OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's have won three of four games since the All-Star Break and are 5-3 in their last eight...have won the first game of a series in 10 of the last 11 series (19-12 for the season)...improved to 20-27 (.426) at home...are now 26-30 (.464) at night...trail the Astros in the season series 5-6, but lead the all-time series 45-29 (.608), including a 24-12 mark in Oakland...are 3-1 on this current 10-game homestand against Toronto (2-1), Houston (1-0), and Tampa Bay (four games).
- The A's have committed at least one error in five consecutive games (nine in total) to snap an Athletics franchise record streak of 15 consecutive games without an error...have hit eight home runs in four games since the All-Star Break...have homered 11 times in the last seven games after tallying just two home runs over the previous six contests.
- Kendall Graveman is 5-0 with a 3.29 ERA (20 er in 54.2 ip) over his last nine starts...the five-game winning streak is an on-going career high (previous; 3. June 24-July 4, 2015)...is 3-0 with a 2.08 ERA (5 er in 21.2 ip) in three starts in July...it is only the second time in his career that he has won more than two games in a month (3 in June, 2015)...is 3-1 with a 3.44 ERA (19 er in 49.2 ip) in eight starts against American League West competition...threw a career-high 112 pitches (previous: 111, three times; last: April 20 at New York-AL).
- Ryan Dull had his career-high 11.1-inning scoreless streak snapped...it was 0.1 innings short of the A's season high of 11.2 (Madson, April 17-May 16).
- Yonder Alonso (2-for-4, r, 2b, 3 rbi) is batting .322 (39-for-121) over his last 37 games...is hitting .450 (18-for-40) with five doubles and 12 RBI in 11 games against Houston this year...is a .350 (28-for-80) career hitter with 21 RBI against the Astros...the RBI are his third most against any team.
- Khris Davis (1-for-4, r, hr, rbi, so) is 6-for-15 (.400) with four home runs and six RBI in four games since the All-Star Break...is hitting .299 (61-for-204) with 18 of his 23 home runs at night.
- Ryon Healy (1-for-4, r, 2b, rbi, 2 so) has started each of the A's four games at third base since being selected from Triple-A Nashville (4-for-15, .267).
- Marucs Semien (2-for-3, 2 r, bb) is 16-for-70 (.229) over his last 19 games, but 11 of the 16 hits are for extra bases (three doubles, one triple, seven homers).
- Stephen Vogt (2-for-4, r, 2b) is 11-for-19 (.579) with seven runs, two doubles and six RBI over his current five-game hitting streak...is batting .367 (22-for-60) with 14 runs scored over his last 17 games.

Manyin Conzaloz (8)

- The Houston Astros are 3-3 in their past six games...fell to 22-24 (.478) on the road...dropped to 31-29 (.517) in night games...are now 29-16 (.644) when scoring first and 44-28 (.611) when hitting a home run...still lead the season series 6-5 with the A's, but are 29-45 (.392) all-time against the Athletics, including a 12-24 mark in Oakland...are 2-1 on this six-game road trip to Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (1-2).
- Mike Fiers is 3-1 with a 4.14 ERA (19 er in 41.1 ip) in his last eight starts...is 0-2 with a 4.76 ERA (15 er in 28.1 ip) in five career starts against the A's...tossed under 4.0 innings for the second consecutive start, and is 0-1 in those games (10 er in 7.0 ip, 12.86 era)...walked more than two batters for just the second time this season. Jose Altuve (2-for-4, sb) has hit safely in each of his last 17 road games (34-for-69, .493)...is batting .404 (74-for-183) on the road this season...is a .319
- (90-for-282) career hitter against Oakland.
- Carlos Correa (2-for-4, r, 2 2b, rbi, so) is 26-for-89 (.292) with 12 doubles, five home runs and 25 RBI in his last 23 games.
- Marwin Gonzalez (1-for-5, r, hr, rbi) is batting .289 (43-for-149) over his last 39 games.
