP & a .792 SLG... Has reached base safely in 42 of his last 43 contests while batting .366 (59-161) with 25-XBH & a .493 OBP (38-BB) over that period...Ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> in WAR on the season at 5.4 (Mike Trout – 5.5).
- Josh Donaldson's OBP is .526 in the past 30 days (24 games). (MLB Rank: 1st of 224 full-time players; League Avg: .338).

- Edwin Encarnacion currently ranks 1<sup>st</sup> in the Majors with 80 RBI & T3rd in the AL with 23 HR... His 80 RBI are 3<sup>rd</sup> most in Blue Jays history prior to the break...Delgado with 97 & Wells with 84 both in 2003 are the only players with more...Is now just 3 HR shy of Vernon Wells for 4th on the all-time Blue Javs list at 223.
- The 143 RBI by Donaldson and Encarnacin are the 4th most by a Blue Jays duo prior to the break...All three higher figures involved Carlos Delgado, with the 181 he (97) and Wells (84) posted in 2003 sitting 1st.

#### ROAD WARRIOR:

Devon Travis comes into the game tonight on a 10-GM road hitting streak...Over that stretch owns.487 (19-49) average with 5-2B, 4HR, 12RBI & a 1.447 OPS...Has seven multi-hit games in those 10 contests...The 1.447 OPS ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> in MLB over the past month.

- Ranks 1st in MLB for groundball percentage (59.9%)...Has induced opposing hitters to ground into seven double plays in 25 opportunities (28.0%) versus RHB over his last 10 starts (since May 17) the highest percentage over that stretch (League Avg: 12.2%).
- Through his first eight starts of 2016 posted a 3.54 ERA with a .220 opponents'average...In his last 10, his ERA is 6.15 with a .309 opponents' average, however, has allowed just three earned runs in his last 14.2 IP) over his last two starts...Opp. have hit just .151 in those games.
- SHUTTING THEM DOWN: Over his last two starts RHH are batting only .077 (2-26) with just a .111 OBP (3-27)...In those outings has a strike percent of 72.3% (60/83) against righties.
