#### .AST NIGHT:

- Last night, the Blue Jays dropped the second of a 3-GM set to Oakland by a 5-4 score...Marked the second staright game out of the break the team lost by One run...Fell to **9-17** in one-run contests this season...Lost a series for the first time since June 24-26 at CWS.
- R.A Dickey allowed five runs over six innings...Had not allowed more than 4ER in his past 14 outing prior to yesterday...Has now allowed 109 home runs since joining the club in 2013, the most in MLB.

## KEEP ON RUNNUNG:

In the **30** games since **June 11**, TOR has scored **194** runs **(6.47** runs per game); most in ML (MIN 2<sup>nd</sup> at 176)...Have scored **10+** runs an AL-best 10 times this season with eight of those contests coming since June 11...Have also scored 5+ runs in eight of their last 10

Josh Donaldson and Edwin Encarnacion rank 1st and 2nd in the AL since June 11 in runs scores with 34 & 31 respectively...In fact Josh Donaldson currently leads the Majors with 81 runs scored, six more than Mookie Betts.

## **STARTING ON RIGHT FOOT:**

- Have a ML-leading 59 quality starts...The rotation has limited the opposition to 3ER or less in 12 of their last 14 and 2ER or less in nine of their last 14 games...Lead all of baseball with 590.0 innings
- Of the top 10 pitchers with the lowest batting average in RISP, the Blue Jays have three starters among the group...R.A. Dickey ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> at .198 (17-86), while J.A. Happ is 4<sup>th</sup> at .200 (18-90) & Aaron Sanchez sits at 5<sup>th</sup> with a .208 (21-101) mark...Overall the club ranks T1<sup>st</sup> (CLE) in the AL with a .238 opp. Avg. with RISP. Hitters are batting only .262 against Blue Jays starting
- pitchers (72-for-275) on 0-0 counts this season. (MLB Rank: 1st of 30 teams' SP's; League Avg: .346).

## **TAKIN A THOLE:**

Josh Thole recorded his 2<sup>nd</sup> straight multi-hit game yesterday, going 2-3 with 2RBI...Over is last two is 4-6 with 4RBI...The last time Thole recorded multi-hits in back-to-back games was July 23-28, 2014, both vs. BOS.

## **ROAD WARRIOR**:

**Devon Travis** comes into the game today on an **11-GM** road hitting streak...Over that stretch owns.**500** (21-42) average with **5-2B**, **4HR**, 13RBI & a 1.448 OPS...Has eight multi-hit games in those 11 contests...Has a 1.469 OPS over the past month, 1st in MLB.

### THE JULY ROAD TRIP:

- Today, the Blue Jays continue the lone road trip for the month of July...Will play the **finale** of a **3-GM** set in Oakland, before finishing the trip with a **2-GM** series in Arizona.
- Michael Saunders is batting .286 with 21-XBH (11-HR) & a .565 SLG on the road this season...The .565 SLG ranks 6<sup>th</sup> in the AL, while his **.919** OPS ranks **10**<sup>th</sup> on the road.
- Josh Donaldson has posted a .544 SLG on the road in 2016, the 13th best mark in the AL.

## **BLUE JAYS vs. ATHLETICS**:

- All-Time: 189-215...All-Time, Road: 97-107...2016: 2-3
  Have won six of their last nine & seven of their last 11 vs. the Athletics, dating back to last season....Have outscored them 64-41
- Four Blue Jays currently sit with a lifetime average of .300 or better vs. Oakland...Darwin Barney .444 (4-9), Russell Martin .355 (11-31), Kevin Pillar .333 (16-48) & Josh Thole .320 (8-25).

### **LEGENDARY COMPANY:**

- Only five players in AL history have ever scored 80 runs and hit 20 homers prior to the All-Star break...Josh Donaldson joined that group on Sunday...The list includes Lou Gehrig (1936), Ted Williams (1946), Reggie Jackson (1969), Frank Thomas (1994) & Alex Rodriguez (2000)
- Josh has recorded a hit in 28 of his last 33G while batting .394 (50-127) with 22-XBH, 34-RBI, 27-BB, .506 OBP & a .756 SLG... Has reached base safely in 44 of his last 45 contests while batting .357 (60-168) with **25**-XBH & a .486 OBP (40-BB) over th period...Ranks  $2^{nd}$  in **WAR** on the season at **5.4** (Mike Trout – 5.5).
- Josh Donaldson has an **OBP of .465** in the past 60 days (50 games). (MLB Rank: 1st of 213 full-time players; League Avg: .331).

