#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland A's** had their two-game winning streak snapped and are 3-3 in their last six games...have lost nine consecutive games against left-handed starters and are now 9-14 (.600) in games started by an opposing left-handed pitcher...fell to 8-6 (.571) in two-run games...dropped to 15-22 (.405) in day games...fell to 19-27 (.413) at home...finished 3-3 in the season series with the Blue Jays and are 22-23 against Toronto dating back to 2011...are 2-1 on this current 10-game homestand against Toronto (2-1), Houston (three games), and Tampa Bay (four games).
- The **A's** have made errors in four consecutive games, seven in total, to snap an Athletics franchise record streak of 15 consecutive games without an error... have hit seven home runs in three games since the All-Star Break after hitting five over their previous nine games.
- A's pinch hitters** are 5 for their last 10 (.500) and are 17-for-69 (.246) this season...have 13 RBI and four extra base hits.
- Rich Hill** left the game after five pitches due to a blister on his pitching hand...is the first A's pitcher since at least 1913 to face no batters in a starting assignment...**Andrew Triggs** left the game with a left calf contusion...**Sean Manaea** made his first career appearance in relief, tossing 5.0 innings.
- Yonder Alonso** (1-for-2, 2b, 2 rbi) is batting .316 (37-for-117) over his last 37 games.
- Jed Lowrie** (2-for-4, so) is 6-for-16 (.375) in four starts batting leadoff this year...is 23-for-54 (.426) in 13 career starts batting leadoff.
- Marcus Semien** (1-for-4, r, hr, rbi, 2 so) has 20 home runs and 48 RBI, both career highs...is 14-for-67 (.209) over his last 18 games, but 11 of the 14 hits are for extra bases (three doubles, one triple, seven home runs).
- Danny Valencia** (2-for-4, r, so) is batting .307 (65-for-212) in 56 games since being reinstated from the DL May 6.

#### TORONTO NOTES

- The **Toronto Blue Jays** snapped a two-game losing streak and are 9-3 in their last 12 games...improved to 25-22 (.532) on the road...are now 9-4 (.692) in July...tied the season series 3-3 with the Athletics and have won seven of their last 10 against Oakland...have scored 199 runs in 31 games since June 11 (6.42 runs per game)...are 1-2 on this five-game road trip to Oakland (1-2) and Arizona (two games).
- J.A. Happ** is 6-0 with a 3.19 ERA (15 er in 42.1 ip) over his last seven starts...is 4-0 with a 3.17 ERA (17 er in 48.1 ip) in nine career games, including seven starts, against Oakland...is 1-0 with a 3.77 ERA (6 er in 14.1 ip) in four games, including three starts, at the Coliseum.
- Josh Donaldson** (2-for-5, r) has reached base safely in 22 straight games and is batting .388 (33-for-85) with 18 walks over that stretch...it is tied for the longest active streak in the Majors with Jayson Werth...recorded his 27th multi-hit game this season.
- Edwin Encarnacion** (1-for-4, 1bb, so) is batting .394 (13-for-33) over his last 20 games.
- Russell Martin** (2-for-3, r, 2b, bb, hbp) is batting .324 (12-for-37) over his past 10 games...recorded his 11th multi-hit game this season.
- Troy Tulowitzki** (1-for-4, r, hr, 2 rbi) is batting .318 (28-for-88) with eight home runs and 23 RBI over his last 21 games.