- Edwin Encarnacion currently ranks 1<sup>st</sup> in the Majors with 81 RBI & 4<sup>th</sup> in the AL with 24 HR... His 80 RBI are 3<sup>rd</sup> most in Blue Jays history prior to the break...Delgado with 97 & Wells with 84 both in 2003 are the only players with more...Is now just 2 HR shy of Vernon Wells for 4th on the all-time Blue Javs list at 223.
- Edwin Encarnacion's OPS is 1.027 (220 PA's) over the past 60 days. (MLB Rank: 5th of 213 full-time players; League Avg: .771).

## RETURNING TO FORM:

- Over his last 20 contests, Troy Tulowitzki is batting .321 (27-84) with 7-HR, 21-RBI & a .983 OPS... Over his first 47 games this season posted a .199 AVG (34-171) with 8 HR, 23 RBI & just a .658
- Troy Tulowitzki is hitting .435 (10-for-23) versus starting pitchers over the past 14 days (10 games). (MLB Rank: 5th of 158 full-time players; League Avg: .272)

## **COMING AROUND:**

- From April through May, Blue Jays relievers had posted a **4.38 ERA**, **.265 opp. Avg** and an **8-18** record...Since July 1 are **2-3** with a **2.03 ERA**, (40.0IP/9ER) and a **.200 opp avg...Both marks represent** the best figures in the AL since July 1.
- Blue Jays relief pitchers have a first-pitch strike percentage of 65.1% (697/1070) this year. (MLB Rank: this is the highest in all of MLB of 30 teams' RP's; League Avg: 59.5%)
- Opponents have hit only 2 fly balls out of 13 balls in play (15.4% Fly Ball Pct) against Blue Jays relief pitchers with runners in scoring position in the past 14 days (10 games). (MLB Rank: 2nd highest of 30 teams' RP's; League Avg: 34.6%)

## A STEADY CLIMB:

Overall this season TOR ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> in runs scored (458), OBP (.334) & 2<sup>nd</sup> in HR (133)...Began the season slowly, however, have improved offensive totals in each month.

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TODAY'S START & HIGHLIGHTS:

Is looking to set a new career-high in wins, after matching his high of 12 victories in the first half of the season (2nd time, last: 2009)...Became the 6th Blue Jays pitcher to record at least 12 wins prior to the All-Star

break in club history, and first since Roy Halladay won 12 in 2006.

- Mas recorded 14 GIDP's this season, T-4th in AL only to Martin Perez & Mike Pelfrey both with 21 & teammate R.A. Dickey's 15... Has induced opposing hitters to ground into 14 double plays in 72 opportunities (19.4%) 6th highest pct. in MLB League Avg: 11.4%).
- In nine of his 18 starts this season has limited the opposition to one earned run or less...In fact, has held opposing teams to three earned runs or fewer in 14 of his outings this season...His 2.71 ERA since August 15, 2015 ranks 5th in ML (Kershaw- 1.69, Arrieta- 1.82, Bumgarner- 2.09, Strasburg- 2.36).
- Lefties are batting .275 (19-69) off of him this season the 10th highest mark by a LHP in baseball...Has struck out just 10 left-handed hitters (79 PA), with lefties chasing just 22.7% (39/172) of his pitches.
- Ranks 7th in ML with a .200 opposition average with RISP, while his .247 opponents' OBP in those situations ranks 2nd in all of baseball... Over his last four starts has held opposing hitters to just a .118 average (4-34) with runners in scoring position.
- BRING THE HEAT(ER): has struck out 20 of his last 50 batters faced while issuing just one BB, over a span of two starts...In those outings has a miss percent of 32.4 (34/105)...Overall this season 54 of his 79 SO vs. RHB have come on his fastball.
- Won his sixth consecutive decision in his last start July 8 vs. DET...Did not allow an earned run for the 3rd time in his 18 outings this season... Issued a walk in the 6th inning, snapping a streak of 14 consecutive innings pitched without walking a batter.

- Picked up the win June 11 vs. BAL despite surrendering 3-HR...Had his streak of 86 LHB faced without allowing an XBH snapped after the Chris Davis HR...Allowed multi-HR in consecutive starts for the 1st time since May 6-12, 2012...Allowed 4+ runs in consecutive starts for the first time since July 30-Aug. 4, 2015.
